

Head Football Coach Michael Mancino presided over the event as all athletes were honored for their contributions to Crusader Football. In addition, numerous scholarships were awarded to deserving student athletes throughout the evening. The night culminated with the showing of the 2012 Crusader Football Team's highlights. It was a wonderful evening to celebrate both past and present Crusaders and continues to keep the tradition of Crusader Football alive and well.

Below is a recap of the scholarships awarded:
THE COLLEGIATE ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

The Collegiate Athlete of the Year honors a former Crusader that has gone on to succeed both in the classroom and on the athletic fields. The 2012 recipient was Dan Dugan, who quarterbacked the 2008 Crusader Football Team to an NJSIAA State Final appearance. Some of Dan Dugan's honors as a player included: 1st

Team All-Conference, 1st Team All-County, and selected to participate in the North – South Game his Senior Season.

In addition, he was the starter for TCNJ this past season at quarterback and broke 5 school records (Most Passing Yards Season 2392, Most Completions Season 260, Most Attempts Season 419, Most Completions Game 34, and Most Attempts Game 50) while leading his team. Dan is currently attending TCNJ where he is finishing his degree while recently completing his football career.

THE HENRY A. VARRIANO MEMORIAL AWARD

Henry R. Varriano presents this award to a senior player who displays determination and a never give up attitude. The recipient of this award always puts Team Above Self, Sacrificed Individuality for the Team, Pushed himself to achieve greater heights, Overcame Adversity, and displayed perseverance. The Varriano Award is for a scholarship and plaque. The 2012 Varriano Award winner was Andrew Zub.

CENTURY 21 JRS ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

GIRLS' BASKETBALL CHARITY EVENTS

The 2012-2013 girls' basketball team at Arthur L. Johnson High School made a commitment this past season to not only do their best in practice and games but to help make things better for those who are in need of a helping hand or a morale boost.

The two projects that were undertaken were St. Jude Children's Hospital and The Wounded Warrior Project.

St. Jude's is a hospital that treats children's cancer patients. All children are treated with no

regard to race, religion, or ability to pay. The hospital has produced many advances in the treatment of all types of cancer.

The second project selected was the Wounded Warrior Project. WWP has many purposes, including: To raise awareness and enlist the public's aid for the needs of injured service members; to help injured service members aid and assist each other; and to provide unique, direct programs and services to meet the needs of injured service members.

Because of the wars being currently fought we have many servicemen coming back with severe physical and emotional injuries. Today's battlefield medics are able to save many of our heroes but many years of treatment and therapy are still needed for them. Our team decided to partake in Johnson High Supports Our Heroes Night. Shirts were designed and worn in school that day and in warm-ups before the game. These shirts were purchased by Coach Tom Chmiel and Andy Hegedus, a Vietnam Veteran, and close friend of Coach Chmiel. The donation

was made in honor of the many men and women who have served our country.

An explanation of the WWP was made before the game and money was raised through the generosity of both Clark and New Providence fans. T-shirts were sold for \$20.00 with every dollar going to the Project. A total of \$622 was raised at the game. The check was sent to the New York office of Wounded Warriors Project with a request that the money be used to help a New Jersey Veteran if possible. Purchasing backpacks with supplies needed for the recovering hero to use during rehab was another use of the donated money.

Coach Tom Chmiel said this about the charity work of his program "As Head Coach of this fine group of ladies, I am very proud of the effort they put forth in both projects. Hopefully they will continue to remember that they have a responsibility to help others who need a kind word, a helping hand, or encouragement in their struggle to beat a disease or recover from their injuries."

In 2011 the library celebrated its 50th anniversary and the Board initiated a capital campaign to raise \$50,000 to purchase various capital items and computers – they are about half way towards their goal. 




