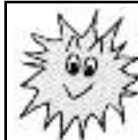

## LT. GOV. KIM GUADAGNO PRESENTS CHECK TO LINDEN FIRE DEPARTMENT

On Monday, April 4, 2011, Lt. Governor Kim Guadagno presented a \$25,000 check to benefit the city's fire department and other first responders. The money comes from a fund set up by the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey and was the first of \$135,000 in grants to be awarded to 13 fire departments and other first responders in northern New Jersey. Departments receiving money have agreed to assist the Port Authority when emergencies arise.

"As we approach the tenth anniversary of 9/11, it is particularly appropriate that we recognize the heroism of the first responders like you," Lt. Governor Guadagno said during a ceremony at the city's South Wood Avenue firehouse. "I know that for some of you, these memories are all too real. You were among the policemen, firemen and emergency personnel who ran toward the towers as they were burning so that you could save others."

"The money is going to be spent for safety equipment for our firefighters and for safety equipment for our residents," said Richard J. Gerbounka, the mayor of Linden. Grant rules

stipulate that fire departments must use the money to buy firefighting equipment or to upgrade facilities.

Also on hand was Bill Baroni, a former state senator and the Deputy Executive Director of the Port Authority. He noted that the grant was timely, coming as it does in a month when the Port Authority is commemorating its 90th anniversary.

Lt. Governor Guadagno also spoke about the

importance of helping municipalities, saying, "The important thing is to get what funding is available out of the hands of government and into the hands of those who can best use it to defend our communities."

As about two dozen firefighters listened, the Lt. Governor added, "With your help, we will support those of you on the front lines and keep strengthening the networks that will keep us secure."

## STRATEGIC VISION PLAN IN FINAL STAGE

The City of Linden is in the final stages of preparing a Strategic Vision Plan for the City. The Plan was prepared by the Rutgers University, Bloustein School of Public Planning and Policy. The subject matter was gathered from Linden Strategic Vision Plan Steering Committee, focus groups, such as Linden elected officials, Board of Education, Industrial and Commercial business groups, City leaders, Residents, Religious and Fraternal organizations that make up the chemistry of the City. A summarization of the collected ideas, suggestions and identified needs for the City of Linden to consider for adoption has been posted on the City of Linden Website.

The residents and business people are being asked to review the strategic plan summary to ensure that any additional subject matter relevant to the Vision Plan is included as part of the information gathering process. Note, The remaining detail explanation and technical detail will be included in the final Vision Plan copy. The Public is encouraged to comment or ask questions on the Strategic Vision Plan subject content.

Your comments on the Strategic Vision plan can help influence the shape and structure of the final plan. To post your comments, a website has been set up to collect your input to the plan. 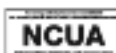

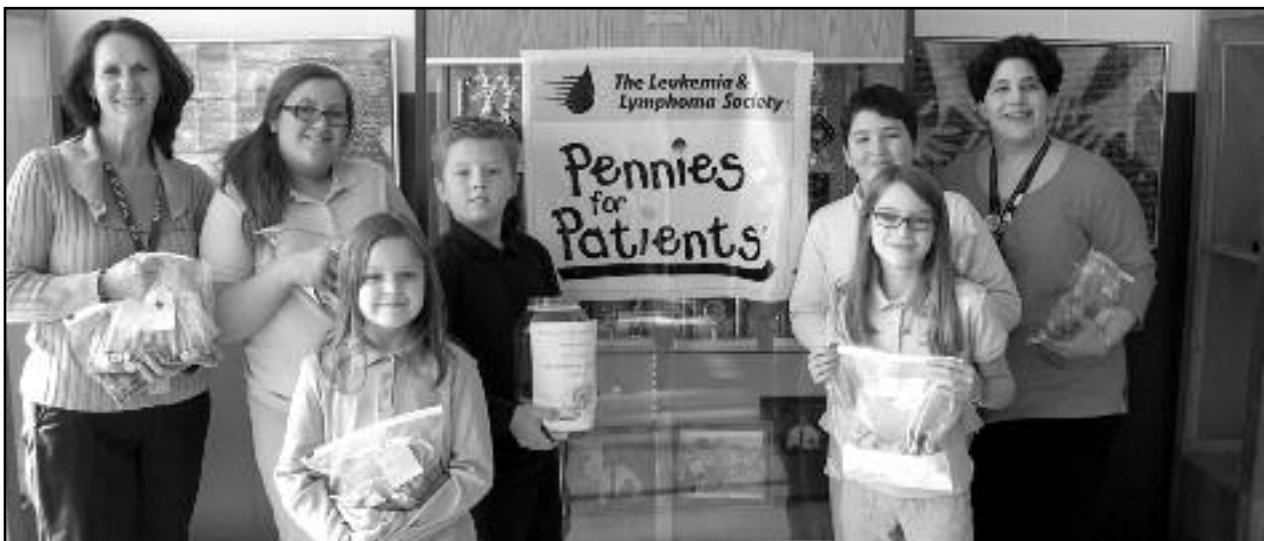

## LATEST HEART TREATMENT IS COOL ANSWER TO RECOVERY AT TRINITAS

*Following cardiac arrest, therapeutic temperature-reducing protocol preserves brain function of local resident*

During a recent visit from Florida to see relatives and friends in Roselle Park, New Jersey, Alfred Colucci experienced a cardiac arrest that made him an excellent candidate to receive the latest treatment using therapeutic hypothermia at Trinitas Regional Medical Center. His remarkable recovery is attributed to the protocol that involved cooling his body temperature to 91 degrees.

Nicknamed "Code Frosty," the protocol involves staff in key areas, including the Mobile Intensive Care Unit, the Emergency Department, Intensive Care Unit, Respiratory Therapy, Pharmacy, Anesthesiology, and the Cardiac Catheterization Lab. For patients such as Mr. Colucci, therapeutic hypothermia relies on the interaction of staff members in these departments who work rapidly to cool the patient in order to preserve brain function in the first minutes following a cardiac arrest.

"Therapeutic hypothermia, which involves bringing a patient's body temperature down to 91 degrees, is recommended for patients whose hearts have stopped, been restarted through CPR, and who remain unconscious," explains Trinitas Advance Practice Nurse Debbie Durand. "Therapeutic hypothermia helps to prevent damage to the brain which is dependent on a steady supply of oxygen from the heart. Since many patients do not even survive the original cardiac arrest, we want to give those that do every chance to maintain good brain function. If the supply of oxygen to the brain is interrupted, various processes can cause damage to brain cells that may result in an inability to communicate or interact with others. By chilling the whole body, we can slow brain damage or even prevent it from happening," she continues.

Therapeutic hypothermia begins in the field where Trinitas paramedics are equipped with icepacks and cooled IV solution. En route to the Emergency Department, work begins on the patient so that valuable time is not wasted. The process then continues in the Emergency Department where the patient is wrapped in a specialized vest and leg coverings.

The care of the patient continues while he or she is under sedation. For the next 24 hours, the patient is kept cool and cared for in the Intensive Care Unit. During this time, the patient's normal body functions are monitored and ultimately, the patient's body temperature is gradually

warmed and returned to normal level.

At Trinitas, this new equipment is in use thanks to a grant received from the Gertrude L. Hirsch Charitable Trust.

The introduction of therapeutic hypothermia as a treatment protocol in such cases has resulted in positive outcomes and remarkable recoveries such as that of Mr. Colucci, whose wife Mary described the entire Trinitas "Code Frosty" team as "angels from heaven."
