STUDENTS HOLD FUNERAL FOR DEAD VERBS

Seventh grade students, teachers, and administrators at Kawameeh Middle School gathered together for a unique "funeral" on Friday, October 14th. As part of a language arts lesson on verbs, students were given a list of twenty-four words that they could no longer use in formal writing. These words were dubbed "dead verbs," and in an official ceremony, students literally buried them under a tree behind the school. With KMS band members playing violins, trumpets, and flutes to set the solemn mood, Language Arts/Social Studies Supervisor K-7, Bob Ghiretti, read an enthusiastic eulogy commemorating the loss of the "dead verbs" and encouraging the use of their "strong, vivid relatives." Many students,

who were also asked to write brief, rhyming eulogies, and recited their work to the crowd. KMS seventh graders, Mr. Ghiretti, and Language Arts teachers including Rich Brown, Jacquie Fernandez, Deana Rittenhouse and Nikki Toccaceli were recognized for the efforts during the October 18th BOE meeting.

In her book, *Blowing Away the State Writing Assessment Test: Four Steps to Better Writing*, Jane Bell Kiester writes: "The key is that in good literature and well-liked books, "dead" verbs are used fairly sparingly. Instead, strong, vivid, active, "showing" verbs abound in descriptions, action, and dialogue.

The use of strong vivid verbs
= better writing = higher scores..."

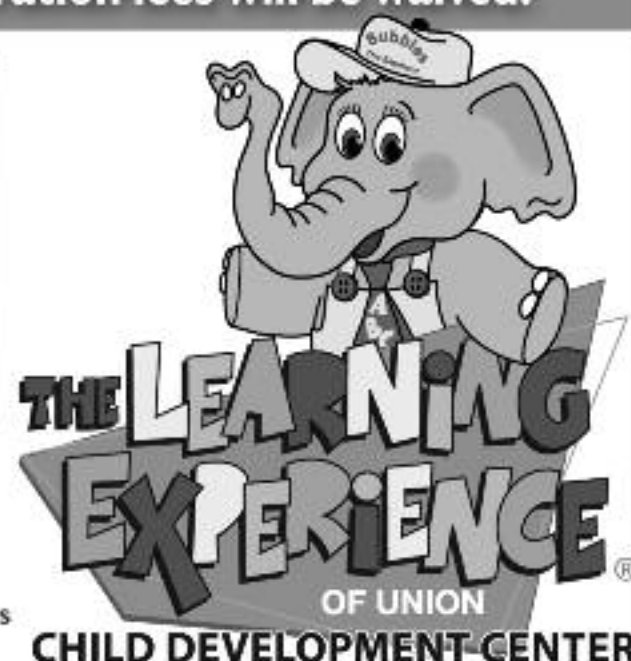

BIGGER LOANS FOR SMALL BUSINESSES

The UCEDC, a non-profit economic development corporation, can now loan up to \$250,000 to small businesses throughout New Jersey, thanks to its recent designation as a SBA 7(a) Community Advantage (CA) Lender. The CA program, currently offered by only 30 lenders throughout the US, is designed to encourage business growth in under-served communities.

"This is a great addition to our portfolio of loan products" says Ellen McHenry, senior director of financial programs. "The streamlined application process makes it easier than ever for busy business owners."

While the program is open to all small businesses, regardless of their location, UCEDC is committed to fulfilling the Community

Advantage mission. "We want to reach small businesses that might otherwise fall through the financing cracks - those that are located in low to moderate income areas, for example, or start-ups with less than two years of operational history," says McHenry. 7(a) loans can fund your small business plans.

Other program priorities include:

- Businesses located in HUB Zones, Empowerment Zones and Enterprise Communities
- Veteran-owned businesses
- Businesses in which more than 50% of the full-time work force is low income or lives in low-moderate income census tracts

Funds can be used for a wide variety of purposes including working capital;

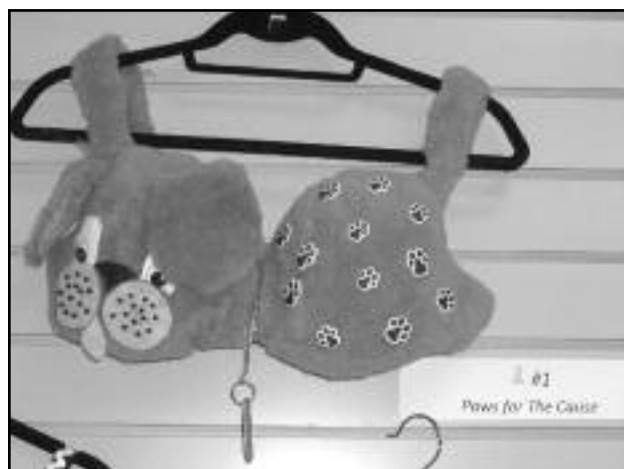
