

Message from the President WAITING FOR THE GAS METER MAN

Years ago I read a short book written by Richard Maybury entitled "Whatever Happened to Justice?". It was a great read, thought provoking and impacts my life still to this day. Maybury introduces in his book two profoundly simple moral laws which if followed will help our families, our

towns, our businesses, our country and our world return to a more moral path.

One of Maybury's two simple laws is "Do all you have agreed to do". Sounds easy.... but it's not. I think back in my own life last week of well intended promises not kept: "I'll do that later today" and not do it; "I'll see you for lunch at noon" and then arrive at 12:15pm; "I'll pay you tomorrow" when what I really mean is sometime soon.

So when Elizabethtown Gas Company tells my new tenant that she needs to be at home as they will be at her building to read-over the gas meter between 8 am and noon, they have an obligation to be there. Unfortunately, my experience over many years as a landlord has shown me that they too often just don't show up. No phone call from them: Nothing. Later when my disappointed, new tenant calls back in she's told "we had to correct a gas emergency that day but we can re-schedule that appointment for next Tuesday between 8 am and noon unless you'd prefer the afternoon from noon till 4pm?"

Duhhhhhh...... what's the matter with these guys! My tenant had to stay at home and take a half day off from work to meet the meter reading guy and then he doesn't show up nor even call. Sadly, this is not an abnormal or isolated incident. To make it even more unbelievable, Elizabethtown Gas Company regularly reads her same meter with a remote reader which gives them accurate readings even as their guy is driving by in his van. When I recently quizzed an Elizabethtown Gas guy I was told informally that that department continues to be understaffed and that this read-over policy is outdated. And it ain't over yet.... Elizabethtown Gas even refuses to accept our meter reading visually confirmed by both landlord and tenant. Hey gas guys...maybe it's time for a policy review?



UC COLLEGE OFFERS FREE TRAINING TO EMPLOYEES OF LOCAL BUSINESSES

OUCH..THOSE STAPLES HURT

The metal staples that attach the paper RPD and garage sale signs to the new trees on Irving Street probably won't kill them but it sure doesn't help them either. Humans have skin and trees have bark and they both serve a similar purpose. Once our skin is punctured it bleeds and then needs to heal in order to prevent disease from entering our body: it's the same with our friends the trees. A healthy body usually doesn't have difficulty healing from a small wound but a body that's under stress is often a different story

Planting a good sized tree takes lots of labor and money. It's tough enough to begin with for a tree living next to our streets; we need to offer them respect and courtesy and help to nurture and treasure them. If we have no other choice and we must attach a public notice to a tree's trunk, instead of a staple gun let's ask our Traffic Department and our residents to use a nursery stretch tie that won't harm the bark and is also re-useable. We might also consider an elastic strap like those that come with Halloween masks which would also be re-useable.


BILL CLADEK - OUTSTANDING RAHWAY RESIDENT

FAMILY HISTORY

Born in 1945 at Saint Mary's Hospital in Orange, New Jersey, Bill Cladek has been a lifelong Rahway resident. Bill's family came to New Jersey in the mid 1800's from Austria-Hungary and settled in Rahway in a home on the corner of Scott Avenue and Price Street. The house is still noted in certain historic registries as the home of Colonel John J. Cladek who served in the 3rd, 5th, 30th and 35th New Jersey Volunteer Infantry from 1861 through 1865. Colonel Cladek served as second in command to General Sherman and was introduced to President Lincoln during his time with the New Jersey Volunteers.

PROFESSIONAL

Bill began his professional career as a teacher at Rahway High School in 1967 and retired in 2006 after suffering a heart attack. During his time at Rahway High School Bill taught History and English, was head of the English and Special Education Departments. Bill also spent time as an administrator. After teaching generations of Rahway High students, many new faculty members would ask him how he maintained order in his classroom. Bill's



advice to them was, "teaching can be so easy and fun, but you have to be the boss, not the students friend". For his style of teaching, Bill was loved by students and faculty alike and has been missed at Rahway High School since his retirement.

Bill also loves coaching sports and was head coach of the Rahway High School basketball, soccer and tennis teams and was a professional tennis coach for twenty nine years. But his true passion has always been baseball. Bill has been a professional umpire for forty years and even umpired several professional games during the umpires strike in the late 1970's. Inducted into the College Baseball Umpires Association hall of fame, Bill continues to umpire college and high school games and is preparing to umpire two New Jersey state championships.

CONCLUSION

To those who know Bill Cladek, he's a charismatic friend, teacher, husband and father that has truly made a difference here in Rahway.




