CLARK BOARD OF EDUCATION HIRES FOUR NEW TEACHERS

Four new teachers were hired by the Clark Board of Communications, Public Relations and Journalism from Education at the Board of Education Meeting of Tuesday, July 22

Serving in the role as maternity leave Biology and Environmental teacher at Arthur L. Johnson High School for the upcoming school year will be Mr. Chris Vanderslice. Mr. Vanderslice is a graduate of St. Petersburg College in Florida with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Biology. The Most Valuable Player and team captain of his high school baseball team and pitcher for his college teams, Mr. Vanderslice had the opportunity to pitch in spring training games against the San Francisco Giants and Seattle Mariners.

Assuming the role of District English as a Second Language (ESL) teacher will be Miss Melissa Gabriele. Miss Gabriele earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree from Montclair State University in Family and Child Studies along with her certification as an Early Childhood teacher. She subsequently received post Bachelorette certification as an English as a Second Language teacher. Miss Gabriele has worked as a primary school teacher and ESL teacher with the West Orange and Belleville school districts before joining the Clark schools.

Serving as a maternity leave Special Education teacher at Arthur L. Johnson High School will be Miss Tara Gordon. Mrs. Gordon earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in

Monmouth University and her Master of Arts in Teaching from Early Childhood and Special Education from New Jersey City University.

Miss Samantha McHugh will be a Kindergarten maternity leave replacement teacher. She is a graduate of Rider University where she dually majored in Elementary Education and Dance Studies. Miss McHugh did her student teaching in a kindergarten classroom in the Manalapan Schools in Monmouth County.

6TH ANNUAL WATERSON/DUNHAM VALOR RIDE

On Sunday July 13 2014 the Clark PBA Local 125 hosted its 6th annual Waterson/Dunham Valor Ride with great success. Over 400 bikes participated in the ride and close to 600 people attend in the event in general. Proceeds from the ride benefit the Waterson Scholarship Fund and the Cpl Dunham Scholarship Fund.

Officer William Waterson was a United States Marine who served in Vietnam and became a Clark police officer. On July 4 1971 officer Waterson was shot and killed during a robbery investigation. And remains the only Clark officer to have lost his life in the line of duty. For his actions officer Waterson was awarded the Valor Award and law enforcement's highest award the Law Enforcement Medal of Honor.

Cpl. Jason Dunham was a United States Marine who served in Iraq. While serving on April 14 2004 cpl Dunham found himself in a hand to hand fight with an Iraqi insurgent. The Iraqi threw a grenade in hopes to kill everyone. Cpl. Dunham thinking only of his fellow Marines jumped on the grenade and took the explosion into his own body. Cpl. Dunham lived for 8 days afterwards and finally surcame to his wounds and died on

April 22, 2004. For his actions he received the Purple Heart and our nation's highest award the Congressional Medal of Honor.



MIRACLES FOR MYELOMA

The Second Annual Miracles for Myeloma a 5K Run/Walk is scheduled for Saturday, September 27, at Oak Ridge Park in Clark. The course is staged entirely within the park on paved paths, and people of all ages are encouraged to participate in this community-wide fundraiser. Miracles for Myeloma raised over \$51,000 at last year's event that went directly to the International Myeloma Foundation (IMF) towards a research grant. Multiple Myeloma is a cancer of plasma cells which attacks and destroys bone.

The entry fee is \$25 per walker or runner until September 1; after that it is \$30. Children's fees are \$15. Runners may also register on the day of the event. For pre-registered participants, Tshirts and event bags will be distributed. Awards will be given for best times in various age categories. All proceeds will be donated to the International Myeloma Foundation (IMF). Registration will open at 8:00 a.m. with the race officially starting at 9:30 a.m.

A Remembrance Path, where maroon and white balloons tied to placards with names of people being honored or remembered will be featured. Maroon balloons are designated for patients living with Myeloma or other forms of cancer and white in remembrance of those who have passed on from cancer. Anyone can purchase these for an additional \$25.00 donation.

The co-founders of the race are Clark resident Sheree Pask, a Myeloma survivor and a teacher at The Presbyterian Nursery School in Westfield, and Westfield resident Gina Klemm, whose brother Frank Guarino died of the disease



in 2012.

Pask, currently in remission, has undergone chemotherapy and two stem cell transplants over the last few years. "I am blessed with a wonderful support network of family members, friends, co-workers, doctors and nurses who have helped me immensely during my cancer journey," she said. "Last year's event was wonderful. Now I am calling upon all of you once again to help us get to the finish line...finding a cure for Multiple Myeloma."






The Clark Scholarship Fund has given out \$331,000 in scholarships to Clark resident students since it was founded in 1952.

SPANISH FOR THE WORKPLACE PROGRAM AT THE INDUSTRY-BUSINESS INSTITUTE



RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE CHARITIES RENEWS GRANT SUPPORT FOR PROGRAMS AT TRINITAS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER

Children in need of intense therapy for psychiatric issues who receive treatment at Trinitas Regional Medical Center will benefit from a \$5,000 grant from Ronald McDonald House Charities, New York Tri-State Area and Ronald McDonald House Charities Global.

The Ronald McDonald House Charities grant will support Project Serenity designed to help children ages 7 - 17 who are unable to function within a regular classroom setting or home environment. The grant will provide these children with access to therapists and clinicians who will help them develop their social skills and communications skills. Further, due to the nature of the trauma that many of these children have experienced, Project Serenity will provide therapeutic supplies that encourage movement as an outlet for these children as valuable coping skills. In addition, the grant will fund the replacement of furniture and therapeutic items found in a Comfort Room where these children can reduce their stress levels and learn how to use and develop their own self-calming abilities. Finally, the grant will support education and training for parents to understand their psychiatric illness, learning children's disabilities and the tools needed to communicate better and cope more constructively with their behaviors.


