

GIRLS EXPLORE STEM AT SUMMER CAMP

Girl Scouts of Northern New Jersey (GSNNJ) hosted several STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) program activities this year thanks to the support of PSE&G.

At GSNNJ's two summer camps, Lake Rickabear in Kinnelon and Jockey Hollow in Mendham, special sessions feature a new water robotics program, in addition to other STEM activities. Water robotics teaches girls to design, draft, and engineer robots that can complete tasks in water. This initiative was funded in part by PSE&G.

During the "Geek Chic" session at Lake Rickabear in July, girls also learned about sound waves, circuitry, and the capillary effect.

"Girl Scout summer camp is a great place to incorporate STEM activities since it provides a structured, girl-only environment for girls to try out new things and learn about different aspects of science and technology," said Betty Garger, President and Chief Executive officer of Girl Scouts of Northern New Jersey. "We truly appreciate the support of PSE&G, which has allowed us to expand our STEM offerings to even more girls."

PSE&G also funded other STEM activities

throughout the year, including STEMfest at Passaic County Community College. During this conference, middle school girls worked alongside students at PCCC in hands-on science experiments and activities.

"Girls are still losing interest in these core subjects once they get to middle school due to the lack of mentors and low exposure to STEM fields," said Betty Garger, President and Chief Executive officer of Girl Scouts of Northern New Jersey. "With the increasing importance of STEM in our world, we really need to foster a love of these fields in girls of all ages."

Girl Scouts is the premier leadership development program for girls. In Girl Scouts, girls discover themselves, connect with others, and take action to create positive change in their own communities. WATCHUNG HILLS EDUCATION ASSOCIATION AWARDS SCHOLARSHIPS TO FUTURE EDUCATORS

Shannon Butler and Rebecca Kinsella are two graduating seniors who are “energetic, enthusiastic and dedicated students with great potential as future educators.” More significantly, they know what they want to do with their lives: teach. The Watchung Hills Regional Education Association (WHREA) will help them do just that by awarding each of them the WHREA’s \$1,000 Scholarship for Future Teachers.

This is the ninth year the scholarship, which is largely funded by individual donors through an annual WHREA fundraising event, is being offered. Said guidance counselor Joseph Toye who serves on the Selection Committee: “As educators we are aware of the challenges that future educators face. Donating to the scholarship fund is a concrete way to show our support.” Since the program’s inception in 2006, the WHREA has granted close to \$14,000 to future educators.

Jose Rodriguez, representing the teachers’ association, presented the scholarships to Butler and Kinsella.

Both students were enrolled in the child development curriculum program through which local preschool children attend morning sessions in the on-site Edna D’Elia Pre-School during the school year to learn the skills and behaviors which will ready them for kindergarten. At the same time, their high school student-mentors have the opportunity to practice early childhood education skills. The teen teachers have the opportunity of being “apprenticed” to teachers in the Woodland School, located adjacent to the high school, in their senior year so that they may observe professional teachers and gain further insight into the profession in a realistic setting.

Millington resident Shannon Butler has known for a long time that teaching might be her

career choice. The spark her grandmother, a kindergarten teacher, ignited for teaching took hold; teachers such as Mr. Porter, Mrs. Jaren, Mrs. Truskowski and Ms. Goodson, and the courses in Hills’ Child Development Program further strengthened her resolve to become an educator.

During her senior year Butler worked as an assistant teacher in a first-grade classroom at next-door Woodland School, where she was able to help with many day-to-day teacher responsibilities, helping younger students learn every day. A four-year member of Hills’ field hockey team, she also coaches young field hockey players in the recreational junior program. In the classroom or on the field, she takes great pride in helping others grow and mature, something she’ll surely experience as a teacher.

Butler will attend Seton Hall University as a major in elementary education in the fall.

Rebecca Kinsella, also a Millington resident, was at one time interested in architecture as a career. However, when she enrolled in a Child Development course, she began to rethink her career goals. “I realized my future lay not in designing houses, but in educating others. Watching children prosper filled me with joy,” she declared. And after that, she never looked back. She will attend the University of Maryland in the fall, majoring in Early Childhood and Special Education in preparation for teaching preschool through third-grade.

Actually, Kinsella has been involved in childhood education all along as a baby-sitter since eighth grade, a four-year camp counselor in Long Hill Township, a peer tutor. “I love helping others and someday hope to have my own classroom where I can help my students prosper and learn,” she says.


