

ARBOR DAY 2012 WILL CELEBRATE SPACE SHUTTLE TREE AND 150TH ANNIVERSARY



The City of Linden has been notified that it has been selected to receive one of the "Space Shuttle White Pines". The tree is being provided by the NJDEP Forest Service.

The Eastern White Pine seedling was grown from seeds that traveled aboard the space shuttle flight of April 4, 1997. Seeds from the New Jersey Forestry Tree Nursery were provided to NASA for their flight. The seeds traveled at 17,4000 M.P.H. for a distance of 1.4 million miles!

Once the seeds were returned to the New Jersey Forest Service, they were germinated at the program's greenhouse in Jackson as part of the Heritage Tree Program. Of particular note – the germination rate of White Pine seeds is usually 10-14 days. The seeds that traveled on the space shuttle germinated in half that time!

The Linden Shade Tree Commission has also planted fifteen Linden Trees in honor of the 150th Anniversary of the City of Linden. Five have been planted at the Linden Public Library, and one of each of the remaining 10 were planted in prominent locations in each of the 10 Wards of the City.

The Linden Shade Tree Commission is planning to hold an Arbor Day Celebration in early May of 2012 to dedicate these special trees. Plaques will be developed and installed over the next few months for both the 150th Anniversary Trees and the Space Shuttle Tree.

The Shade Tree commission has selected a location at the Linden Public Library to plant the Space Shuttle Tree so that it will be accessible for all citizens to admire and reflect upon.







SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS VISITS CHINA

The Superintendent of Schools in Linden, Dr. School Principal Forum for middle school presentation was videotaped for wider use in Rocco Tomazic, was invited to visit China on December 25, 2011 to attend the 30th anniversary of the Xiamen Foreign Language School in Xiamen, China. The Xiamen Foreign Language School is a partner school with Linden High School. Together, Xiamen and Linden are joint Confucius Classrooms under the Confucius Institute at Rutgers University.

During the visit in Xiamen, besides attending the day-long anniversary ceremonies, Dr. Tomazic also made a presentation at a Middle

principals from around Fujian Province. He spoke on the topic of managing American schools and the means to select school textbooks. During the stay in Xiamen he also made a presentation at the Confucius Institute at Xiamen University. He spoke on the topic of managing the American classroom to Chinese college students preparing to teach Chinese in the United States, drawing comparisons between Chinese and American classroom practices. Student questions were plentiful and the

China.

Following the visit in Xiamen, Dr. Tomazic took the train north to Fuzhou to visit Fuzhou High School No. 3. This trip traced out the route for the upcoming visit by Linden High School students this March and April. While at Fuzhou High School No. 3, Dr. Tomazic gave a presentation to the students on applying to American universities emphasizing those qualities desired beyond academic proficiency, including community involvement, athletics and school leadership. A separate session was held with Fuzhou High School No. 3 students who will visit Linden High School later this month during Chinese New Year.

Designated as a model district for the Great Wall Chinese language program, after returning to Beijing Dr. Tomazic met with Dr. Song Jihua of Great Wall Chinese Center and Dr. Liu Bing, the Deputy Director of the Division of Teaching Materials, Office of Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) to discuss the continuing implementation of the Chinese program in Linden and the activities of the Confucius Classroom. Dr. Tomazic also gave a lecture at Beijing Normal University to aspiring teachers on how to run a Chinese language program in America, emphasizing the integration of language and culture.

The Linden School District is in its fifth year of teaching Chinese, providing instruction at all levels from grades 1 to 12, including the high school International Baccalaureate Program. Twenty-five percent of the students in grades 1 through 12 are studying Chinese.

REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR LINDEN DAY CAMP STARTING JAN. 11, 2012

Linden Day Camps will run from June 25th through August 16th this year with hours of operation from 8:00am to 5:00pm.

The fee of \$350.00 per child can be paid all at once or in monthly \$100.00 increments.

You can register your child for a Linden Day Camp by:

- A. Going to the City of Linden website at www.linden-nj.org and clicking onto CommunityPass. Follow the directions and include a payment of \$350.00 per child at the time of sign up or in \$100.00 monthly increments by submitting your Visa or MasterCard number. You can sign your child up for camp utilizing this method 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- B. If you do not have a computer, or do not have a community pass account, you may manually register your children at any City of Linden Recreation Center beginning, January 11, 2012 through May 25, 2012, from 9:00am to 4:00pm at the Community Center Building, 605 So. Wood Ave. or the JTG Recreation Center, 330 Helen St. or from 9:00am to 9:00pm at the Linden Multi Purpose Center, 1025 John St.

