

Looking ahead, Council will hold a hearing month that the Little on the 2008 proposed budget on May 14, 2008. This year's budget provided many challenges which were met and overcome. More than Little \$1,000,000 in reduced revenues and increased costs had to be resolved. Among the increased costs were increases in pension contributions of more than \$250,000, increases in our assessment by the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority of more than \$165,000, and garbage disposal costs which increased by more than \$81,000. The largest impact on the budget is the Governor's proposal to reduce aid to the municipality by over \$371,000.00.

> The proposed budget results in an overall increase of 10.9 tax points or approximately 11% over last year for municipal taxes. If you would like further information, please come to the budget hearing on May 14, 2008.

> From May 1st through May 8th, the Kenilworth Police Department will be collecting specifically requested items to be sent to a local soldier stationed in Iraq. The items are nonmelting snacks (beef jerky, rice krispie snacks, dried fruit, trail mix, etc.), white socks, sun block, foot powder and instant green tea. All items may be dropped off at the Police Department from May 1 through May 8th.





LOCAL HISTORY CELEBRATION HIGHLIGHTS KENILWORTH'S NATIONAL PRESERVATION MONTH OBSERVANCE WITH TRIP TO OCEAN GROVE

The Kenilworth Historical Society will observe National Preservation Month with a May 17 bus trip fundraiser to New Jersey's famous historic seashore resort Ocean Grove, followed by a Kenilworth History Celebration on May 30.

The May 17 bus trip to Ocean Grove will depart Kenilworth (St. Theresa's School parking lot) at 9 a.m. and return at approximately 6 p.m. Cost of \$82 includes motor coach transportation and a guided walking tour along Ocean Grove's tree-lined thoroughfares, which showcase one of the largest assemblages of authentic Victorian architecture in the U.S. The tour features stops at the Great Auditorium, "Tent Colony" and many other sites and includes lunch at a charming (c. 1890) Victorian inn. A visit to Sandy Hook Visitors' Center is also planned. Tax and gratuities are included in the price of the trip, which is being arranged and escorted by Progressive Travel of Union, N.J.

For further information and reservations, call 908-709-0391 or 908-709-0434. Proceeds will benefit the Kenilworth Historical Society's project to restore the local 19th- century Oswald J. Nitschke House and transform it into a living museum and cultural arts center.

Exciting developments concerning the Nitschke House preservation project will be presented during a Kenilworth History Celebration on May 30.
