PRESIDENT DECLARES DISASTER FOR NEW JERSEY

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) announced that federal aid has been made available to the State of New Jersey to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the area affected by Hurricane Irene beginning on August 27, 2011, and continuing.

The President's action makes federal funding available to affected individuals in Union County.

Assistance can include grants for temporary housing and home repairs, low-cost loans to cover uninsured or underinsured property losses, and other programs to help individuals and business owners recover from the effects of the disaster.

Federal funding also is available to state and eligible local governments and certain private nonprofit organizations on a (above) Irving St. just above Seminary Ave. Photo by Derron Palmer cost-sharing basis for emergency work and the repair or replacement of facilities damaged by Hurricane Irene.

Individuals and business owners who sustained losses can begin applying for assistance today by registering online at www.disasterassistance.gov, by web enabled mobile device at m.fema.gov or by calling 1-800-621-FEMA (3362). Disaster assistance applicants, who have a speech disability or hearing loss and use TTY, should call 1-800-462-7585 directly; for those who use 711 or Video Relay Service (VRS), call 1-800-621-3362. The toll-free telephone numbers will operate from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week until further notice.



FRANK THORNE (RHS '47) – Author & Illustrator

Frank Thorne is a comic book artist-writer, best known for popularizing the Marvel Comics character Red Sonja. He began his comics career in 1948, penciling romance comics for Standard Comics. "After graduation, he drew the Perry Mason newspaper strip for King Features, which was followed by more comic book work for Dell. He turned out a multitude of stories for Flash Gordon, Jungle Jim, The Green Hornet and many more." His published works include two autobiographies, Drawing Sexy Women and The Crystal Ballroom, as well as a novel, Nymph. Among his awards are a 1963 National Cartoonists Society award in the Comic Book Division, the 1978 Inkpot Award and the ¬Playboy Editorial Award for best comic: Moonshine McJugs. Mr. Thorne was known during the 1970s for attending comic

judging Red Sonja lookalike contests.

LLOYD GARRISON (RHS '62) – Artist

Lloyd Garrison, is mostly self-taught and started his career in Rahway, New Jersey, in October of 1966. He is quoted, "I was interested in drawing and painting since I could remember." The colonial paintings were inspired by the fact that he is the 11th generation in Rahway and his ancestors were innkeepers of the Terrill Tavern (which stands behind the M&D Tavern), and also carriage and sled He painted murals for Prudential Insurance in Newark, Rahway Savings Institution (Battle of Spanktown), and the restaurants Barbary Coast, Brass Bucket, and Al Dente Restaurant in Piscataway. Mr. Garrison has a gallery in Red Bank, NJ.

ADELE KENNY (RHS '66) - Poet & Author

Adele Kenny is the author of 23 books (poetry and nonfiction). Over 700 of her poems, articles, and reviews have been published in journals throughout the world. Her teaching background includes 20 years full-time employment as a secondary-level English teacher, creative writing specialist, and teacher of the gifted and talented (Rahway, NJ Public Schools). Ms. Kenny taught courses in police report writing at the John H. Stamler Police Academy in Scotch Plains, NJ. She has also taught graduate-level courses in creative writing as an adjunct

professor in NY at the College of New Rochelle and Rockland County Community College, and in NJ at Middlesex County College. Ms. Kenny's most recent publication is What Matters (Welcome Rain Publishers, 2011), poems.

ALEX SHIPLEY (RHS '66) - Historian & Author

Alex Shipley, a lifelong resident of Rahway, earned a BA in English and later an MA in Humanities from Kean University, taught English for thirty-three years (Linden High School, 1970-79, and Rahway High School, 1979-2003), until his retirement in 2003. He is currently the Director of Museum Operations at the Merchants and Drovers Tavern Museum, serves as city historian for the City of Rahway, and is a research consultant for the Rahway Public Library. 
JOSEPH BOST (RHS '74)

RWJ RAHWAY FOUNDATION MOURNS PASSING OF LIFE **MEMBER OF THE BOARD KITTY QUADREL**

The RWJ Rahway Foundation sadly reports the passing of Catherine "Kitty" Quadrel. Mrs. Quadrel passed away on August 5, 2011. A Life Member of the Foundation Board and with her family, a 2007 Guardian of the Rose recipient, for many years of dedication and outstanding philanthropic support to RWJ Rahway. The Nicholas and Catherine Quadrel Foundation donated nearly \$500,000 to the hospital.

In 2007, when the new Nicholas Quadrel Healthy Heart Center was dedicated, a plaque in tribute to Mrs. Ouadrel was unveiled. The inscription on the plaque read "dedicated with deepest gratitude to Catherine "Kitty" Quadrel for decades of unfaltering philanthropic support to The Nicholas Quadrel Healthy Heart Center and the construction of this new facility."

Nick and Kitty Quadrel cut the ribbon at the opening of the first Healthy Heart Center at RWJ Rahway in 1988. This event marked the fruition of Nick and Kitty's vision for this important community resource. In 1993, the Center would be re-named the Nicholas Quadrel Healthy Heart Center, a fitting memorial to her late husband, long-time Hospital Board Member Nick.

