

CLARK POP WARNER CHEERLEADERS BRING HOME NATIONAL TROPHY

It's a proud time for Clark's "Silver, Blue and White" Crusader Cheerleaders. For the first time in Clark Pop Warner history, a Clark cheer squad, the Midget Large Novice team, earned the privilege of competing in the National Pop Warner Cheer Championships in Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida in December.

The Midget squad, consisting of 27 seventh and eighth graders, began preparing for competition in August, in addition to performing at the Clark Pop Warner Midget football games all season. En route to Nationals, the Midgets won first place in the local Raritan Valley competition in October. Moving on to the Metro Qualifiers in late October, the Midgets took second place. Finally, at the Pop Warner Eastern Region Championship in November, with stiffer competition and a larger pool of competitors from several states, the Clark Midget squad placed runner up to last year's 2010 National Champions, the Riverside Bulldogs. Only the top two Eastern Region winners in each division advances to Nationals.

"What an incredible moment it was to hear the Clark Crusader name announced at Regionals. These girls work so hard and have dreamed of that moment for years," said Coach Melissa Sapia.

Winning an opportunity to compete on the national stage was a thrilling high point for the girls, some of whom have cheered for Clark Pop Warner for eight years since age five. Then placing fourth Nationally in Walt Disney World was truly a dream come true. Some girls will be leaving the Pop Warner program after this season, as Clark's program ends after eighth

grade. This was a wonderful way to end their career with Pop Warner.

On the mat during the National Championship, the girls performed flawlessly. Despite many injuries and illnesses that plagued their season, the team really pulled together and gave it their all, executing a trophy-winning performance. "What a proud moment for these girls. This will be a memory of a lifetime for them," said Coach Kim Shriner.

The Midgets brought home the fourth place trophy, beating the 2010 National Champions they had taken second place to at Eastern Regionals, and placing behind teams from Massachusetts, Florida and Connecticut. The point spread between second, third and fourth

place was 0.79 percent, an extremely tight margin.


This win is a rousing tribute not only to the girls who worked so hard, but also to Pop Warner Cheer Coordinators Justine Petronella and Melissa Sapia, Coach Kim Shriner, and Junior Coaches Carly Koppel, Ali Dugan and Amanda Ciccone. Their many volunteer hours of planning, practices and encouragement guided and challenged the girls to rise to their potential on the mats this year, leading them to the National stage. The Midgets have now set a precedent and left a legacy for the younger Clark Cheer squads, who will cheer with dreams of Disney in their hearts as they grow through the Pop Warner program.

GIRL SCOUT TROOP BENEFIT FOOD PANTRY



LIBRARY OFFERS CAREER RESOURCE TO HELP CITIZENS FIND EMPLOYMENT

Clark Public Library now offers Career Transitions, an online advanced career service tool from Gale, part of Cengage Learning. Career Transitions is designed to help public library patrons, even those who have no experience using technology, secure sustainable employment.

In an effort to assist in the economic recovery of the state, the New Jersey State Library, an affiliate of Thomas Edison State College, purchased the Career Transitions database for the Clark Public Library, after receiving a federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Broadband Technology Opportunity Program (BTOP) grant.

"Every day more than 300,000 Americans get job-seeking help at their local public library, and they need efficient tools to help them find work," said Patricia Anderson, Library Director. "With Career Transitions, Clark residents will be able to find the answers they need to improve their chances of finding sustainable employment."

Career Transitions is a guided, self-paced program that walks users through the entire employment process – assessing strengths and interests, providing information on new opportunities and growing industries, preparing a resume and cover letter, finding educational opportunities and networking advice, performing a comprehensive job search and completing online job applications.

The program includes a guided resume and cover letter creator to help users find a quick and

efficient path to presenting their background and abilities in the best light. The resource also offers custom interview simulation, targeted tips and advice in the form of articles and more than 1,000 videos on job searching and applying, as well as "Day in the Life" interviews with people in different fields. Users can also search for training programs and new career opportunities based on their education level, or previous job or military experience.