Remember, you may only register your own child. When registering manually, you may pay the \$350.00 registration fee all at once or in \$100.00 monthly increments, by cash, check, money order or by Visa or Master Card. Completed applications should include a copy of

Registration will take place between January your child's birth certificate and parents should be prepared to show 2 proofs of residency such as a driver's license or utility bill.

> It is mandatory that each camper's parent/guardian/representative attend orientation meeting - date given at sign-up.

> At the orientation, camper's Day Camp Information and Day Camp Handbooks will be distributed. If you do not attend, your child will not be allowed to begin Camp. Additionally, all necessary medical and release forms will be discussed. You will also be able to have any of your questions or concerns answered. It is important to note that Open House Orientation is a mandatory meeting for each Camper's parent/ guardian/representative. Failure to attend Orientation will result in your child not being admitted to Day Camp on the first day.



LINDEN HIGH SCHOOL EVENT CELEBRATES CHINESE NEW YEAR

Linden High School celebrated Chinese New Year (Year of the Dragon) on Monday, January 23, 2012. The event was held in the school auditorium and featured Linden students in a variety of cultural and language performances.

Joining the celebration were twenty-six visiting Chinese high school students who were on an exchange visit to Linden High School from January 20-29, 2012. The students are from the Xiamen Foreign Language School and Fuzhou High School No. 3 of Fujian Province, China.

The morning performance featured Linden High School students in a variety of Chinese events including song, dance and music. Of particular interest was the bringing to life of two Chinese lions by Richard Gerbounka, Mayor, City of Linden and Susan L. Hudak, President, Linden Board of Education. Also featured was the Chinese dragon teams performed by the Linden High School Navy Junior ROTC cadets.

Following the morning ceremony a traveling contingent of Linden High School students, together with the visiting Chinese exchange students, toured district middle schools and elementary schools to spark enthusiasm for the Chinese program. The schools had already been decorated with lanterns and other student-made crafts to celebrate Chinese New Year.

The Linden Public School District is in its fifth year of teaching Chinese, providing instruction at all levels from grades 1 to 12, including the high school International Baccalaureate Program. Twenty-five percent of

the students in grades 1 through 12 are studying Chinese, which represents nearly 975 students.

The Chinese students and teachers lived with host families in Linden and had a welcome reception at Linden High School. Linden High School students will be returning the exchange visit to Xiamen and Fuzhou in late March, early April of this year.

The Xiamen Foreign Language School is a partner school with Linden High School. Together, Xiamen and Linden are joint Confucius Classrooms under the leadership of the Confucius Institute at Rutgers University.

The Linden Public School district has signed an official agreement with The Office of Chinese Language Council International (Hanban) for Linden to be a model K-12 school district for the new Great Wall Chinese instructional program. Linden is the first model Great Wall Chinese K-12 school district in the United States. Two Great Wall Chinese Center teachers have already visited the district to set up the computer support and student accounts necessary to implement the program.

Great Wall Chinese is a new Chinese teaching and learning system based on cutting edge network and multimedia technology. Great Wall Chinese mixes direct instruction with courseware technology, and uses a new management system for teachers to electronically monitor student progress over the Internet.


As part of the agreement, the Linden Public School district has already conducted its first

workshop for Chinese teachers from around the Northeast in October 2011.

The workshop attracted Chinese teachers from New Jersey, New York and Delaware. Attendees were introduced to the Great Wall Chinese system, and Great Wall Chinese trained teachers then demonstrated the various techniques using Linden students at the high school and middle school level.

The Linden Public School District is now in its fifth year of teaching Chinese, providing instruction at all levels from grades 1 to 12, including the high school International Baccalaureate Program. The district has over 6,000 students with 4,773 in grades 1 to 12. Of those students, 25%, or 1,195, are studying Chinese.

The Linden Public School District is designated as a model district for Bilingual and ESL education by the New Jersey Department of Education. The District teaches six world languages including Spanish, French, German, Italian, Russian and Chinese. At the high school level, students regularly participate in exchange visits to the language country of origin, and host return visits to Linden. Linden High School has a formal partnership with the Xiamen Foreign Language School in Xiamen, China. Students from Linden have visited Xiamen three times. and students from Xiamen have visited Linden twice. 


