



## **IMPAIRED DRIVING ENFORCEMENT CRACKDOWN TO BE CONDUCTED** LOCALLY AS PART OF STATEWIDE CAMPAIGN

Police Department kicked off the summer 2012 "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" campaign with three drunk driving arrests over the first weekend. The campaign began August 17 and runs through September 3, during which local and state law enforcement officers will conduct sobriety checkpoints and roving patrols, looking for motorists who may be driving while intoxicated.

A concentrated national effort, the campaign helps to raise awareness about the dangers of

Law enforcement officers from the Linden drinking and driving through high-visibility yourself and on the road, in danger." enforcement and public education tools, including posters, banners and mobile video display signs. Launched nationally in 1999, the program works to combat drunk driving during some of the busiest travel times of the year, including the Labor Day holiday period.

> "Many people believe that after a few drinks they're still safe to drive," said Gary Poedubicky, Acting Director of the Division of Highway Traffic Safety. "Even one drink can impair your judgment and reaction time, putting



In 2010 alcohol-impaired fatalities accounted for 20 percent of New Jersey's motor vehicle fatalities. As part of the initiative, the Division of Highway Traffic Safety provides grants to local law enforcement agencies throughout the state to run the two-week campaign.

"During the two week campaign last summer, our department arrested 13 drivers for driving under the influence," said Linden Police Traffic Bureau Commander Sergeant Michael Babulski. "We have had a great start so far this summer, and I am confident that our officers will continue to locate and arrest impaired drivers and keep the public safe."

Law enforcement agencies participating in the Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2012 crackdown offer the following advice:

- If you plan to drink, designate a driver, someone who will not drink alcohol, before going out.
- Take mass transit, a taxi or ask a sober friend to drive you home.
- Spend the night where the activity is held.
- Report impaired drivers to law enforcement. In New Jersey, drivers may dial #77 to report a drunk or aggressive driver.
- Always buckle up, every ride, regardless of your seating position in the vehicle. It's your best defense against an impaired driver.
- If you're intoxicated and traveling on foot, the safest way to get home is to take a cab or have a sober friend or family member drive you to your doorstep.

## LINDEN PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT DESIGNATED "HIGH PERFORMING" BY NEW JERSEY

The Linden Public Schools is proud to announce that the district has met the requirements of the NJ Department of Education's (NJDOE) Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) review and has been designated as a "high performing" school district. This designation results from an extensive review of five areas: instruction and program, fiscal management, operations, personnel, and governance. The QSAC Review requires large Process amounts of documentation to rate school districts on more than 500 factors.

Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Rocco Tomazic said the "High Performing District" designation is something that we are very proud about and is the result of much time, hard work, and collaboration among all of our stakeholders." The district received the news in a letter from Bari A. Erlichson, Chief Performance Officer at the NJDOE. As a result of this designation, NJDOE Commissioner Christopher Cerf will recommend to the NJ State Board of Education that the Linden Public School District be certified as providing a thorough and efficient system of education. The

certification is for a period of three years when the district will undergo its next QSAC review.

Linden has eleven schools (one high school, two middle schools and eight elementary schools). All schools are operating clear of any sanctions from the NJ Department of Education.

The news of being a high performing district arrived in tandem with the March 2012 Cycle II High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) results for Linden High School. Linden High School scores in Mathematics went up 1.4% and Language Arts Literacy went up 5.3%.

Linden High School HSPA scores have improved each year over the past three years in both Language Arts Literacy and Mathematics. Linden High School's rate of HSPA improvement has exceeded that of the state average and the district factor group of high schools similar to Linden in socio-economic status.

HSPA Math (Statewide), 3 years = +6.6%;

HSPA Language Arts Literacy (Statewide),

3 years = +7.9%;

HSPA Math (DFG B), 3 years = +8.5%;

HSPA Language Arts Literacy (DFG B),

3 years = +12.7%;

HSPA Math (Linden), 3 years = +10.1%;

HSPA Language Arts Literacy (Linden), 3 years = +18.5%

Linden High School also received notification this summer that eight 2012 graduating seniors earned the coveted International Baccalaureate Diploma for their work at Linden High School. This represents the highest number of diplomas earned by Linden students since the IB program was established at the school ten years ago.
