

I would like to wish the residents of Kenilworth a Happy New Year and may they have a happy and healthy new year.








## DAVID BREARLEY HIGH WILL PRESENT "LEND ME A TENOR"



The Borough of Kenilworth has enacted a new snow parking ordinance. The purpose of Ordinance 170-4.5A is to clear the roads of snow and ice as quickly and safely as possible. It is imperative that emergency vehicles such a police, fire and first aid vehicles can respond to emergencies and all other traffic can travel safely. Last year parked vehicles were snowbound causing hazardous driving conditions. This ordinance will ensure the roads can be plowed in a safe, efficient manner.

#### **DURING SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL:**

- On even number days of the month, no parking on even numbered side of street.
- On odd number days of the month, no parking on the odd numbered side of the street.
- There will be no restrictions from 9 pm to 12 am.
- This will be in effect for all Borough streets unless otherwise posted.
- There will be no parking in municipal lots from 8am-10am during snow/ice removal.
- The municipal lot at South 23rd St and South 24th St will be restricted to use by municipal employees and officials without regard to handicap parking spaces.

Failure to comply with the ordinance may result in ticketing and towing at the owner's expense. Tickets will be a fine of \$100.00.

Kenilworth Boulevard and Michigan Avenue are county roads and the rules will remain with no parking both sides of the street when the road is snow covered.


