NPBA ANNOUNCES BUSINESS OF THE YEAR COMPETITION

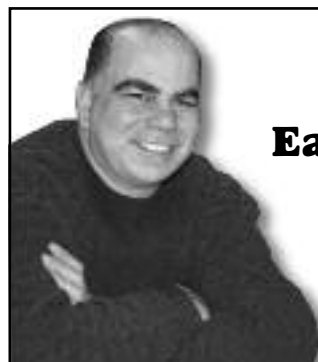

SHIRLEY THOMPSON TO RECEIVES ROTARY AWARD

The Rotary Club of Plainfield-North Plainfield is pleased to announce that South Plainfield resident Shirley Weaver Thompson will receive the 2017 Service Above Self Award at the club's 18th Annual Wine Tasting Dinner. The event will be held on April 5 at Giovanna's Restaurant in Plainfield, and is a fundraiser for the club's scholarship program for graduating seniors. Club President Ravenell Williams cited Shirley's exemplary service to the elderly and others in need at Christmas as the determining factor in her selection for the award. "Rotary International's motto is 'Service Above Self'", said Mr. Williams. "Rotarians strive to provide service to others in all of our projects and activities. We also seek out community leaders from Plainfield, North Plainfield, or South Plainfield who are actively involved in exemplary projects or activities that benefit their respective communities," said Williams. "Shirley was selected for her years of service to others through her Shirley Thompson's Christmas project."

This year will be the 15th year that Shirley has cooked and delivered a hot meal to senior citizens and families in need on Christmas day; last year, the number was over 140. Shirley also obtains family and children's names from Social Services and "adopts" the children out to friends and families, distributing hundreds of gifts for the children. Rather than wrap each of the gifts, Shirley and her volunteers provide the gifts and the tape, wrapping paper, and tags so that the children's parents can wrap the gifts and share in the Christmas spirit.

Shirley relies solely on donations from friends, families and local businesses. Twice a year, Mr. Subs holds a fundraiser and donates a portion of the sales proceeds to be used for the purchasing of items needed to cook for the Christmas dinner. Collection boxes for new clothes and toys were hosted last year at Mr. Subs, the Observer Newspaper office, Investors Bank, and at Bagel Pantry, all in South Plainfield.

Past recipients of the award include Janice Allen, former mayor and councilwoman North Plainfield (2010 - inaugural recipient); William Parenti, North Plainfield Chief of Police (2011); Michael Townley, South Plainfield resident and Rotary member (2012); Donna Albanese, Plainfield business owner and leader (2013); Dr. Marilyn Birnbaum, Superintendent of Schools North Plainfield (2014); Plainfield Mayor Adrian Mapp (2015); North Plainfield Mayor Michael Giordano (2016).

CHIEF WILLIAM G. PARENTI OFFERS SOME SPRING BREAK BURGLARY PREVENTION TIPS


Soon families from North Plainfield will be among those on Spring Break, heading to beaches and other (hopefully warmer) vacation destinations.

Empty homes, apartments, and condos can be targets for opportunistic criminals, and with that in mind, Chief Parenti would like to offer some burglary prevention tips:

- Make sure locks are in good working order and lock all doors and windows.
- Consider installing timers on interior lights and install exterior motion lights.
- Close bedroom drapes or blinds.
- Write down serial numbers of valuables (TVs, laptops, gaming consoles, DVD players, etc) and take photographs in case items are stolen.

- Don't advertise assets. Hide laptop computers and other small electronic items or ...
- Remove valuable technology from apartments or residences; take items with you if possible.
- Stop mail and newspaper deliveries.
- Ask a trusted friend or neighbor to check on the residence while you are away.
- Don't tip off criminals on the web; refrain from posting your spring break plans on social media.
- Consider purchasing a home alarm system, and post highly visible warning stickers and signs indicating one is in place.

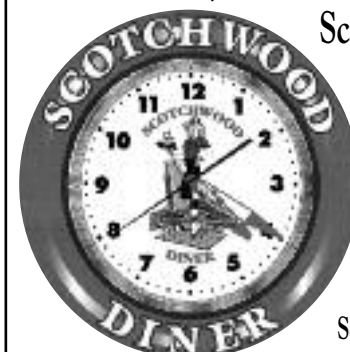
