




POLICE PROMOTE 9 NEW SERGEANTS IN OUTDOOR CEREMONY

POLICE CONTINUE TO WARN RESIDENTS OF TELEPHONE SCAMS

The Linden Police Department is continuing to receive reports of telephone scams being perpetrated on local residents. The telephone is the new tool for criminals to enter your home.

The scams usually come in one of three different ways:

- 1) A caller will tell you that a family member has been arrested and needs bail money to be wired via Western Union or through a prepaid money card in order for them to be released.
- 2) A caller will impersonate a utility company employee and tell you that you are behind in your payments. They then will demand immediate payment through a pre-paid card or your service will be shut off.
- 3) A caller will impersonate an IRS employee and tell you that you owe tax payments to the


government. They will often threaten you with immediate arrest by an IRS enforcement agent unless you immediately wire money to them through a pre-paid card.

The Police Department warns resident NOT to provide any personal information over the telephone and tell the caller to have documentation sent through the mail. Do not be surprised if the scammers know your name and address. They are able to obtain this information through a variety of legitimate means.

In the past, the scammers have most likely targeted elderly residents, which they believe are most vulnerable, but recently we are seeing residents of all ages receiving the calls.

Lastly, if you suspect the telephone call is suspicious, immediately hang up. If you have Caller ID, give the number to the police.






