The City of Linden has launched a Facebook page in an effort to better communicate with residents and provide yet another source of information for activities and happenings in and around the community. For the past few weeks the City has been adding posts to their site with the goal of promoting local events and highlighting the various services and departments.

“Utilizing social media provides us with another tool to share information with City residents,” said Linden Mayor Richard Gerbounka. Across the country cities large and small are using social media sites like Facebook, YouTube and Twitter to do everything from providing updates about community events to sharing information about city services.

The Linden Police department also expects to utilize the Facebook page. Videos captured by the City's red-light safety cameras program have

been posted as a reminder to pay attention, watch the traffic signals, slow down and obey the law. The City recently posted a devastating drunk driving red-light running collision which was captured by four red-light safety cameras at the intersection of Park Ave and Edgar Road.

“These videos not only help us educate the public about how devastating red-light running can be, but will also hopefully aid in our police work by allowing us to post images and videos of individuals wanted in connection with crimes,” said Sgt. Babulski. “We are looking forward to using this new resource to enhance public safety in the community and provide yet another way to keep our residents informed.”

Remember you are never too young to make a difference.

When Alex, who was diagnosed with childhood cancer just before her first birthday, was four, she told her parents she wanted to set up a front-yard lemonade stand. Her plan: to give the money to doctors to help them find a cure. Her first "Alex's Lemonade Stand" raised an astonishing \$2,000 in one day. While bravely fighting her own cancer, Alex continued to set up lemonade stands every year. As news spread of the remarkable girl so dedicated to helping other sick children, people everywhere were inspired to start their own lemonade stands – donating proceeds to her cause.

Linden residents will host an Alex's Lemonade Stand on Saturday, October 13, 2012 from 11AM-2PM at 216 W. Blancke Street. In conjunction with this stand the Linwood will be selling paper lemons on behalf of our team "Gabriella's Lemon Ladies".

This Alex's Lemonade Stand will be a family affair complete with 7-year-old Gabriella, her mom Mary and aunt Kathie. What started out as finding a lemon decorated table cloth at a clearance event has been transformed into a family life lesson. The family feels that it's the perfect opportunity to show Gabriella that you are never too young to make a difference and that it can be easy to help others through simple actions. Gabriella is looking forward to sharing the day with several of her classmates and fellow Girl Scouts and raising funds to help find a cure for all kids with cancer.

Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (ALSF) emerged from the front yard lemonade stand of cancer patient Alexandra "Alex" Scott (1996-2004). Since Alex held that first stand, the

Foundation bearing her name has evolved into a national fundraising movement, complete with thousands of supporters across the country carrying on her legacy of hope. To date, Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation, a registered 501(c)3 charity, has raised more than \$55 million toward fulfilling Alex's dream of finding a cure, funding over 250 research projects nationally. This program fosters the study of the German and English languages, increases intercultural awareness and understanding among German and American youth and forges long term friendships.

With more than 700 active school partnerships throughout Germany and the United States, G.A.P.P. is the central youth exchange link between American and German secondary school students. Each year more than 5,000 American students and teachers visit their partners in Germany and 8,000 German students and teachers are hosted by American families and schools, making the program one of the

largest and most important people-to-people connections between the U.S. and Germany.

The Linden High School G.A.P.P. exchange program was started by German teacher Mrs. Mary Turbett. The first exchange occurred during the 2001-2002 school year. To date, Linden High School has had six successful exchanges with their partner school in Butzbach, Germany enabling over 100 Linden students the opportunity to live and study abroad.

Linden High School 12th grader Ryan Bertani, who attended the celebration with his parents and participated in the exchange program last year, said "This was a life changing experience for me. Originally my plan was to study German for three years but after meeting my host family, the Steins, I am anxious to become fluent. 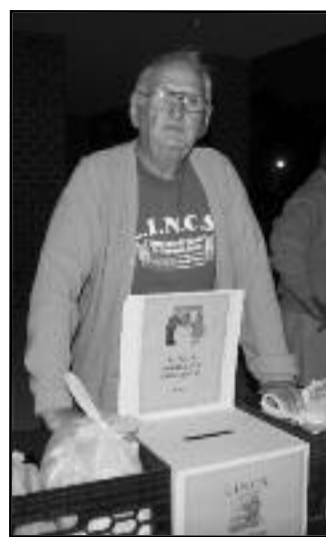
