

CHESS CLUB TIES FOR FIRST IN WORLD TEAM TOURNAMENT

The Kenilworth Chess Club Niners tied for 1st among U1900 teams at the World Amateur Team Championship, duplicating their 2013 result.

Since 2007 the tournament has grown in size and is now the biggest amateur team tournament in the world, about 1,300 players and almost 300 four-player teams participate. The tournament was recognized by the World Chess Federation (FIDE) as a world championship.

The average of all four players is used to determine the team average. Aside from the overall open winner, prizes are awarded for each 100 rating level from under 1000 to U2100. All teams must enter with an average rating of under 2200.

Each team plays six times over a three day period. The Kenilworth team lost just 4 games out of the 24 they played in the tournament held in Parsippany, NJ over the President's Day weekend. They did not suffer a single defeat in the last 3 rounds.

Life Master Mark Kernighan led the way on board one by drawing GM Larry Kauffman in the opening round and winning his last 5 games. Third board Greg Tomkovich and alternate Dan Komunicky also turned-in plus scores. Second board John Moldovan struggled in rounds 3 and 5 but nicked FM Allan Savage for a draw on Saturday afternoon and finished at 50%. Fourth board Geoff McAuliffe also finished with an even score.

In the Open catagory the team lead by Kenilworth Chess Club member Steve Stoyko which included club member Scott Massey tied for fourth place overall.

WHITE CASTLE SPONSORED BOY SCOUT CHESS TOURN WAS BIG HIT

The Munsee District of the Boy Scouts of America hosted their first Chess Tournament open to all registered Boy Scouts, Venturers and Explorers. The tournament was generously sponsored by White Castle and was held on February 22, 2014 in the Cranford Community Center.

This was the first tournament since the Boy Scouts of America introduced the Chess merit badge. Thirty-one players participated. Representing Kenilworth's troop #83 was David Villafranca.

Each player played four games. Nichas Riggins of Cranford took first place. Second Place was Thomas Brockman from Millstone and Third Place was James Sweeney of Cranford.



KENILWORTH'S SCHOOLS ARE GETTING LOTS OF GOOD ATTENTION

If you look at the Department of Education school performance reports (they are available for download on the Kenilworth district website) you will see that Harding and Brearley school students are still not performing to their potential on standardized tests. There are a lot of indicators that measure the quality of a school and standardized tests are but one of those measures.

A school's quality can also be measured by the reputation of its programs. You should know that Kenilworth has become a model for school systems around the state. For instance, Harding School hosted teachers from Middletown Township last week to show off its successful implementation of the GoMath mathematics program. Brearley has been helping the Villa Victoria Academy, a private prep. school in Ewing, develop a scholars' academy like the one Kenilworth created two years ago and which has since become very popular throughout the region. Roselle Park visited Kenilworth administrators to learn more about our school district's "home-grown," state-approved teacher evaluation model. Finally, the Millburn Board of Education spoke with me to learn more about what they know is our effective resident re-registration program.

The Kenilworth School District is attracting the attention of educators from around the state and national media. As I am sure you are aware, Brearley Middle-High School has appeared on national and local radio and in such publications as The New Republic and The Star Ledger because of its pioneering efforts to combat cyberbullying.

All of our schools' teachers and leaders are

working hard to improve our test scores, but the district will not rely solely on standardized assessment results to measure its success. We are a school district going world class that will only see its reputation grow steadily over time.
