FRANK K. HEHNL SCHOOL TEACHER NICOLE PARLAVECCHIO IS RECIPIENT OF STATEWIDE SPECIAL EDUCATION AWARD

Nicole Parlavecchio, special education teacher at the Frank K. Hehnl School in Clark, is the recipient of the highly prestigious "Innovations in Special Education" Award through the New Jersey School Boards Association. Ms. Parlavecchio is one of only eight awardees throughout the entire State of New Jersey.

Each year the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA) solicits program nominations for what they deem the most effective, innovative, and successful programming ideas currently in practice in special education classrooms and programs from each district throughout the State. As a recipient of the 2013 "Innovations in Special Education" Award, Ms. Parlavecchio was selected from a pool of 55 nominations and is one of only eight winners in the State.

Ms. Parlavecchio's award winning program is titled "Teaching, Technology, and the Tennessee Titans," it features educational lessons that are skyped between the special education students and players and coaches from the National Football League's Tennessee Titan football team. Ms. Parlavecchio's Father, Chet Parlavecchio, is the Linebackers Coach of the Tennessee Titans team. Titan players read to the students, participate in interactive learning activities, engage students in higher level thinking skills, and provide homework assignments. Among the Tennessee Titan players who have participated in the program include Linebacker Gerald McRath, Wide Receiver Marc Mariani, Linebacker Zac Diles, Linebacker Kevin Malast, and Linebackers Coach Chet Parlavecchio. Ms. Parlavecchio develops lesson plans and shares them in advance with the team, who then prepares materials and coordinates the lesson with her. The program has been valuable in developing enhanced student self-esteem, building speaking and listening skills, and promoting higher level thinking skills.

Clark Superintendent of Schools Kenneth Knops was delighted to hear of Ms. Parlavecchio's selection for an "Innovations in Special Education Award, "Nicole and her Dad have done a wonderful job planning, coordinating, and developing this state of the art program." I had the pleasure of working on many graduate school projects with Chet Parlavecchio who was my classmate at Montclair State University about 22 years ago, and now to supervise his daughter, Nicole. Both Parlavecchios are cut from the same mold: they are visionary educators who think outside the box to motivate young people to strive to better themselves. I have had the pleasure of attending a few skyping sessions, the program is a tremendous innovation as the Titan players involved as well as Coach Parlavecchio are wonderful guiding lights, role models, and mentors to our impressionable students. This program truly touches on the theme of Special Education Week in New Jersey which is "Journey Into the Future of Education."



Clark's 2nd annual Give & Share Drive Thru Food Drive was a huge success.

Over 20 volunteers showed up at town hall, that windy morning, ready to fill the 8ft truck that would transport any donations received that day, back to St. John the Apostle Food Pantry. Our volunteers jumped right into action, loading over 125 cases of food that was dropped off the day before at Arthur L. Johnson high school. The teachers provided incentives for the students to get involved and donate. And donate, they did! How wonderful was it to see cases piled high, and bags upon bags of dry goods and non-perishables ready to be taken to the pantry. Several teachers at Kumph Middle School also got their students involved in supporting the food drive, including the school's K-Kids club,

adding even more donations to the pile! "We actually lost count of how many cases we loaded, there was so many, how wonderful!" said Mary Ann Fiorello, director of pantry.

While one crew of volunteers was loading up the truck, our other crew was busy unloading bags of donated groceries from the cars pulling into the front drive. People would pull up, pop their trunk, or wind down their window, hand out their donations, and off they went. Not without a "thank you" and some yummy Snicker doodles handed out by our younger volunteers.

After four hours, our food drive came to a close. Oh, and remember that empty 8ft truck? Well it left the town hall driveway very slowly and completely filled! All thanks to the support of the Clark community!



THIRD GRADERS ROCKIN' RECORDER CONCERT

The annual third grade recorder concert at Frank K. Hehny Elementary School was held on May 1. The students, under the direction of music teacher, Mr. Jamey Vavra, are required to play the recorder as their introduction to the woodwind instruments. Mr. Vavra uses Recorder Karate, which is an achievement program to help inspire students to practice and advance their recorder skills. As the children master each song, they earn colored 'belts' (strings) that get displayed at the end of their recorders. The entire third grade learned to read sheet music and mastered 5 songs throughout the year, earning 5 belts. The finale and student favorite, was "Crocodile Rock". The students learned a choreographed dance routine, arranged by Mr. Vavra, and the notes to play along with the chorus. The students enjoyed seeing the audience participate with them in the dance routine in both the daytime and nighttime performances.
