

SGT. TEDDY SYPKO A TRUE ADVOCATE FOR VETERANS

of Linden to attend a party with his family and Gersick cousins. Teddy was born in Linden to Teddy and Jenny Sypko. His siblings are Anna, Robert, Linda, Michael, and Suzanne. He attended Seohl Middle School and Linden High School before enlisting in the United States Marine Corp in May of 1967. This was at a time when most guys wished their number wasn't called to be drafted. He did basic training at Paris Island, South Carolina, followed by four weeks of advanced training in Camp Lejune, NC. He then came home for 20 days before heading to Camp Pendleton CA and Okinawa in preparation for Vietnam. He was assigned to Echo Co. 2nd Battalion 7th Marines(E-2/7) for 13 months. During this time, he was in major battles against the North Vietnamese army and Viet Cong. Nonetheless, he recalls sneaking into DaNang with a couple of friends to buy cigarettes for the rest of the guys in his platoon. While there he met three friends from Linden: Alfonse and Dominick Catinella and Butch Hemingway.

After returning home, he was stationed at Lakehurst Naval Air Station, Lakehurst, NJ for two years. In 1970, after his tour of duty was over, Teddy and two other sergeants were sent back to Vietnam. Upon arriving they were assigned to KiloCo.3rd Battalion 5th Marines while stationed on Hill 145 outside of DaNang. His platoon was on an operation on October 6th when Teddy stepped on a White Phosphorus Grenade Booby Trap. He was taken by helicopter to the hospital ship USS Sanctuary where his left leg was amputated above the knee. From there he was taken to Clark Air Force Base, Philippines, Camp Butler, Japan and then to Brooke Army Hospital, San Antonio, Texas for treatment of his burns. With the help of a Linden businessman, his cousin Ralph Gersick and the Marine Corp League, Teddy's parents were able to fly to Texas to visit him. After extensive skin grafting he was allowed to go home for the Holidays.

In January, 1971, Teddy was transferred to the East Orange VA Medical Center where he received the first of many prosthetic legs.

While serving in the Marines, Teddy received the following awards:

- Bronze Star Medal with combat V Meritorious Commendation
- 2 Purple Hearts
- Vietnam Cross of Gallantry
- Presidential Unit Commendation

However, after getting out of the VA Medical

Sgt. Teddy Sypko came back to his hometown Center, he was unable to find employment because of his disabilities. In 1973, a VA counselor talked him into attending college. Teddy enrolled in the Hotel Restaurant Management Program at Middlesex County College where he met his wife, Liz. Just before graduating, he took a job with the Department of Labor, assisting veterans seeking employment. This job was funded from year to year and he needed a permanent position since he was getting married. He found employment with the NJ Department of Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) as an assistant service officer. Six months later he was asked to work for the VFW National Headquarters in Washington DC. During this time he was trained to inspect VA Medical Centers throughout the country. An inspection in a facility in the Mid-West proved to be the worst. The Secretary of Veterans Affairs sent a team to do a re-inspectiion which agreed with Teddy's. Finally, six months later, The VFW Commander - In-Chief confirmed the inspection and Teddy's report sits in the Library of Congress. In addition, he assisted veterans and their dependents secure their entitlements.

Teddy retired in 2004 after 25 years. He always said he wanted a hot dog cart when he retired. His wife and kids thought he was crazy. But at 55, Teddy ran a successful hot dog business in Grain Valley, Missouri near his home in Independence. But where did he get his hot dogs and kielbasa?? Pulaski Meat Market in Linden and Thumann's Meat Company. At age 62, Teddy parked his cart forever.

return to Vietnam in 2009 thanks to a wealthy Vietnam Veteran who left money to the VFW with the stipulation that the money be used to send 10 Vietnam veterans back to Vietnam every year until the funds run out. It was a ten day trip that started in L.A. From there they flew to Hong Kong to Hanoi with many visits to historic sites. They included the lake where Senator Mc Cain was captured to the DMZ. There they encountered a former North Vietnamese Soldier , who extended his hand and said "we be friends now". From there the trip took them to HUE, Pu Bai, China Beach, Cu Chi, Chu La, Ho Chi Minh City, and the Mekong Delta. He was surprised how the country changed. The people were friendly and their method of transportation were mopeds. He mentioned that of all the military bases we had, there is only one small one kept in tact.

SID COMMITTEE WORKING HARD TO IMPROVE THE DOWNTOWN AREA

Committee is an organization charged with the management of a special tax applied to commercial properties within the general "Downtown" Area. These funds are managed by a committee of 9 members consisting of property owners and business owners from within the business district along with Linden citizen representatives and a governmental representative. The job of the SID Committee is to support and supplement services and programs offered by the City and help support the downtown business district in any way possible. SID helps to run such events as sidewalk sales, helps businesses with the purchase of signs, and organized the Holiday Christmas light show.

