
LINDEN WINS \$1.1 MILLION FOR TRANSIT VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (DOT) has awarded the City of Linden a total of \$1,100,000 in the form of three grants, the largest amount awarded in North Jersey. The grants are specifically for the Transit Village Streetscape Grant (\$600,000), Local Aid Transit Village Grant (\$295,000), and the Municipal Aid Grant (\$205,000).

The City of Linden has been designated as a Transit Village by the DOT. The grants were derived from the program and will be used to revitalize the downtown area around the train station in order to promote the use of public transportation. The redevelopment is also focused on creating a pedestrian-friendly neighborhood.

The goals of the Transit Village Initiative is to bring more housing, business and people in the neighborhoods around transit stations. The scope of the multi-phase plan in Linden includes approximately a halfmile area. Improvements and enhancements to the train station are under way and will be followed by streetscaping. Planning stages for development of properties on Wood Avenue on both sides of the trestle as well as on Linden Avenue are moving forward.






SOEHL STUDENTS VISIT NASDAQ, WALL STREET **AND NY TIMES**





LINDEN FIRE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES \$2.4 MILLION FEDERAL GRANT

LINDEN, NJ - Four months after the Linden Fire Department faced layoffs of its firefighters due to budgetary constraints, U.S. Senator Robert Menendez (D-NJ) visited the department's headquarters to announce a federal grant award of \$2,406,684 to save 12 jobs in the department. The funding is awarded through the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) programs.

"Keeping firefighters on the job is critical to protecting the Linden community, and I am very pleased that this federal funding is coming directly to the Linden Fire Department during a difficult budgetary year," said Senator Menendez. "This not only helps the communities they serve, but it also helps maintain safer working conditions for our firefighters, who deserve nothing less than our best efforts to help them work as safely and effectively as possible."

"I'm extremely excited about this SAFER grant that will help us keep 12 firefighters. It couldn't have come at a better time," said Linden Mayor Richard Gerbounka. "Quite

frankly, it's a Godsend. I want to thank Senator Menendez for his aggressiveness in getting this grant for the City of Linden."

"This federal grant is a tremendous help to our department in keeping firefighters on duty to serve the residents of our community," said Linden Fire Chief Joseph Rizzo. "Senator Menendez has always been there to help our fire department, and I thank him for his helping us obtain this funding that means so much in keeping our residents safe."

"The City of Linden's firefighters have struggled to maintain proper staffing," said William Lavin, President of the New Jersey Fireman's Mutual Benevolent Association. "Senator Menendez's efforts here will go a long way, not only to keep Linden firefighters and

residents safe, but also in the surrounding areas and we are eternally grateful for his efforts."

"The firefighters of the Fireman's Mutual Benevolent Association are ready to respond to anything that happens in the communities we serve, and we greatly appreciate it when federal resources help communities like Linden keep firefighters working," said Firefighter Christopher Lukenda, Secretary of the New Jersey Fireman's Mutual Benevolent Association.

The highly competitive SAFER grant program provides funding directly to fire departments and volunteer firefighter organizations in order to help them increase the number of trained "front line" firefighters in their communities.





(above, l-r) Mayor Richard Gerbounka, Library Director Dennis Purves, Library Board President Doris Henel and Robert Gobel.







HAVING FUN WITH SCIENCE



In an academic year, ESL students are responsible for learning hundreds of science vocabulary terms while at the same time they are learning English. This can be difficult to navigate unless a series of scaffolding strategies are put in place. Under the guidance of ESL teacher, Danie Orelien-Armstead and teacher assistant Eglys Rodriguez, the ESL Summer Enrichment Program at School #9 will not only focus on building students' language skills of reading and writing but also on the development and application of skills in the area of scientific

literacy which includes speaking, listening, presenting, interpreting, reading and writing about science.

Every day, students will explore a science concept. On the first day of summer school, ELLs explore the sun and the clouds. Students investigated and conducted a scientific experiment on how water vapor is formed which condenses into water droplets to form clouds. Students were excited to learn that air temperature and water vapor played a big role in forming clouds.
