Visitors to the Kenilworth School District website (www.kenilworthschools.com) are in for a surprise. A brand new look, more media content, and an extremely user-friendly interface will make the community's Kenilworth Public Schools internet experience richer and more engaging.

News headlines now appear on the front page of the district and individual school pages. Click to Brearley High School and watch Principal Brian Luciani channel Rocky Balboa in his commencement speech. Go to the Harding site to learn more about Mrs. Murphy's personal and professional interests and discover how the school's new language arts program will improve student achievement. The district's "front page" includes 2014-2015 District Goal information and episodes of "Out and About in Kenilworth Schools" that previously aired on

Channel 36.

The new website is now more accessible as well. Speakers of foreign languages can read important information by choosing any of 10 languages. A search box located at the top of the page now allows visitors to type keywords and quickly go to the information they want to see right away. Text is larger and menus organize content so users can get what they want without having to go "fishing" around the website. Droid, iPad and iPhone users will now be able to download an application that interfaces with the website.

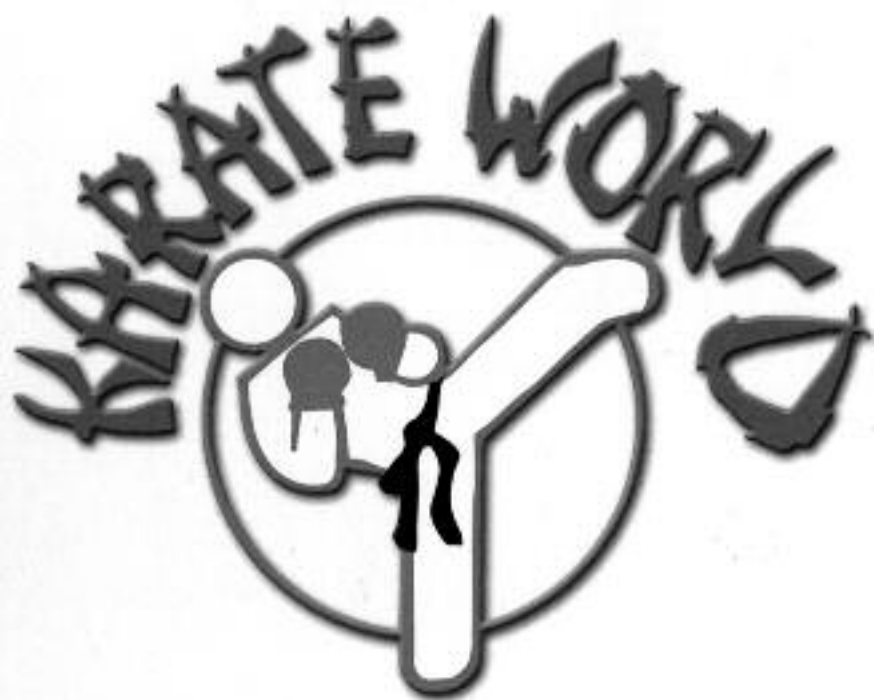

BEWARE OF NIGHTTIME BURGLARIES

Message submitted by Kenilworth Police Department

On late Sunday night into Monday morning July 21, 2014, just after midnight, the Kenilworth Police dispatch received a phone call from an alarm monitoring service reporting they received a panic alert from a resident reporting an intruder in her residence, which is on the 500 block of Newark Avenue.

Kenilworth Officers Robert Cox, Ed Paster, Ken Grady and Matt Torre were dispatched to the residence, whereupon they made contact with the victim, an 88 year old female, who was able to tell the officers that an intruder had come into her bedroom while she was watching television. The officers immediately checked the house and surrounding areas, but the intruder was gone.

According to the victim, she heard a noise downstairs in her house, and almost immediately the intruder was in her room. He demanded cash from her, at which time she said she did not have any. The intruder then began to check in other rooms, and the resident was able to activate her portable panic alarm to inform the monitoring service operator that an intruder was in her house. At that time the intruder confronted her and snatched the monitor away from her. He then fled the house and the police arrived.

