






#### DAVID BREARLEY MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT OF THE MONTH

The May David Brearley Middle School Student of the Month is Dominick Ciano. Dominick has made great strides during this academic year. He takes pride in his work. He





#### **BIG PLANS FOR SUMMER READING**



### "BARD ON THE BOULEVARD" OPENS SEASON NINE WITH PERFORMANCE OF OTHELLO

The Kenilworth Public Library is please to announce the opening of season nine of "The Bard on the Boulevard," the library's annual outdoor Shakespeare series, with a performance other outdo of Othello at 7:30 PM on Thursday, June 21, at the David Brearley High School football field. Other performances in the series include The Comedy of Errors on July 19 and Cardenio on August 16. The library is continuing its ongoing collaboration with The Hudson Shakespeare Company, an organization celebrating its twentieth anniversary this year.

One of Shakespeare's most performed tragedies, Othello is a heart rending drama that touches on the themes of love, jealousy and betrayal in the context of the marriage between Desdemona, the daughter of a Venetian nobleman, and Othello, a dark skinned Moor who is a general in the Venetian army. The story will be familiar to many in the audience due to the numerous performances of the play that have been presented on film and television as well as from adaptations of the story that have been made for opera and ballet.

All performances in "The Bard on the Boulevard" series are free and open to all

members of the general public and preregistration is not required. Those planning to attend should bring their own lawn chairs or other outdoor seating as seating in the bleachers is not recommended. The David Brearley football field is located at the intersection of Kenilworth Boulevard and 14th Street and it is recommended that those planning to drive to the performance park their cars on either the Boulevard or 14th Street rather than in the high school parking lot. In the event of rain or extreme heat, the performances will be moved indoors to the Kenilworth Public Library which is located at 548 Boulevard.

Funding for "The Bard on the Boulevard" has been made possible in part by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts, Department of State, a partner agency of the National Endowment of the Arts, through a grant administered by the Union County Office of Cultural and Heritage Affairs. 
