Linden Public Schools are pleased to announce that Mrs. Barbara June Brady has been nominated for the New Jersey Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance Teacher of the Year Award. This award honors outstanding leaders in the field. Our faculty and students feel that she truly deserves the recognition for what she has done with our dance program here at Linden High School. Our students are more healthy and fit for being in her class, but more importantly, they are better people for having her influence in their life.

Mrs. Brady was born and raised in Linden, NJ and graduated from Kean College of NJ in 1995 with a Bachelor of Arts in Health and Physical Education. She began her teaching career at Franklin High School and Sampson G. Smith Middle School in Somerset, NJ where she taught Physical Education, Dance and Health. During her time there, she was the Assistant Coach of the Varsity Field Hockey team, the Dance Team Coach and choreographer of the annual school musical.

In 1998, Barbara began teaching at McManus Middle School in Linden, NJ and was transferred to the high school the following year to teach Physical Education and Dance.

In 2001, Barbara began the full time dance program at Linden High School where she now has over 125 students enrolled. Each year, these dancers perform in an annual spring dance concert where they showcase their talents in a variety of dance styles. The LHS Dance Company has performed throughout the state of NJ since 1998, entertaining diverse audiences which include workshops for special needs children and seminars and dance performances at the annual NJAHPERD (NJ Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance) Teachers' Convention.

Before her teaching career began, Barbara was a professional dancer, who was on replacement for the Broadway shows Cats and Jerome Robbins' Broadway; and performed with the New Jersey Ballet Company, the Joffrey

Ballet (NYC), and the NJ State Opera. She also performed and choreographed for the Cumberland County Playhouse in Tennessee. She sits on the Union County Cultural & Heritage Programs Advisory Board and is listed in Who's Who in Entertainment and Who's Who Among American High School Teachers. A Papermill Playhouse Rising Star Award Nominee and the recipient of many NJ ACT (Achievement in Community Theater) Awards, Barbara received the NJAHPERD Dance Education Award as a senior in college and was awarded a medallion from Governor Whitman for promoting culture in the state of NJ.

Her credits are ongoing as she continues her interest for all students' growth and accomplishments. It is her passion and love for her students as well as her art that keeps her striving for and getting success.

Elizabeth "Liz" Garcia, Public Affairs Manager, Infineum USA L.P. will retire in January with over 41 years of combined Infineum and Exxon service.

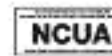

She chairs the Union County College Board of Governors, is a trustee and vice president of the Linden Industrial Association, and a director of the Union County Workforce Investment Board, the Union County Alliance Board, and the Linden Economic Development Corporation. Liz is an active volunteer in the community and enjoys being a speaker at science and engineering career days to encourage students, especially women, to pursue careers in those fields.

The program has helped over thirteen thousand residents to date.

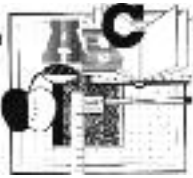

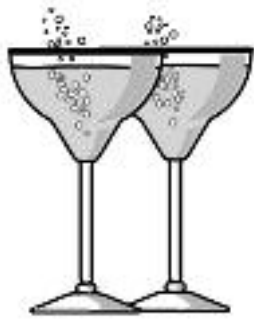
