# **DAFFODILS / NARCISSUS**

Of all the beautiful spring flowering bulbs from early snowdrops to late blooming tulips, few are more dependable than the daffodils. For a reliable display you can count on year after year, these popular perennials will give you 'the big bang' for your time and money.

Once properly planted daffodils will come back for many years, blooming in early spring with very little care.

There is a long standing debate on the correct name, Narcissus, Daffodils or Jonquils. In this article I am simply going to use the most common name in our area, daffodils for all of

Trumpet shape flowers which begin to bloom in April, daffodils have a large selection of color patterns to choose from. The most popular yellow will brighten up any garden from the front door to large displays in back yards or even in open fields. In addition pure white flowers are available as well as mixed trumpets blends of two or three colors on the same flower.

Easy to plant, place the 'bottom' of the bulbs six inches in the ground, 5 to 6 " apart. They will fill in quickly.

In our clay soil and handful of chopped leaves will lighten the soil and help with drainage. If you don't have leaves take advantage of your neighbors who mow their leaves and put them on the street.

After daffodils have bloomed leave the green leaves until they turn yellow before cutting them back. These leaves will supply the energy for next year's bloom. One of the few drawback of daffodils is that these leaves will remain until early June. When planting my summer flowering plants, I simply push the greens aside and put the new flowers between them. They quickly over grow the yellowing leaves and

draw attention away from them.

One of the few yearly tasks you should do to help your daffodils remain viable is to cut off the dead flowers after they have bloomed. This will force the bulbs to transfer major energy from setting seeds into producing next year's flowers and a healthier bulb to survive the winter.

If your flowers begin to dwindle it's time to dig up the bulbs and divide them. This should only be required once every ten years.

# **ISABEL IRVING: THE LEADING LADY**

Isabel Irving, an actress who appeared in thirty-three stage productions during a career that spanned fifty years (1886-1936), spent a good portion of her life at "Mill Stones," a quaint, rambling farmhouse just off the Rahway River. A contemporary of Augustine Daly, Ada Rehan, Daniel Frohman, Georgia Cayvan and Maude Adams, Ms. Irving starred on the stages in this country and abroad.

Born on February 28, 1871 in Bridgeport, Connecticut, she made her first appearance at the Standard Theater in New York City as Ermyntrude Johnson in "The School Mistress" on December 7, 1886. The following season she was engaged by the Augstine Daly Company where she remained for the next six years. Some of her parts included Oberon in "A Midsummer Night's Dream," Audrey in "As You Like It," and Helen in "The Hunchback."

Throughout her heavy schedule, Ms. Irving always found peace at her country home in Rahway. In 1889 she said, "I love this little spot, for it has been my haven of rest for almost ten years. We come, we go, just as the caprice moves us. One of the charms of our little country home is that it is free from all responsibility. We want to take a trip to Europe? We turn the key in the old door and off we go. When we return to the old place, the very chairs and tables, and even our old, torn schoolbooks, seem to extend hands of welcome."

While in Europe, she worked under Daniel Frohman in the London theaters and played the Vaudeville Theater in Paris. Her first appearance on the London stage was at the Lyceum Theater in 1890

where she played Daisy in "Nancy and Company." At the Vaudeville she appeared in Ada Rehan's part of Jo in "Lottery of Love."

In the late 1890s, she became the leading lady with Frohman's company at the Lyceum, New York, upon the retirement of Georgia Cayvan. "The Amazons," "A Woman's Silence," and "The Prisoner of Zenda" were a few of the plays in which she starred. The young Rahway girl, who had a "a voice full of melody and blue eyes full of visions," later succeeded Maude Adams as the leading lady in John Drew's Company at the Empire Theater, New York. She also starred in "The Crisis," under the management of James K. Hackett, played Louise in the all-star cast of "The Two Orphans," and starred in "The Girl Who Has Everything," under the management of Liebler and Company.

The latter play was perfectly suited for Ms. Irving. She was beautiful, gentle, graceful, a leading lady of distinguished ability, and a woman of deep thought. An English critic once characterized her as "a dainty rogue in porcelain." It is little wonder that her neighbors would walk down the dusty road to "Mill Stones" bringing 'humble offerings of some kind, carefully tucked away in the corner of their market baskets.' The townspeople referred to "Mill Stones" as "Miss Isabel's house," and to the great pine tree or the lawn as "Miss Isabel's pine tree." She was the most famous celebrity in town; she was Rahway's leading lady.







# **COUNTY DAY OF PRAYER DRAWS HUNDREDS**

and commitment to community for the good of the community – of treating others with caring and holding those who do not accountable.

The Union County Day of Prayer, held Thursday, Sept. 18, at the First United Methodist Church in Westfield, drew hundreds to hear those messages, as delivered by a slate of leaders from houses of worship from throughout Union County and the nonprofit community.

The Day of Prayer, the first of a planned annual celebration, was an interfaith gathering of the faith-based, nonprofit and government communities to unite people from throughout the county regardless of race, religion or disability and to bring greater awareness of the support services available to them, according to Sid Blanchard, executive director of Community Access Unlimited (CAU).

CAU provides support programs and services to people with disabilities and youth served under the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to enable them to live independently in the community, in areas including housing, vocational and life-skills training, education, advocacy and recreation.

The event was sponsored by the Union County Interfaith Coordinating Committee Council, an organization comprising 40 interfaith congregations and community-based nonprofits, including CAU, the driving force behind creation of the council. The council was formed to promote inclusion of all people within the community, without regard to race, religion or disability, and to create a clearing house of faith-based, nonprofit and government community services available to the public, according to Blanchard.

"Being part of the community is a full-time job and the steering committee and members of the Interfaith Council are bringing important services to the community," said Blanchard, who sited information about employment opportunities, the entitlements - including support for seniors, children and families with members with special needs - and record expungement programs.

"Our mission at Community Access is for our members to live fulfilling lives within the community," he said. "But in order for there to be a community, there needs to be a cohesive and caring community of people. We hope tonight inspires others to talk to each other and put their caring into action."

The theme of the evening was "The Ethics of Reciprocity - Your Faith, Your Golden Rule." Attendees heard multiple readings from the Bible and Koran and a panel discussion about what the reciprocity of faith, or Golden Rule, means within different faiths.

The panel discussion featured Imam Ali Jaaber of Masjid Darul Islam Mosque in Elizabeth; Sister Mary Carrington, vice president of missions and effectiveness at

It was a message of communication, inclusion Trinitas Regional Medical Center and the Sisters of Charity of Saint Elizabeth; Pastor William Ingram of the Shiloh Baptist Church in Elizabeth; and Rev. L.L. DuBrevil of the Faith United Church of Christ in Union. Rev. Erica Crawford of the Ebenezer African Methodist Episcopal Church in Rahway served as the discussion facilitator.

> Imam Ali Jaaber quoted from the Koran, saying, "We have made you tribes so you may know one another."

> Sister Carrington said the Golden Rule "allows us to accept the process of change" for the better.

> Rev. Ingram said, "There is more that unites us than separates us" and quoted from Martin Luther King Jr., who said, "We will either dwell together as brothers and sisters or we will perish."

> Rev. DuBrevil said The Golden Rule Transcends all religions and cultures and that those who obey the rule must hold those who don't accountable for the good of the community.

> "As people of faith, we're the ones who have to hold their feet to the fire," using education, advocacy, activism, legislation and judicial action, as said.




