DEE VILLANI NAMED "VETERAN OF THE YEAR"

Each year in celebration of "Veterans Day" the Linden Veterans Council select a veteran to be honored as "Veteran of the Year".

The members of the Linden Veterans Council: American Legion Post #102, Catholic War Veterans, Post #497, Linden American, Linden Marine League, Martin Danowski Detachment, Post 91, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Vietnam Veterans Of America, Chapter 779, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 1397, select a veteran who practices patriotism, honorably served his country in the military service, came home and continued to serve his country and community.

This year's Linden Veterans Council Nomination, for 2013 Linden Veteran of the Year" is Dee (Diodata), Francisco Villani.

Dee Villani a life-long citizen of the City of Linden, was born at 115 South Wood Avenue to Palma and Francisco Villani. "Sonny" as his family affectionately called him, because he was so bright; was the first of seven children born to Palma and Frank at their home. All of the Villani children attended Linden Public Schools including Elementary School 6, Soehl Middle

School, and Linden High School.

Like many young patriots, Dee tried to enlist early during WWII, but was underage. He successfully enlisted in 1945 attended boot camp at Camp Perry in Virginia. Dee excelled at calisthenics and other training programs. Here he became responsible for rebuilding and restoring landing craft. In the US war effort the vital means for transportation combat troops and supplies was the Navy landing craft. Villani Buses and U.S. Navy landing craft were powered by the same (671) engines, so Dee was familiar with this work and turned these engines out in record time, impressing his officers. On the occasion if there were leftover parts, Dee would try to get permission to bring them back to Linden to help power the #44 line. Dee was offered entrance into the V-6 program, which was 4 years of college into 3 years with a 3-year flight program. Wally Schirra the famous astronaut was a member of that program.

Dee returned to Linden following his discharge from service and worked his family Bus service business. Dee applied and was accepted to attend Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, PA, where he earned a degree in business.

After receiving his degree from Duquesne University he returned home to work in the family business. Possessing a strong belief in patriotism and community service, Dee joined and supported a variety of organizations such as the American Legions, V.F.W., Vietnam Veterans, Lions Club, Moose, Elks, Knights of Columbus, Italian American Clubs, and UNICO. Through the years, Dee continuously gave of himself; donating his time and resources whenever and wherever possible. He never passed on an opportunity to purchase a poppy, or attend an event at the American Legion, or to buy a drink for the vet next to him. And if you know Dee, his warm smile, his friendly gestures, he always left with "If you need a bus, call us!"

STRONGER THAN SUPER STORM SANDY

The challenge: No Electricity - or- Computers. The Solution: "Business Basics"

Power outages caused by Super Storm Sandy affected many New Jersey businesses including Epicor. Epicor is a filter media manufacturer serving the Power Generation Industry, globally. The power plants, both nuclear and fossil, consider their products "critical commodities" necessary for the production of electricity.

Unlike other local businesses that had to shut down until power was restored, Epicor was able to continue functioning because of well maintained manual systems. The Company continued serving their customers and experienced minimal business interruptions.

BACK TO BUSINESS BASICS

Epicor was founded in 1972 and the manufacturing / administrative systems in place were set up, manually, prior to the sophisticated computer programs currently available. Their computers are industry state of the art but are not primary and serve as backup systems to the effective / efficient manual methods. During the "Sandy Trauma," Epicor maintained and implemented "business basics" to avoid negative downtime results. This capability is also conducive to better customer service even for non-emergency situations.

ILLUSTRATION ON HOW THE SYSTEM WORKED

1. Loss of Communication

A "basic" tool of business is the telephone. Epicor had no internal service, so innovation was required. Fortunately, an off-site business phone location worked and calls received at that location were transferred to employee cell phones set up at Epicor. They were able to both receive and return customer calls. Communication continued!

2. Shipping and Receiving Operations

Epicor utilized "manual techniques" to open and close their warehouse dock doors. The required paperwork documentation was handwritten on existing, printed forms. Battery operated lamps and calculators provided the other needed services. Customer documentation demands were satisfied!



3. Administrative Procedures

Upon the return of power but without computer restoration, all required administrative documents were completed by the use of typewriters. The typewriter is a "reliable basic" and operates with minimal attention.

Epicor "Faxed" communications. The "Fax" does not encounter "viruses," "freeze up" or "get hacked." This equipment also does not undergo "built in obsolescence," necessitating short-term upgrades. It also does not require frequent ink cartridge replacements.

"Business Basic Tools" fully utilized

According to Epicor's president Rose Bussiculo "The Telephone; The Typewriter; Fax Machine; and Copy Machine "were the key tools in maintaining stable operations. Of course, the main assets which allowed business continuance were the dedicated people in our organization. Long-term personnel with company commitment enabled us to "weather the storm."

After the power was restored and computer systems were up and operating the Epicor staff retroactively inputed the data collected during the down time.





LINDEN POLICE CONDUCT DISTRACTED DRIVING CRACKDOWN

In an effort to help combat distracted driving, members of the Linden Police Department were out in full force in the area of US 1 and Avenue C on October 17, 2013. 18 summonses were issued within 90 minutes. 


