#### TASTE OF SPRING FEATURED GREAT FOOD, WINE AND LIQUOR

#### A MEMORIAL DAY TRIBUTE: RAHWAY AIRMAN REMEMBERED IN FRENCH WORLD WAR II MUSEUM

By the end of World War II, over 2,400 men and women who called Rahway their home, had enlisted in the Armed Forces of the United States. Fiftyeight servicemen from that number made the Supreme Sacrifice in the defense of their country. Unfortunately, with the passage of time, most of the stories of the valor shown by all of these brave, young, citizen-soldiers have been lost or forgotten. Only by serendipitous chance did one account surface three years ago that may serve as a Memorial Day tribute to all who served.

As City Historian and research consultant for the library, I routinely receive calls, letters, and emails from all across the country and even from places around the world. In April, 2011, I was contacted by Dan Corson, a gentleman from Denver, Colorado, who was trying to locate a photo of his uncle, Lieut. Conner. Lieut. Conner was navigator/gunner who was aboard a B17 Flying Fortress that was downed by German fighter planes while on a bombing raid over German Occupied French Territory on December 20, 1942. Corson, the Intergovernmental Services Director at the Colorado Historical Society, had been told by his grandparents years ago that his uncle was from Rahway, New Jersey.

A month before he contacted me, Corson had made a pilgrimage to the Normandy Beach Memorials and Cemeteries which included a tour of the French countryside. During his travels he passed through Tosny, a small village north-west of Paris on the Seine River, where he stopped at a local museum which housed artifacts from WWII. While looking through the exhibits, he was shocked to come across a display case that was dedicated to his uncle and the other eight airmen who were shot down. The display contained items recovered from the crash and photos of five of the nine crew members, none of which pictured his uncle. Corson wasted no time searching out the museum director who turned out to be an 82 year old Frenchman named Jean Erisay. In a lengthy conversation, the Frenchman related how he had lived in Tosny his entire life and had first-hand experience of the war and the German Occupation. He was deeply affected by the conflict and as a result it became his life's work to gather relics from the war, enough to eventually establish a museum. Ironically, the same display which had caught the attention of Corson, also had special meaning for Erisay. As a young boy he had actually witnessed the

air fight and crash and had gathered several remnants which would become the start of his collection.

Erisay described the incident as follows:

"I was ten years old when the B17-41-24432 crashed at Bernieres s/ Seine on 20 December, 1942 at noon. That Sunday I was returning from Mass from my church when the sky became covered with B17s. They were being attacked by Fw 190 German Focke-Wulfs. One single B17 found itself at the back of the formation. A few minutes later a big explosion and a large white cloud rose in the sky. The B17 Danellen just crashed!

"That afternoon I went to the site with my two uncles. What a tragedy! Fragments ..... covered the ground, trees were covered with bits of parachute fabric, motors torn from their housing, and torn apart bombs of which the yellow dynamite was still apparent.

"The Germans exploded the bombs a few days later. German soldiers guarded the site and ran off the curious. I knelt down and gathered the housing of a camera and a small oil can which I slipped into my jacket behind the back of a German soldier.

"The members of the air team had defended themselves well against the attacks of the Fw 190s.

Many hundreds of casings of 50 were pulled from the site. The blade of a screw propeller and the lighter of M. Bacon were found by magnetic detection thirty years later."

Erisay was overjoyed to learn that Corson was the nephew of one of the airmen and might possibly be able to locate material which could be added to the display. When Corson got back to Colorado he contacted the Merchants and Drovers Museum hoping he might get lucky and find a photo or at least some information about his uncle from Rahway.

Corson did get lucky. Within a week I sent him a photo and a copy of his uncle's obituary which he forwarded to the French museum. "Mr. Erisay will be delighted," he wrote back.

A tourist makes a chance stop into a small village museum, and has the uncanny good fortune to meet a local Frenchman who spent his life preserving history. In this unusual twist of fate, a war story was brought to light. One story about one airman, yet it reminds us of the sacrifice made by the thousands and thousands who served in our military, all of whom have compelling stories. Memorial Day is a good time to remember.