When learning of the passing of Mrs. Quadrel, Kirk Tice, RWJ Rahway President and CEO, said that Kitty Quadrel was a very special person who cared deeply for the hospital and shared generously so that thousands of heart attack survivors would receive life enhancing cardio-pulmonary rehabilitation here at our hospital. We are ever indebted to Kitty and Nick Quadrel.





Most people know that libraries provide essential services, information, and enjoyment to the community at low or no cost. Less clear may be that libraries also need the community's support in order to thrive. The Friends of the Rahway Public Library is a volunteer organization that supports the library through fund-raising and volunteer activities. For example, funds raised in the past year have supported purchases of furniture, computer software, and education for children's programs that could not be supported under the library's existing budget.

The Friends run a number of fund-raising activities during the year—I'll detail those in a future column—but our greatest and steadiest fund-raising source is individual memberships. Students and seniors (under 18 or over 55 years, respectively) can join for \$5; individual rates are \$15, and families pay \$20. Members can help shape the group's direction at our monthly meetings or volunteer to become officers. Application forms can be picked up at the library's reference desk, and more information can be found on the group's Facebook page.

The Friends want the library to do more than just "get by," as Lennon and McCartney suggested. And your participation in and financial support of the Friends of the Rahway Public Library will allow the library to thrive with a little help from the Friends. Please consider joining today!

Before coming to Rahway, Mrs. Fields was a math teacher and later vice Roselle. Cantagallo and Fields join veteran Vice Principal Chey Rivera and Principal John Farinella in looking ahead to a successful year for all students at Rahway High School.


Freshmen Seminar, the new required course for all entering freshmen is designed both to enable students to meet the revised New Jersey graduation requirements mandating financial literacy and to equip them with the skills to make plans and choices to effectively focus their efforts during high school and beyond to determine and realize personal and career goals. Funding for this course included a grant from the Princeton Center for Leadership Training (http://www.princetonleadership.org/). Financial literacy is the cornerstone on which the five-credit freshman seminar will be built, including such topics as saving, investing, insurance, credit, debt, and budgeting. course is designed so that students might learn about how to formulated career and personal goals, what are associated financial constraints and opportunities, and what actions are required on their part during high school to avail themselves to realistically pursue their choices.

All these changes, staffing, course offerings, and construction are part of the framework designed to maximize student achievement in all areas at Rahway High School. The entire administration, Principal Farinella and Vice Principals Rivera, Fields, and Cantagallo look forward to supporting staff and students in pursuit of excellence in the year ahead.

RAHWAY RENAISSANCE MAN CREATES THE MAGIC OF MEXICO

Local legend, Carlos "Steve" O'Connor, he dubbed his whimsical little restaurant, Carlos swears he's not an artist and yet his famed Cafe Mexico restaurant is a masterpiece that continues to live on in both Rahway and Red Bank long after he's retired.

As a young man, Steve served 2 years fighting in the Korean War and when he returned Rahway he carved out a very successful career in the furniture industry, but it was his passion for travel that, inadvertently, set him on a very different life path.

"Over the years I did quite a bit of traveling around Europe for both business and pleasure," says Steve, "but found that I was drawn back again and again to the warmth and comradery I found in Central America." His many trips to the local cafes and nightlife in Panama, Belize, Cuba and Costa Rica resulted in his amassing a huge collection of indigenous art, artifacts and just plain tchotchkes.

Then in 1990, ready for a change, he got the idea to open a little cafe of his own just like the ones he had often frequented. He settled on Mexican cuisine which was still somewhat rare in those day and rented a little storefront on Irving Street and set about painting and filling its walls with his many treasures.

"I have a true appreciation for all the arts and what I wanted to create was a colorful collage that reflected my love of classic and contemporary literature, Mexican art and American culture," he says. "Someone once told me that my décor was 'so tacky but also so beautiful." He decided he needed a more fitting name, so a new persona was also created when

O'Connor's Café Mexico.

A huge hit, patrons spilled out onto the sidewalk eager to be transported to another country and partake of his authentic Mexican cuisine, made up of recipes given to him by a Mexican chef. And Steve, now known as Carlos, added the most important ingredient by greeting and schmoozing with all who came in.

Soon, the tiny space was bursting at the seams, and an offer to move his Café Mexico to Redbank in 1993, when it was on the cusp of becoming the artsy town it is today. This time the space was three times as big and Carlos set about weaving his magic a second time.

Meanwhile, a certain loyal waitress at the original café remained in Rahway and was determined to fill the void so Gina and her late beloved husband, Kerry O'Connor (Carlos' brother), created a sister café, our fabulous Beana's on Saint Georges Avenue.

And both establishments are flourishing to this day! The Redbank Café Mexico is now in the hands of a new owner who carries on it's legacy and Carlos is now finally free to enjoy life and the arts full-time. He keeps a little bachelor pad at the Case Apartments while he goes to haunts the many museums and galleries in Manhattan, camping and kayaking all around the area.

Carlos says, "And usually once a year I treat myself to a month in Nicaragua where I stay in a little hut on the beach and relax with the locals at the very cafes that were my inspiration so long ago!"
