### **TWO FREE CHILDREN'S CONCERTS** FOR SPRING AT LINDEN LIBRARY




# KIWANIS CLUB OF LINDEN TO SPONSOR "TASTE OF LINDEN" FOR LINDEN'S HURRICANE SANDY VICTIMS

On October 29, 2012 the landscape of our East Coast changed including the town of Linden, NJ. Along with sustained power outages, and severe tree damage, a 15–foot storm surge generated from the Arthur Kill hit the Tremley Point area. At least 25 homes were severely damaged. The 7th and 8th Wards needed the most assistance, but our entire community was touched by Sandy's pain. Linden's business, industrial, and residential communities were changed.

what had to be done and we applaud them. FEMA and many support services were available, and local fundraising occurred. To assist Linden victims of Sandy, a relief fund through a non-profit 501c3 organization that operates Linden's food pantry has been set up: LINCS – Linden Interfaith Network for Community Service, Inc.

We, the Kiwanis Club of Linden, did what we could as individuals to assist but, collectively, we too wanted to do more. The community felt the warmth in 2012 and, as 2013 continues, we wanted to continue to spread the warmth and word. Our current Kiwanis President, Ben Sheedy, thought a "Taste of Linden" could



promote our restaurants, businesses, get the community together, provide resources for emergencies, and also assist our club in achieving our mission: To change the world one child, one community at a time.

# **TEXAS SCHOOLS HELP LINDEN VICTIMS OF HURRICANE SANDY**

From over 1,500 miles away students and staff at Allen High School and the Marion Elementary School in Allen, Texas watched as Hurricane Sandy battered the east coast and especially their longtime friends in Linden, New Jersey. As the storm raged on text messages from concerned staff at Allen High School checked on the safety of their colleagues in Linden.

Underscoring the special relationship the

schools share, Allen High School PALS, under the charge of JD Walker, and the students and faculty of the Marion Elementary School in Allen, with Principal Johnna Walker, have raised and donated \$1,700 to help those Linden High School students and their families most affected by Hurricane Sandy. In a comment from Linden's program originator and advisor Joe Cataline, "I am greatly appreciative of the gift and blown away by the concern and generosity of the Allen community". Mirroring much of the state, the City of Linden suffered 99% power outages lasting many days, multitudes of downed trees and wires, blocked roadways, and gasoline shortages. However, eleven students and their families at Linden High School, living in the Tremely Point section of town, lost most

of their possessions and in some instances their homes due to severe flooding. The monies donated by the Allen students and staff will be shared with those students and their families attempting to rebuild their lives.

Following the 911 tragedy, what began as an opportunity for diverse students from different parts of the country to share their fears and concerns, grew into a sister school relationship spanning the last 12 years. Over those years videoconferencing technology has permitted students at Linden High School and Allen High School in Texas to share views and regional perspectives on topics like politics, local/world events, and national disasters. Students as well as staff have visited each other's schools and have created lasting friendships and bonds.

# LINDEN SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Submitted by Bryan Tomko The Linden Special Improvement District (SID) Committee is proud to provide this update on current and ongoing efforts to improve, beautify and support the Downtown Business District. Last year the committee tackled a few large projects aimed at improving the overall look and feel of the North Wood Avenue business and shopping area with an eye toward cleanliness and curb-appeal. The replacement of all existing awnings which overhang many of our Wood Avenue store fronts is just about complete with only a handful of awnings waiting to be hung. The old awnings had been in place for approximately 14 years and were beginning to show signs of age and wear therefore a freshening was certainly in order. The Committee also had the sidewalks in the entirety of the business district cleaned and power washed. Keeping with the "Spring Cleaning" initiative, we also ordered all new garbage receptacles with half the costs being shared by the City of Linden's Clean Community Grant funds.

On the horizon for this year, the Committee

# **CHINESE NEW YEAR CELEBRATION**


Linden Public Schools celebrated Chinese New Year in February. Students participated in a variety of Chinese events including songs by Linden Public School children, the Renaissance Chinese Opera Society from Chatham Square of New York, the Dragon and Lion dance performed by the Linden High School NJROTC, Linden High School award winning Dance Company performed the traditional Chinese ribbon and fan dance. Musical selections were provided by the Linden High School orchestra. The schools of Linden have already been decorated with lanterns and other student-made crafts to celebrate Chinese New Year.

The Linden Public School District is in its sixth year of teaching Chinese, providing instruction at all levels from grades 1 to 12, including the high school International Baccalaureate Program. Chinese is one of the critical languages identified by the U.S. Department of State. Linden High School welcomed 13 exchange students and two teachers from Xiamen Foreign Language School in China on February 4, 2013. The 13 students stayed with host families for a week. Linden students will go on their return visit to Xiamen in April. Linden students will stay at the Xiamen School. Linden will have the opportunity to be dressed in the school's white jackets and blue pants, and the Linden students will be partnered with their Chinese student that they hosted and attended classes like Chinese grammar, calligraphy and Tai chi. Classes are from early morning to late night.

The Xiamen Foreign Language School is a partner school with Linden High School. Together, Xiamen and Linden are joint Confucius Classrooms under the leadership of the Confucius Institute at Rutgers University. The Linden Public Schools is also a model district for the use of the Great Wall Chinese Program in the United States.

# **STUDENTS ASKED TO JOIN THE DISCUSSION**

Law Explorer Post 629 is currently working on a project in the aftermath of the Sandy Hook Elementary School massacre in Newtown, Connecticut. The youth Explorers believe that students should be discussing school safety not in terms of any political motivations, but in a forum where students can talk with other students in an attempt to try to better understand and come to terms with why this seemingly senseless act took place. The project, currently entitled "What can be done to Prevent School Shootings: A Discussion by Students" involves interviewing other youth ages 11-20 and videotaping their responses to a series of questions. The responses will then be edited for time and will be used to create a video montage which will highlight the sentiment of the larger youth population on the issue. The Explorers' idea is to present the completed video in a public forum and after the video have a roundtable discussion identifying the possible causes of the large-scale school violence, how school violence can be prevented and how students themselves can make a difference. The dates for the final

presentation will be in April but no dates have yet been determined.

Since December of 1983, the City of Linden has administered the Linden Emergency Response System Program for the elderly, physically handicapped, medically disabled and the socially isolated of Linden. To date more than 500 Linden recipients have taken advantage of the 24 hour monitoring service and we presently serve approximately one hundred-fifty area residents.

The LERS unit is an easy to use wireless transmitter which becomes a 24 hour companion and a direct link to safeguarding one's health and safety. One press of the button is all it takes to notify the central station that an emergency condition exists and within minutes, an ambulance and emergency personnel are at the scene. Besides having the transmitter and emergency help immediately, your medical profile is kept on file and is at the disposal of emergency personnel.

The City of Linden has purchased the emergency units for the subscriber. The subscriber in turn pays \$12.00 a month monitoring fee and charges for the installation.


The Linden Emergency Response System, administered through the Department of Public Property and Community Services, is an invaluable service available to Linden residents.






