#### LINDEN FIRST IN U.S. WITH CHINESE EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Linden Public School district has signed an official agreement with The Office of Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) for Linden to be a model K-12 school district for the new Great Wall Chinese instructional program. Linden is the first model Great Wall Chinese K-12 school district in the United States. Two Great Wall Chinese Center teachers have already visited the district to set up the computer support and student accounts necessary to implement the program. Great Wall Chinese is a new Chinese teaching and learning system based on cutting edge network and multimedia technology. Great Wall Chinese mixes direct instruction with courseware technology, and uses a new management system for teachers to electronically monitor student progress over the Internet.

As part of the agreement, the Linden Public School district has already conducted its first workshop for Chinese teachers from around the Northeast held on October 22, 2011. The workshop attracted Chinese teachers from New Jersey, New York and Delaware. Attendees were introduced to the Great Wall Chinese system, and Great Wall Chinese trained teachers then demonstrated the various techniques using Linden students at the high and middle school level.

The Linden Public School District is now in its fifth year of teaching Chinese, providing instruction at all levels from grades 1 through 12, including the high school International Baccalaureate Program. The district has over 6,000 students with 4,773 in grades 1 to 12. Of those students, 25%, or 1,195, are studying Chinese.

The Linden Public School District is designated as a model district for Bilingual and ESL education by the New Jersey Department of Education. The District teaches six world languages including Spanish, French, German, Italian, Russian and Chinese. At the high school level, students regularly participate in exchange visits to the language country of origin, and host return visits to Linden. Linden High School has a formal partnership with the Xiamen Foreign Language School in Xiamen, China. Students from Linden have visited Xiamen three times, and students from Xiamen have visited Linden twice. Mutual exchange visits are again scheduled for this school year.

The study of Chinese as a world language in Linden, a city with few heritage Chinese residents, grew from a 2007 visit to China by Mrs. Alphonsina Paternostro, Linden's Supervisor of World Languages/Bilingual/ESL. Mrs. Paternostro attended the government sponsored "China Bridge" tour in 2007 visiting with key governmental and educational leaders seeking to promote the study of Chinese

in the United States. Mrs. Paternostro was recently honored by the New Jersey Principals and Supervisors Association, earning an award as the Visionary Supervisor of the Year for 2011.

The following year, Rocco Tomazic, then Linden's Assistant Superintendent, traveled to China on the 2008 "China Bridge". Then Linden Superintendent Mr. Joseph E. Martino authorized the expansion of the Chinese program and appointed Ms. JuPing Chen as a Program Advisor to help guide the program forward.

Linden has greatly benefited from its association with Hanban, the Great Wall Chinese Center, and Xiamen Foreign Language School. Hanban has provided thousands of dollars in free educational materials in each of the eleven schools in Linden. By being designated a model Great Wall Chinese district, Linden has obtained over \$15,000 worth of educational hardware and software free of charge, together with the services of highly trained specialists from China that has provided high quality professional development at no cost. The association with Xiamen Foreign Language School has allowed Linden students a safe and secure environment to interact with Chinese students and experience Chinese culture first hand.

"In these tough economic times, public school districts are challenged to do more with less," says Linden Superintendent Rocco Tomazic. "Great Wall Chinese is a perfect example of how a school system can partner with outside organizations to obtain high quality support at low cost, all with the object of significantly helping students move confidently into their future."





#### **GEORGE DORIN AWARDED LINDEN 2011 VETERAN OF THE YEAR**

George Dorin was born in Lakewood, Ohio on March 9, 1926. His parents moved east soon after his birth and settled in Newark, NJ where George attended public schools.

When George reached the age of 16, he was already aware of the effects of war since both of his older brothers, John with the Army Air Corp and Michael with the Army Paratroopers, were already serving in the Pacific Islands.

At this early age George's desire to serve brought him to the Marine recruiting station in Newark; however, when they learned that he had two brothers already serving and of his young age, they denied his request. George then tried

the Navy, which also because of his young age, contacted his mother who confirmed that she already had two sons serving. They turned him down as well.

