
LINDEN VETERAN HERMAN ZEITCHIK RECEIVED HONORARY DIPLOMA 70 YRS. LATER

The Linden High School Marching Band performed in the National Memorial Day Parade representing the entire state of New Jersey. While attending the National Memorial Day Parade in Washington DC, with the Marching Band some of the parents were approached by an older gentleman who saw the band warming up. He mentioned that he grew up in Linden (he is 90 years old and currently lives in Maryland) and went to the high school. They immediately introduced me to him. He mentioned having received a metal in Paris a few years earlier but didn't speak much more about the war. He was more interested in talking about Linden. He grew up on Cranford Ave, went to School 4, the Junior High School (Soehl) and LHS. He spoke of the lake across the street from the high school and was shocked to hear there is now a second, rather large part of the high school now blocking it. He talked about playing clarinet in the band and how they would have parades for the recruits that would go down Wood Ave., stop at the theater for a pep rally and then continue on to the train station as they left to serve our country. We spoke for a few minutes longer before he returned to the group he was with in the parade. After he left I was told by one of our parents that he was honored on stage the night before at the National Memorial Day Concert on the West Lawn of the Capitol Building along with 11 others for their participation in the Normandy Landing.

When we got back home I couldn't stop thinking of my conversation with this man. I went to the high school and searched old year books from the time he would have been in school. I found him. He was in the 1941-1943 year books. His senior year yearbook did not contain any pictures of him. After we spoke about it on Wednesday I reached out to him at his home on Thursday. He was so happy not only that I remembered him but mentioned how he hasn't stopped thinking about Linden since he saw us on Monday. I jokingly explained I wasn't a stalker but was very interested in his story and that I couldn't find him in his senior yearbook. He explained that he did technically graduate and that his parents received his diploma for him since he had already enlisted.

I invited him back to Linden to receive an honorary diploma at graduation as per our discussion. He was silent for a few moments then asked numerous times why we'd want to do something like this for him because he has a diploma. I

explained that it was the least we could do to show our appreciation for what he has done for our country and wanted to provide him the opportunity to get a diploma himself. The ironic thing is that this year is the 70th anniversary of him missing graduation while he was overseas fighting in the war. I spoke to his wife as well to explain to her the conversation he and I just had because he said he was too excited to explain it. She said she would get back to me in the next few days once they figure out if they can work out transportation for him. After our conversation I went back to the high school and actually found his transcript which verified the whole story including receiving "blanket credit" for his entire senior year due to him enlisting.

Friday afternoon I received a phone call for his wife saying that he, his wife, 2 daughters and sons in law would be making the trip up. They already reached out to family in the area who they haven't seen in years to share the news with them. Thy booked a few hotel rooms and will be arriving Thursday. I offered to give them a tour of the schools he attended if they wanted to see how somethings remained the same and how different other things are.

On June 20, 2014, Herman Zeitchik walked across the dais and received an honorary diploma from Linden High School 70 years later. I am so glad we were able to do this for this veteran.
