GREEN BROOK RECREATION COMMITTEE BASKETBALL REGISTRATION

ATTENTION BASKETBALL PLAYERS AND PARENTS

Registration for the upcoming season is open for both Travel and Saturday morning Rec. program. Any parent needing additional information can e-mail rec@greenbrooktwp.org. To be considered for travel team participation, you must be registered by October 7th. Rec registration closes November 4th.

WHAT ARE THE AGES FOR BASKETBALL?

The Saturday morning Rec program is open to children from grades 1 to 8; Travel is for grades 3 to 8.

DO I HAVE TO FILL IN A SEPARATE FORM FOR EACH CHILD?

No. You need to complete one form per family for up to four children, recreation and travel team.

DO I HAVE TO WRITE MULTIPLE CHECKS?

Yes. One check can cover all children in the family who want to play Recreation basketball. Individual checks are required for each player trying out for a travel team. All checks should be payable to Green Brook Rec.

WHEN DOES BASKETBALL SEASON START?

Travel team tryouts will occur in October; you will be notified. Clinics for grades 1-2 and Rec League Play for grades 3-8 begins December 1st. Tentative dates are Dec 7, 14, 21, Jan 4, 11, 25, Feb 1, 8. Registration

Deadline for Saturday Rec is November 4th. After that date, your child's participation is not guaranteed and is subject to a \$5 per child late fee. Please register early so that we can order shirts and plan teams.

WHAT ARE THE DIFFERENCES IN PROGRAM?

The Rec program is instructional in nature, and is comprised solely of Saturday play. Grades 1 and 2 receive instruction on fundamentals, while grade 3 through 8 play games against opposing teams of like age. There will be some additional instruction for the older grades, which will be scheduled once the number of players is known and the timeslots are allocated. The Travel program is a more competitive, more serious program. Games occur on weeknights as well as weekends. Practices are scheduled by the coaches to provide instruction prior to and during the course of the season. The travel program requires a greater commitment of time, not only on the part of the players but the parents as well.

HOW MANY TRAVEL TEAMS WILL WE HAVE?

The exact number of teams and grade levels varies from year to year, based on interest.

WHEN DOES MY CHILD FIND OUT WHAT TEAM THEY'RE ON?

Travel players will be notified in early November; rec players will be contacted after Thanksgiving.

IS THERE A WORK BOND?

No. Parents of Travel players will be asked to work 3 hours at our Shootout Tournament held President's Day weekend. Parents of Rec players are needed to help organize teams and coach on Saturday mornings.


HOW CAN I HELP?



GREEN BROOK GATORS SWIM TEAM


