LINDEN BOY SCOUT HELPS TO SAVE DAD'S LIFE AND EARNS NATIONAL HONOR MEDAL

Linden resident Kyle Dziedzic rushed into action in getting his father, John, to the hospital in time for life saving treatment of a heart attack. Kyle, a Linden High School sophomore, received the Boy Scouts of America National Honor Medal. National awards for lifesaving and meritorious action are made only for outstanding and unusual acts that demonstrate unusual heroism, skill, or bravery.

On November 4, 2012, John Dziedzic was loading up gas cans to help friends in the aftermath of Super Storm Sandy. He was feeling fatigued and generally wasn't feeling right. Both neither John's wife or their adult son were home. He asked his son Kyle to take a ride with him. His intention was to drive himself to the hospital. Not to alarm Kyle, he told him they were going to run an errand. John's condition was getting worse and he blacked out before he could pull into the hospital driveway. Kyle stopped the car and ran to alert hospital security. Kyle then returned to his father and began administering CPR until help arrived.

John had suffered a heart attack. There were several factors that made those first few critical minutes very complicated and potentially fatal. If it wasn't for Kyle's cool and measured response, his dad would have been in greater jeopardy. Kyle displayed discipline, control and skill in helping his father, all traits that he learned from scouting. The Boy Scouts of America recognized his achievement at the





PADDLE SAFETY RULES

- Take an on-water paddlesport class for safety, skill development and essential rescue skills before planning a trip.
- 2. Always wear your US Coast Guard approved life Jacket! Attach a whistle or horn.
- Dress for the weather conditions and be prepared for coldwater immersion. Hypothermia is a serious danger at any time of the year. Without a PFD in cold water, survival time can be reduced to minutes.
- 4. Plan Ahead: Know the water you are paddling. Be aware of tides and dangerous currents and have a float plan. Tell people where you are going and when you plan to return.
- Have proper Safety Kit gear on board (alarm, light, paddle
- Never paddle alone. A buddy can come to your aid if you get in trouble. New paddlers should paddle with someone more experienced.
- Learn skills necessary to maneuver your boat. Practice how to get out of, hang on to, and re-enter if capsized. Don't overload and keep your balance.
- 8. Do not exceed your paddling ability. Know your limits.
- Learn to recognize potential hazards and use good judgment
- Check your equipment prior to each use for signs of wear

LINDEN RESIDENT TO WALK 39.3 MILES TO END BREAST CANCER

Linden Library Director Dennis Purves, a resident of Linden, NJ, will join thousands of women and men in the upcoming Avon Walk for Breast Cancer New York City, raising funds and awareness that will help defeat breast cancer and support those facing the disease. Dennis will participate in the non-competitive event, which offers the option of walking a marathon (26.2 miles) or a marathon and a half (39.3 miles) over the weekend of October 18th and 19th. This is his first time participating in the Avon Walk, and he is training hard and raising funds in preparation for the event.

Dennis was inspired to take part in the Avon Walk New York because his friend Aimee was diagnosed with breast cancer and recently beat it. She is also walking, and he is doing this both to support her and to help eventually beat this disease once and for all.

"Every year, thanks to thousands of participants like Aimee's Rack Pack, we are able to save lives by providing significant funds for vital breast cancer research as well as access to care, screening, support services and education," said Carol Kurzig, president of the Avon Foundation for Women, the public charity that produces the events. "For the past decade, tens of thousands of dedicated women and men took personal action to help others through the Avon Walk for Breast Cancer. We are truly inspired by our participants' passion and enthusiasm."

The Avon Walk New York City is one of eight

complete 2014 Avon Walk for Breast Cancer schedule includes: Houston (April 12-13), Washington, DC (May 3-4), Boston (May 17-18), Chicago (May 31 -June 1), San Francisco (July 12-13), Santa Barbara, Calif. (September 6-7), New York City, (October 18-19), and Charlotte, N.C. (October 25-26).

The Avon Walk series, the Avon Foundation's largest fund-raising event, comprises eight noncompetitive weekend fund-raising walks for all fitness levels that require a significant commitment from participants. Each walker is required to raise at least \$1,800 in donations and to prepare physically for the event, which offers the option of walking a marathon (26.2 miles), or a marathon and a half (39.3 miles) over a weekend. Among the nearly 15,000 participants in 2013 were men and women of all ages, from weekend walks taking place in 2014. The nearly every state and several countries,

including more than 2,000 breast cancer survivors. This large, diverse group was united by their shared desire to eradicate breast cancer and help those touched by the disease.

Dennis will start his Walk weekend with an opening ceremony early Saturday morning, followed by walking up to a marathon that day. Both walkers and volunteer Crew spend the night at the "Wellness Village," a "tent city" featuring two-person sleeping tents, hot showers, prepared meals and support services. On Sunday, all walkers complete the final 13.1mile leg of their journey, culminating in a moving closing ceremony during which the Avon Foundation presents local grants to leading breast cancer care and research organizations so funds immediately benefit the community. The Avon Foundation also awards hundreds of additional grants to breast cancer research and access programs across the