More recently, the SID Committee has very aggressively taken on the issue of cleaning up our downtown. Some of the projects that we have been working on are:

1. Power Washing - Beginning this past November and running through January, the sidewalks of North Wood Avenue were power washed and scrubbed to remove stains and gum

- 3. Storefront Awnings The SID has also undertaken the replacement of all of the awnings on N. Wood Avenue. The existing awnings were hung approximately 12 years ago and many are in dire need of replacement.
- 4. Shrubbery New shrubs and flowers are also going to be permanently planted in the many concrete planters that are currently empty on N. Wood Avenue.

This much-needed facelift to our downtown is just getting started with many new initiatives to follow. A website which will list all of the businesses in our downtown area is currently under development, (LindenDownTown.com).

In addition to all of these exciting improvements, the Committee will be making a very aggressive push for the enforcement of our Municipal Litter Laws. All of the work and money being spent in this effort to improve and clean up our downtown shopping area and make it more appealing for shoppers is currently being undermined by what has become a very serious litter problem. The SID committee plans on working with the various departments within the city to make sure we are all working together to get our Downtown Shopping District back to its former glory.

NEW JERSEY REMEMBERS DWI ACCIDENT VICTIMS

In honor of those who lost their lives to impaired drivers, the Division of Highway Traffic Safety will host New Jersey Remembers, a commemoration, for the second consecutive year. The Division is looking to expand the event this year by inviting new families to honor their loved ones. The event is April 24, at 11 a.m., at the War Memorial Building in Trenton.

During the emotional remembrance last year, families that lost loved ones to a drunk or drugged driver participated in a processional, where they were escorted by local police officers and State Troopers. Representing the nearly 13,000 lives lost each year nationwide to impaired driving, the families displayed photos of their loved ones and lit candles to commemorate their lives. As a reminder of the continuing effort to eliminate drunk and drugged driving, traffic officers from around the state were also recognized for their role in enforcing New Jersey's Driving While Intoxicated (DWI)

CONOCOPHILLIPS DONATES \$15K TO RWJ


ConocoPhillips - Bayway Refinery has generously donated \$15,000 to the Cardiac Catheterization Lab Replacement Project at RWJ Rahway.

Thanks to the support of ConocoPhillips and other funders, RWJ Rahway completed the major renovation of its Cardiac Cath Lab in November 2011.

According to Marlene Lubinger, President, RWJ Rahway Foundation almost one third of the people living in the hospital's service area are 65 or older and that population is growing as the baby boomers age. Last year 62% of all patients admitted to the hospital were 65+ and more than half had a cardiac-related diagnosis. In November the new lab with new capabilities opened with a new name...The Cardiovascular Lab at RWJ Rahway.



The Linden Public School District held a ribbon cutting ceremony in March to officially open the new addition at School No.2 (1700 South Wood Ave. Linden). This structure is the newest of four buildings comprising the School No.2 Complex.

The twenty-one new regular classrooms and two small group classrooms will give the district an additional 34,609 square feet of instructional space. Designed as an early childhood center, the facility includes a "gross motor room" for activities, along with office space for the principal, nurse, conference room and a teacher room. A soft-surface playground is adjacent to the addition and other soft surface play areas are also included, along with additional parking areas.

The additional classroom space will allow for a general realignment of elementary students such that all Linden elementary schools will return to neighborhood PK-5 schools starting with the 2012-2013 school year. School No. 2 will have the largest pupil enrollment of any elementary school in the district. In designing the building, care was taken to develop a bright and nurturing environment with special awareness and consideration given to material finishes.

Design intent was geared towards providing sensitivity to textures and colors so as to ensure a more domestic and less institutional scale and character. Colored glass has been positioned strategically to allow the children to learn about color and demarcate time during the course of a day, month, season, and school year.

The facade is comprised of 2 levels of windows: one at adult eye height and one at a child's. The building and associated area, separate from the furniture, was constructed at a cost of \$10,950,981. Funding for this project was secured through Capital Reserve funds and a School Development Grant.



According to Marlene Lubinger, "Our Helping Hands Fund was established to assist uninsured and underinsured patients who cannot afford to pay for basic medical needs." This fund provides vital prescriptions, walkers, wheelchairs, tests and treatments, physician office visits, and transportation home or transportation to doctor appointments once they leave the hospital.

These patients may be clinic, outpatient or inpatients. Although some may qualify for charity care, charity care does not cover these needs nor include coverage for these necessary items or services after the patient leaves the hospital. Often, a patient's length of stay is longer because they cannot afford the necessary prescriptions or medical equipment to make the transition from hospital to home and continue their recovery.

Through the years, this fund has truly made a difference and has helped many people. In the past year, a 60-year-old woman was hospitalized and was totally paralyzed. The hospital successfully partnered with a local acute rehab facility to continue her care, and the transport costs were covered by the Fund.


In another case, the hospital was able to locate

a dialysis slot for a single, unemployed male who required dialysis 3 times per week. The Helping Hands Fund covered his medications for 30 days until he would quality for SSI or other programs.

Ms. Lubinger added, "The support for these needy patients is of tremendous benefit to them and helps to overcome insurmountable obstacles for their recovery."