#### A GROUP GROWING

columns, spring 2014 has been an especially busy time for the Friends of the Rahway Public Library. As I write, planning continues and excitement grows for the Amazing Rahway Race on May 3;

we recently wrapped up our annual book sale in mid-April, and the 10th Anniversary Celebration back on March 22 already seems a distant memory. But I want to take a moment to revisit that event and point out its significance to our group.

If you've read previous columns here, you may recall that the Friends is an ancillary support group to the library itself-our volunteer and fundraising efforts supply doers and dollars to help run events, purchase needed supplies or circulating materials, and raise community consciousness about the library.

With the Anniversary Celebration, the relationship between the Friends and the library developed further, deepening collaborative effort that we look to as a pattern for the future. The idea for the celebration originated with the library and the library's board of trustees, and the Friends were enlisted not to simply write checks or provide bodies, but to play a key role in planning and managing the event. Because of the event's complexity, we had to delegate many tasks among the group, and I was happy to see everyone willingly take on a role. Many hands make light work, indeed!

After this spring, I confess I am looking forward to things slowing down-at least for a little while—but I am also excited by things bubbling just below the surface both with the Friends and at the library.

First, plans are afoot to secure extra funding for the library via grants, in addition to "more

As I've noted in recent traditional" efforts. For example, the Friends run fundraising events that are both fun and successful financially, but these events require a great deal of time and, sometimes, physical labor. Our annual book sale, to give one example, requires lifting and sorting of large numbers of books beginning in December for a sale that takes place in April! The Anniversary Celebration had us meeting several times in a week in the weeks leading up to March 22. We are an energetic and committed group, but it is in everyone's interest to investigate if dollars are available from foundations, arts groups, charities, etc. These extra dollars would translate into more programs, more education, and more focus on the library as community hub.

> Second, as our group grows in experience and connections, I see us working to create programs and events as well as serving to underwrite them. Ideas have been thrown about in recent meetings, and we're working through them to try and figure out what's feasible.

> Which brings me to my last point...what's feasible depends on both time and human resources. There are many things we'd like to do, but not all are possible when there are only 12 months in a year. And of course, we'll always need the people power to bring these things about. I may have scared some of you off with my earlier descriptions of physical labor, but we are always appreciative of individuals willing to join us, sharing time and talent in our—no, make that the library's—cause.

## **TOMATOES New Jersey's Favorite**

LAST FROST DATE: May 12\*

Now that Spring has finally arrived gardeners are itching to get busy planting. For many of us in New Jersey that means TOMATOES. The tomato is native to Central and South America. While it's culture is ancient it has only reached its present prominence since the mid- 1800s.

Unfortunately tomatoes can host many diseases that can devastate your harvest just when you are looking forward to it. There are a few things you can do at planting time to help limit the chances that will happen to you.

Rotate your crops. Plants your tomatoes in a different spot than you planted them last year. This practice prevents diseases that can go into the soil, which can contaminate it for years into the future. If last year you had a tomato problem don't replant in the same area. Disease resistant varieties are available. These are marked on the label and your local greenhouse personnel will be able to help you locate them.

Plant several different varieties. Not only will this help prevent disease from infecting all of your plants, it will also give you more flavor and most likely a longer and more bountiful harvest.

Proper and consistent watering will greatly improve your harvest. Tomatoes require less water than you might think. Over-watered tomatoes can lack flavor and meatiness. Although we cannot control rainfall, we should take it into consideration when hand watering. A rain meter, either bought or home-made, can be very helpful. It can be as simple as dipping a ruler into a bucket.

Pruning tomatoes and removing suckers will focus plant growth on vegetables rather than unproductive stems and leaves.

Staking up your plants makes it easier to

detect problems, harvest your crop and will keep fruit from touching the ground where it can rot. Staking also improves air circulation.

Mulching with black plastic or chopped leaves will control weeds and maintain moisture. This will help keep the soil cool during the heat of summer. Although we know tomatoes like it hot, they stop producing fruit when temperatures reach over 90 degrees. That will greatly diminish your late harvest.

Container gardening is a good choice if you have had disease problems in the past. A simple five gallon bucket with holes drilled in the bottom can be a good choice for this. This system works best with medium size tomatoes.