Undaunted by setbacks, he joined a line at the Army recruiting station and begged his mother not to keep him from going. By June of 1944, at 17-1/2 years of age, he was in boot camp and getting ready to be sent overseas for combat.

George served with George Patton's Third Army and his unit, the 35th Division, was sent to Southern France where he engaged in the Battle of the Bulge. He saw combat in the Rhineland and at Bastogne, Belgium from November of

1944 until he was captured by the Germans on January 4, 1945.

On January 4th, his unit was engaged in battle from 4:00 a.m. to approximately 9:00 a.m. After 5 hours of battle, all but he and two others were either wounded or killed. They were taken prisoner by the Germans.

At first they were taken to a train tunnel for interrogation and were repeatedly punched in the face during that period of time. Then they were made to walk for 32 days to work on a railroad in Geralstein. These prisoners were repeatedly beaten and kicked in the back while working and beaten while marched through

They were then taken to a prison camp called Linberg 11B and put in solitary confinement for two days for missing a roll call. Following this imprisonment, they walked to a town called Mayen and were put into box cars for 5 days. During that time they were periodically strafed

Food was scarce – one loaf of bread and one inadequate that they suffered malnutrition.

sausage or one bowl of thin soup was supplied as a day's rations. There were at least 60 prisoners in each box car and everyone suffered from dysentery. The crowded conditions allowed only room enough for the prisoners to sit between each other's legs. One corner was used for the prisoners to defecate. They reached Stalag 4B after 32 days and food was so

George was processed and put in a barracks with some British prisoners where the unit (Continued on page 7.)



## GEORGE DORIN, VETERAN U.S. ARMY - WWII - POW, 1926 - 2001

worked on wood details. During this confinement, George suffered frostbite on his hands and ears as well as trench feet.

In June of 1945 his group was liberated by the Russians. He was first hospitalized at Camp Lucky Strike in France, and then taken to the States and received treatment at Inglan General Hospital, now known as Resorts International in Atlantic City for six months. He received continued treatment for two years following that at the Veterans Admin. in Newark, N.J.

George holds the following Medals of Honor: Bronze Star – POW – Good Conduct – European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign – WWII Victory and Combat Infantryman Badge.

In 1988, he was a recipient of the National Medal of Recognition by the United States to all former Prisoners of War at Ft. Dix, N.J.

A resident of Linden since 1965, he lived with his wife Maryann at 400 Morristown Road until he died in August of 2001. He is the father of two daughters, Carolyn Dorin-Ballard and Cathy Dorin-Lizzi, both of whom were coached in bowling by their Dad and became

professional athletes.

George was a member of the NJ Ex-Prisoners of War Chapter I, the Disabled American Veterans, Linden Moose and Union County Bowling Hall of Fame. He was a communicant of St. George Byzantine Church in Linden.

The members of Linden's Veteran organizations, American Legion, Catholic War Veterans of America, Linden Marine League, Marine Danowski, Detachment, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Vietnam Veterans of America and Veterans of Foreign Wars, all salute and honor George Dorin and all World War II Veterans who served their country to preserve world freedom.

#### CITY OF LINDEN BUSINESS COMMUNITY INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN A RUTGERS UNIVERSITY FOCUS GROUP ON NJ AMERICAN WATER UTILITY

Dr. Judy Shaw, Professor of environmental studies at the Rutgers University, Bloustein School of Public Planning and Policy, reached out to the Linden Business community to participate in a focus group discussing NJ American Water Utility service delivery and 2. How is potable water part of participant's associated water quality. Dr. Shaw is no stranger to the City of Linden and its business community. Prior to accepting the position at Rutgers University, Dr. Shaw was a senior member of the NJ Department of Environmental Protection and assisted the LEDC in expediting a Brownfield remediation report, processing, and grants for Brownfield contamination studies.