The officers determined that the suspect had forced open a rear entry door to the house and made his way inside. She reported to the police that he was in the house for about 5 minutes before he fled. She described him as about 6 feet

tall, a stocky build, African American, and in his 30's.

She could not find anything missing from her house at the time.

Detectives came to the scene and processed the house for evidence. They also believe that this may be tied to other recent burglaries in the borough where a similarly described suspect has been observed. Police are asking for the public's help that if they see any suspicious activity, or hear anything suspicious at night to call them right away at either 9-1-1 or 908-276-1700.

Over the last couple of weeks the Kenilworth Police have taken reports on a few nighttime burglaries in different areas of town, along with one during the day with a similar description to this intruder. Again, the Kenilworth Police are asking to please immediately report any suspicious acts or people that you may see.

PADDLE SAFETY RULES

1. Take an on-water paddlesport class for safety, skill development and essential rescue skills before planning a trip.
2. Always wear your US Coast Guard approved life jacket! Attach a whistle or horn.
3. Dress for the weather conditions and be prepared for cold-water immersion. Hypothermia is a serious danger at any time of the year. Without a PFD in cold water, survival time can be reduced to minutes.
4. Plan Ahead: Know the water you are paddling. Be aware of tides and dangerous currents and have a float plan. Tell people where you are going and when you plan to return.
5. Have proper Safety Kit gear on board (alarm, light, paddle leash, etc).
6. Never paddle alone. A buddy can come to your aid if you get in trouble. New paddlers should paddle with someone more experienced.
7. Learn skills necessary to maneuver your boat. Practice how to get out of, hang on to, and re-enter if capsized. Don't overload and keep your balance.
8. Do not exceed your paddling ability. Know your limits.
9. Learn to recognize potential hazards and use good judgment to avoid them.
10. Check your equipment prior to each use for signs of wear or failure.

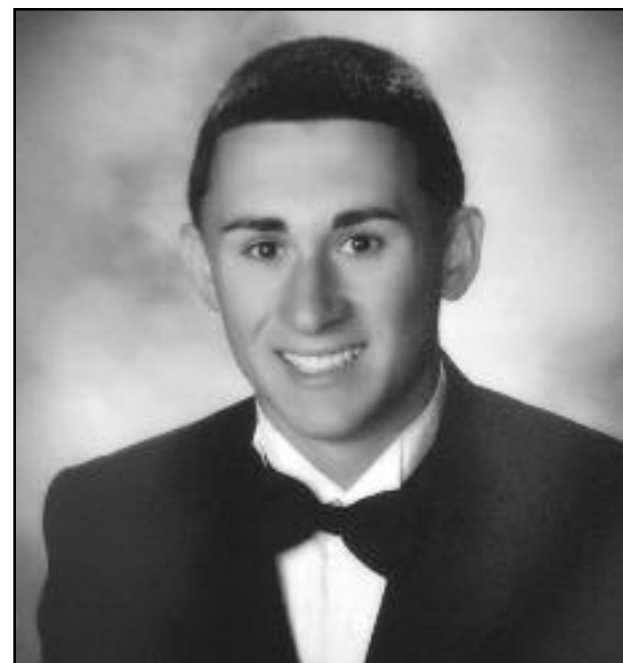

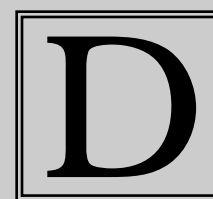

LOCAL BALLPLAYERS TO JOIN TEAM USA-LABC IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC AT THE 2014 LATIN AMERICAN BASEBALL CLASSIC

This summer Joe DiGrado, Age: 10 (Kenilworth, NJ) and Lucca Limeira, Age: 9 (Cranford, NJ) will head to the Dominican Republic as they have been selected to play for the 2014 9U/10U USA-LABC baseball team. Team USA-LABC is selected through 22 national tryout events held across the country. The team will compete in the Latin American Baseball Classic August 6th -12th in the Dominican Republic and will be coached by former MLB stars, current college coaches, and nationally acclaimed baseball coaches.
