#### CLARK MEMORIAL DAY CELEBRATION

After months of interviewing local veterans and current servicemen and women, the students of Miss Sinicropi, Mr. Lowe, and Miss Williamson's classes of Frank K. Hehnly and Valley Road schools in Clark have used the created biographies to assemble a publication honoring the nearly 30 local honorees interviewed. The students involved presented their work to Clark's mayor and local councilmen and women at the and were proud to do so. From start to finish, the project was an engaging, interactive and hands on learning experience which also provided students a deeper understanding of what it means to serve.

Teachers Nina Sinicropi, Kelly Williamson, and Bryan Lowe initiated the project, which began with the teachers soliciting and researching the whereabouts of town veterans. Through contacts with the VFW and the American Legion, a total of 29 veterans were contacted, invited into the classroom to be interviewed, and photographed. Each student was assigned a veteran. They then took information gleaned from the interview and created a page and a half biography of their assigned veteran. The students imported two photographs of their veteran into the biography. one that depicted the veteran during their years in service to the nation, and the other a current picture. When all the biographies were completed, they were bound professionally into

At the Clark Town Council meeting held on May 19th, the three teachers got up to the podium and explained their project to the Council. The students then presented Mayor Bonaccorso and the Council with their own copies of the Veteran Biographies. During the Memorial Day Commemoration held on Friday, May 23rd, the fourth and fifth graders presented their interviewed veterans with their own copies of the publication as part of the ceremony.

Mayor Bonaccorso and the Council thanked the students for their efforts, and expressed their appreciation to the students for preserving the primary source information gleaned from the veterans in the published booklets, which would now be put on display in the Clark Library, township and school for the community to enjoy.


