RICK PROCTOR WINS MAYORAL RACE - RAHWAY DEMOCRATS SWEEP Jim Kennedy steps down after 20 years at the helm

More than 1,500 votes separated winner from loser in our town's recent mayoral election. Democratic Freeholder Rick Proctor, and now mayor-elect, received a total of 4,172 votes to Republican challenger Patrick Casio's 2,628 votes.

Rick Proctor ran his campaign in part on a pledge to continue redevelopment efforts within downtown and its outlying areas that were initiated by retiring mayor Jim Kennedy.

Incumbents Nancy Saliga, Sal Mione and James Baker held their Council At-Large seats by soundly defeating Republican challengers James Grady, Kevin Retcho and Jeffrey Spatola. Former Councilman and Republican candidate Larry Bodine were defeated by Democrat Bob Rachlin in the 1st Ward.







VIRGINIA DAD MOVES TO RAHWAY AND MAKES HIS MARK AT DZ MOTORS!

Stanley Azor's family is in Virginia, but when the recession hit he did what he had to do to provide for them. They did come back until harsh economic times hit and Stanley evaluated the situation. "The rich get richer in a downturn economy










because they're the ones who have enough money to take advantage of the cheap prices," he reasoned, "And when the rich get rich - they buy fancy cars." And at DZ Motors, not only are the cars fancy-schmancy but they can be bought for the lowest prices within a thousand miles because their focus is on volume, not profit margin. While competitors may rely on an \$8,000 markup - DZ Motors is happy with a \$1,500 profit.

LAKE AT RAHWAY RIVER PARK GETS A MUCH OVERDUE CLEANING!

It took a team of employees from Aquatic Analysts, Inc. of Middleville New Jersey six or seven days in mid October to remove an overgrown mass of emerging vegetation and lily pads from the lake at Rahway River Park. Three county dump trucks made five trips each day with the debris and vegetation that was removed from the four and one half acre manmade lake and then disposed of it at a quarry near Springfield.

Larry Kovar, President of Aquatic Analysts, Inc. noted that his firm was hired by Union County for this specific job after a competitive bid process. Mr. Kovar, an Aquatic Ecologist, is noted for his knowledge in aquatic weed and algae control. "The lake was hydro-raked using a specialized machine that looks like a back-hoe on pontoons. Instead of using a York rake our machine has a clamshell attachment that pulls those tuberous lily pads out by the roots as well as leaf mold" noted Kovar. After the clam shell does its job another floating machine, also with paddle wheels painted robin egg blue and named 'the harvester', comes along and skims up the floating debris. The entire mucky mess is then brought alongside shore where a Union County back-hoe lifted it from 'the harvester' onto one of the lined up dump trucks.

"The timing was critical in order to minimize the effect on marine life. Fish breeding took place in the spring so that was not an issue. Reptiles haven't yet started to hibernate and over winter in the mud of the pond so we avoided that situation. When the fish and turtles hear us coming on the pond surface with our



equipment they vacate that area. In addition we use no chemicals in our process so we're really environmentally friendly. The mass of overgrown vegetation indicated that this lake was overdue for cleanup. You'll now experience not only more fish and healthier water but on the far side of the lake you can now easily fish from the bank, skim a rock across the lake surface, sail a toy boat or just pull up a chair and rest while admiring the beauty of this peaceful setting" remarked Mr. Kovar.


Local downtown resident and 'angler extraordinaire' Steve Bloch couldn't agree more. "This was really overdue but the lake sure looks great today. I spend a lot of time fishing this lake and the adjoining Rahway River. It was getting pretty difficult to cast a fishing line out with all the lily pads. Now it's a pleasure to fish here" noted Steve. According to Mr. Bloch the lake has lots of life including "three pound and bigger small mouth bass, shiners, bluegills, painted turtles, muskrat, the ever present Canadian geese, ducks, diving Cormorant birds

and long legged Herons to name just some" remarked angler Steve.

The Rahway River Park, one of the gems in our town, is a part of the Union County Park System and under the control of the Union County Freeholders. The Rahway Park and others in a coordinated system of public parks in the Union County Park system were designed by the world famous landscape architectural firm of Frederick Olmsted, designer of Central Park and Prospect Park in New York City.