The goal of the project was to conduct research to understand how residential water customers feel about the quality of their water, what they understood about how the state of the systems' delivery infrastructure affects them, and how they garner information through digital media, or whether customers still rely on traditional media outlets (newspaper, radio and television) to learn about their water system.

research questions:

- 1. What is the customers' basic understanding of available potable water and its utility to general activities of daily life?
- daily living?
- 3. What is the value of potable water to families and benefits to the community?
- 4. How aware are customers of infrastructure (Water Delivery Systems) issues in NJ?
- 5. Are customers aware of the water infrastructures in NJ?
- 6. How do customers view responsibility for state residents for infrastructure improvements and maintenance?
- 7. How willing would customers be to accept increase in water bills to address infrastructure upgrades?
- 8. What is known of the economics of water distribution and overall capacity of this region to compete economically?
- 9. What public issues concern people?
- 10. How do people learn about issues?

- The focus group discussed the following 11. Where do water customers get information and what is their preferred social communication media?
  - 12. How often do people rely on Internet for information?
  - 13. Where do people go to research for information on issues?

Dr. Shaw praised the knowledge level of the Focus participants and found their feed back very valuable in understanding the water utility issues and providing a practical approach to addressing the issues.


Six students from Saints Mary & Elizabeth Academy participated in the Forensics Reading Competition that was held at Hillside Catholic Academy on November 16th.

#### **BUCKLE UP**

The most effective form of protection in a motor vehicle crash is your seat belt. Airbags work with your seat belt to protect you; they are not as effective alone and can increase your chance of injury when used without a seat belt. A ten second action we take for granted can save your life and your loved ones lives. Do you wear yours?

Over the past ten years, more than 2,000 unbuckled drivers and front seat passengers died on NJ roads. That's one person every other day. 700 unrestrained drivers and front passengers were thrown from their vehicles and perished on NJ roads. Crashes happen suddenly and many things happen almost at once. Your vehicle





stops abruptly, but you and others in your vehicle are still in motion. A seat belt helps to keep you in place limiting the opportunity of colliding with objects or people inside your vehicle. If you are not restrained you can become a dangerous projectile striking and injuring other passengers. It is possible to bounce around inside your vehicle striking your head and cause a traumatic brain injury. You can also be ejected from the vehicle you are in and land in the roadway where other cars may not see you. In many rollover crashes people who are restrained receive little or no injury and walk away from the accident. Seat belts not only protect you from death, but limit serious injury requiring long term care, time out of work and possible permanent physical or mental disability by half according to the Center for Disease Control (CDC). Per the CDC the lifetime cost of death and permanent physical injuries incurred while unrestrained was \$70 billion in 2005.

New Jersey seat belt law applies to all passenger vehicles required to be equipped with seat belts. In January 2010, the law was passed requiring all occupants to buckle up, or use appropriate child safety restraints, regardless of their seating position in a vehicle. The new law allows police to issue tickets to unbuckled rear seat occupants, 18 years old or older, as a secondary offense when a vehicle is stopped for another violation. As always, the driver and front seat passenger must be restrained or an officer can stop the vehicle and issue summons as a primary offense. Children up to age 8 or 80

pounds must ride in a safety or booster seat in rear of vehicle. If a child is under 8 years old, but over 80 pounds they must wear a seat belt anywhere in the vehicle. Passengers 8 to 18 must wear a seat belt anywhere inside the vehicle. More information about the seat belt law can be found at www.nj.gov.

According to The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's Unconscious Motivators and Situational Safety Belt Use report, most people use their seat belts. When they don't, they are usually in situations where they feel safe and ignore the risks described above. The biggest offenders are: teens, men, truck drivers and pickup drivers. What can you do? Take the time to buckle up. Use a positive approach when encouraging others to use their seat belts. Some examples are: wearing a seat belt helps you feel in control, because other people care about you and your safety, to be a good role model to your children, to be a good Don't be afraid to start a passenger. conversation or ask your friends to wear their seat belts. You might be surprised as to how well the conversation will go. They might be waiting for you to bring up the conversation and start a discussion.

Wearing your seat belt all the time is the best way to avoid a preventable injury during a motor vehicle crash. So many things on the road are out of our control; distracted or incapacitated drivers, road conditions, debris on roadway. Take charge of your own safety when driving and buckle up.


