LINDEN EMS ADVISES ON POOL SAFETY

lazy days at the pool running and splashing around. Being prepared for emergencies at personal and public pools, not only protects your family and friends, but means an enjoyable time for everyone. Per the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, 300 children under 5 drown in swimming pools nationwide. 2000 children in the same age group are treated for submersion injuries. These incidents happen in seconds and are silent. Children do not splash or make noise to alarm anyone. Being alert, learning and practicing water safety, and being properly equipped can help avert emergencies. Below you will find tips and recommendations to make your families and friends' experience in the water safe and enjoyable.

Many of these "rules" may seem obvious, but it is important to practice them constantly for them to be effective. Never leave a child alone in or around the pool; always have adult supervision. If you are having a party, make sure there is an adult appointed to monitor the pool. Teach your children how to swim and about water safety basics. Keep swimmers



END OF A LINDEN LANDMARK

In November 2009 at 1215 North Wood Avenue, the house and six car garage on this property were demolished. Anyone passing this area, just past St. Georges Avenue, would be aware of this gracious house, sitting on a slight hill, surrounded by beautiful evergreen trees and bushes. The house was built in the late 1700's as a farmhouse on a farm that extended to St. Georges Ave and to the railroad tracks. This area was part of the Linden landscape for many years.

Some of the early residents, according to records, were Charles and Catherine Schoppaul, Augustus C. Dellogg, Samuel Osborn, Aaron J. Thompson, and Silar Tappim. Known Linden families who also occuppied the property since 1915 were Albert Weber, Clarence H. Winans and Albina and Nicholas Palermo.

Frank and Palma, owners of the Villani Bus Company, purchased the property from Mr. Palermo in the fall of 1952. Many happy years were enjoyed at the "Hill", as Frank called it. He enjoyed his huge vegetable garden while his wife Palma Villani planted flowers and bushes. In 1957, a room with a ramp was built in the rear of the house to allow for wheelchair access for their youngest son, "Tot", who was paralyzed in

an automobile accident returning to Ft Dix. In November 1960, Palma Villani died suddenly of a heart attack. In 1961, Frank Villani Sr. married again to Anna. Frank Villani died in June 1984. Anna Villani was the last to occupy the house and eventually the property was sold to a builder who will build 8 houses on the land.

Frank and Palma Villani had seven children; Diodato "Dee", Rosalie, Joanna "Jay", Carmine, Carmella "Nina", Francesco "Tot", and Aida. Frank and Anna Villani had one son, Francisco "Frank".

Records show that the McGillvrary, Wozniak, and Winans families occupied the property and the land adjacent to it. This extended to St. Georges Ave and down near S. Wood Ave. The poind in the Woodrow Wilson Memorial Park was known as the McGillvrary Pond. The pond was used as a watering hole for farm animals in summer and an ice skating pond in winter.

Deed of April 28, 1915 declared John P. and Ella M. Winans sold the property to Albert Weber. In Jun2 29, 1926 Albert Weber, a widower, sold the property to Clarence H. Winans. On November 17, 1934, the Linden Trust Company of NJ sold the rear plot of land to Clarence H. Winans.

On July 22, 1935, another parcel of land was sold by Wesley Collins to C.H. Winans Co. Eventually parcels of the land were sold to the Sunnyside Gardens Co.

Records of the property dating back to 1898 show that the house was rebuilt at that time. Records do not show who occupied the property before that time.

LINDEN'S SCHOOL #4 INTRODUCES PROGRAM READY, SET, READ!

Linden's School #4 has been given an in the area of literacy instruction. amazing opportunity to pair with the New Jersey Parent Involvement Resource Center to bring the program Ready, Set, Read to their school community. As part of the school's unified plan, parent involvement is an essential component that bridges the gap toward student success. With this vision in mind, the basic skills teachers, Reina Irizarry-Clark, Christine Messina, and Lindsay Filler, volunteered to implement this literacy program. In addition, child care is provided by School #4 faculty and staff volunteers.

The program was designed to assist parents with development and reinforcement of literacy skills for their children. LINDEN MANUFACTURER, IS NEW CHAIRMAN OF THE NEW JERSEY STATE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE




