SAFETY IS TOP PRIORITY FOR TOWNSHIP SCHOOL DISTRICT

Now two years into its multi-year Strategic Plan, the Warren Township School District has made many efforts to "shine brighter every day" in the school community, and community at large. Various committees, born from the strategic planning process, were comprised of staff, parents, Board of Education members as well as volunteers from the town. Progress is evident in all of the following focus areas: Communication, Technology, 21st Century Learning, Assets and School Environment.

The district has been working hard to assess its current safety and security practices. During the 2013-2014 school year, the Board of Education appointed an ad hoc Safety and Security Committee to review security expert Michael Dorn's three day audit which assessed buildings, procedures, and equipment. Administrators immediately began working to improve certain areas based upon noted suggestions. The Administration will continue to work methodically with the Warren Township police moving forward.

In addition to partnering with law enforcement, regular meetings are held with Superintendent Tami Crader, numerous Administrators, and members of the Board of Education. One of their goals is to hire a security consultant to upgrade existing emergency management plans in preparedness, response, and recovery. The district will be working with the consultant to improve internal safety practices and procedures.

"I plan to work closely with our valued local resources, both police and the Office of Emergency Management, to ensure our goals align. The district will also consider a number of facility upgrades over the next several years," said Crader.

EAST COUNTY PARK WALKING TRAIL NOW OPEN

East County Park 1/4 mile walking trail is officially open to the public: walkers, runners, bikers or strollers; all for your enjoyment. Enter at the new parking lot off of Reinman Road. The new loop trail at the 150-acre East County Park is bordered by Dubois, Reinman and Old Stirling roads in Warren Township.

This is phase one of a joint project between Somerset County Parks Commission and Warren Township. This particular area was originally Linden Farms, owned by the Gaiser Family. The gravel path was in the same area that the Gaisers had a horse track for training horses. Gaiser property was part of four farms that were purchased by the Somerset County Freeholders and are now in the process of being developed into trails for walking, running and nonmotorized biking.



CHELSEA RAISES OVER \$4,600 FOR WARREN MAN

The Chelsea at Warren assisted living residence, 274 King George Road, raised \$4,634 to assist Quaid Mobus, 21, nephew of a long tenured Chelsea employee, who was paralyzed following an accident on an all-terrain vehicle last September.

The money was raised through the sale of \$15 dinners-to-go, which were picked up at the Chelsea on Friday, September 12, 2014. The grand total raised includes a portion matched by a family member's employer, Prudential.

All proceeds benefit the Michael Bruce Fund supporting individuals with spinal cord injuries, including Quaid Mobus.

Mr. Mobus's injury occurred in September, 2013, when his ATV hit an obstruction in the road, throwing him into a tree and causing paralysis and the loss of a kidney. Funds are required to continue adapting his home to his motorized chair and other changes necessary to facilitate mobility, and ongoing medical needs.

Mr. Mobus and members of his family were at The Chelsea Friday when the dinners were

distributed to people who had pre-ordered them.

"You don't realize how many friends you have until something like this happens," said Mr. Mobus as he greeted and thanked many supporters.



Over the past several years the Wagner Farm Arboretum in Warren has been the home of the fall spectacular known as BRITE NITES. There were fantastic lighted carved pumpkin displays which adorned our grounds.

But then the brutal winter came. The old farm wagon shed which served as home to the Haunted House, and in which the many carved pumpkin displays and equipment were stored, could not bear the brutal weight of a massive snowfall. The grand old shed collapsed under the weight of the snow, and the thousands of hours of BRITE NITES artwork were turned to rubble by this crushing blow.

We realize we cannot re-carve the needed thousands of pumpkins in time for a BRITE NITES 2014. Nor do we have the building space for a Haunted House or the ability to store the newly carved displays. So, we are setting our sights on the future.




