# VIN BANEK IS 2ND IN DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR VOTING

On Thursday, December 05, 2013, NJ.Com closed a poll that was being voted on by the public on who the best defensive player in the State of New Jersey was this past season in the sport of High School Football. The panel of experts came up with a list of 38 of the state's best defensive players. One of the players listed was Arthur L. Johnson's own Vin Banek, a senior Linebacker / TE that was a three year starter on the Crusader Football Team.

Vin had a stellar career for the Crusaders as the Senior LB regularly pushed 20 tackles per game for Johnson High School. Banek, who wore #40, finished his career with a school record 390 tackles while accumulating 17 wins throughout his varsity football career. Vin is a three sport athlete and also was named captain of the football, basketball, and lacrosse teams for his senior season. He is a member of the Crusader Athletic Leadership Council in addition to being a standout student, with a GPA of 4.716.

Vin finished second to Ken Bradley of Jackson High School, who garnered 21.33% of the votes (37,965 Votes). Vin finished with 15.59% of the votes, which came out to 27.756 votes.



Students in Laura Bundy's third period Driver's Education class at Johnson High School just learned about the GDL also known as the Graduated Driver's License. The GDL is a program teen and first-time drivers must complete to get their unrestricted basic driver license. The program is designed to reduce driving fatalities among first-time divers and their passengers. By, having more experience, new drivers will be more capable of handling all types of driving situations.

There is a three step route to the GDL. The first step is the Permit (age 16). The requirements are to obtain parent/guardian signature, pass vision and written tests, drive supervised and pass the road test. The next step is the Probationary License (age 17). The requirements are to complete the student Permit or examination Permit necessities. The last step is the Basic License (age 18). The requirements are to complete the Probationary License requirements.




### **HOLIDAY MAIL FOR HEROES CAMPAIGN**


