LINDEN POLICE CONDUCT DISTRACTED DRIVING INTERDICTION

The Linden Police Department Traffic Bureau assisted by patrol officers conducted a distracted driving interdiction. Officers in plain clothes were stationed on the side of Route 1 & 9 in Linden looking for drivers doing anything but concentrating on driving.

LPD used funds from the NJ Safe Corridors Grant to bring in off-duty Officers especially for this detail. The Officers were paid for by the Safe Corridors Grant. The City of Linden has received this grant each year since 2009 with the



exception of 2010. Linden Traffic Bureau Commander Michael Babulski stated, "The Safe Corridor Grant is an excellent program and it is a vital part of traffic safety in Linden. We use the grant for everything from manpower, equipment, training and technology to educational material for traffic safety. Without the support of this grant Route 1 & 9 in Linden would be a lot more dangerous."

This is not the first nor the last distracted driving detail to be conducted in Linden. "You may or may not see us out there but the Linden Police Department will definitely be aggressively enforcing the distracted driving as well as the move over law in the near future. We may not issue us a summons, we may just educate you or hand you're a brochure explaining the laws but hopefully it will make our roads safer," Babulski further stated.

In October Linden was awarded \$122,528.07 from the Safe Corridor Grant. A slight decrease from last year's award. About Safe Corridors The Safe Corridor grant program dates to 2003 and targets resources to 14 ten-mile segments along highways that have a history of high crash rates. Grants are supported by fines, which are doubled in designated Safe Corridors for a variety of moving violations, including speeding.

FY 14 Safe Corridors funding is being allocated based on crash data, with higher amounts of funding going to areas demonstrating the greatest need for continued enhanced enforcement measures. Segments of Route 1, Route 9, Route 22, Route 40, Route 46, Route 47, Route 73 and Route 206 are receiving FY 14 funding.

Grants can be used by municipalities to purchase enforcement equipment including police vehicles, radar equipment, computer hardware and software, and to pay salaries. Here is the complete list of grant recipients, amounts, and Safe Corridor segments (pdf 20k) for which grants are being awarded.

VETERANS COUNCIL ANNOUNCES, "2014 VETERAN OF THE YEAR"

This year's LVC "Veteran of the Year," is Joseph "Joe" Wojick, Member of Post # 91, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Linden American Legion Post 102, Vietnam Veterans Chapter 669 and Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post # 1397.

Each Year the Linden Veterans Council select and honor a Veteran with fundamental qualities



of courage, pride, determination, selflessness, dedication to duty and integrity. Many veterans did not ask to leave their homes to fight on distant battlefields. Many did not even volunteer. They did not go to war because they loved fighting. They were called to be part of something bigger than themselves. They were ordinary people who responded in extraordinary ways in extreme times. They rose to the nation's call because they wanted to protect a nation, which has given them, and us, so much. The Linden veteran of the year, in addition to his committed service to his country, and his service to veteran's organizations, has served his community by participating in civic programs.

Joe "Pepper" Wojick had a distinguished US Army service record serving in the medical corp. Medics are those who serve the health needs for military service in peacetime and in war, providing lifesaving medical applications to US combat troops on the battlefield, saving lives.

Sergeant Wojick served in the National Guard from 1947 to 1951, activated to regular Army in 1951, and served in Germany from 1952 to 1953 as a medic with the 631st Armed Field Artillery. Between 1956 and 1958, he served as a Combat Medic with seventh Medical Battalion of the seventh Infantry Division. In 1960 to 1962, he served in France with the 19th field station hospital. Between1963-1964, he was stationed at Fort Bragg, 519th Military Battalion, training as a Vietnam interpreter. From 1964 to 1965 he served in Vietnam as combat veteran with the MACV as an advisor with operations against the Vietcong, and medical evacuation of the wounded. In 1966, he served with 19th psychological ops as an interrogator. In late 1966, he participated with the Marines landing in Mekong Delta, conducting operations against the Vietcong. From 1968 to 1969, he served with Eighth Psychological Operations as Sergeant of Operations Planning, working with Air Force 9th SOS dropping leaflets to Vietcong areas. He served in Fort Bragg from 1969 to 1973 as first Sergeant, Operations Sergeant for 13th Psychological Ops. Headquarters Co.

Sergeant Wojick retired in 1973 after 25 years of patriotic service to his country. Sergeant Wojick earned the following military decorations: Combat Medic Badge, Vietnam Service Medal, Bronze Star, Air Medal and South Korea Service Medal.

Sergeant Wojick is a lifetime member of Polish Legion of American Veterans, Post 91; Vietnam Vets Chapter 779; Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 1397; Linden American Legion, Post #102; he is also the Hospital Chairperson at Menlo Park and Lyons Veteran Hospitals.

"Elizabeth Soldier on Leave from Viet Nam Keeps Rounding Up Clothes for Refugees"

A brief respite from hostilities in South Vietnam has not relieved Spec.5 Joseph E.Wojick of the deep concern he feels for the refugees he left behind.

The Elizabeth man, who lives at 530 Fulton Street, started a one-man campaign last winter that resulted in the shipment of some 1,500 pounds of clothing for the destitute survivors of bombed out villages in the Tuy On district of Vietnam. His fellow members of Post 91, Polish Legion of American Veterans, collected the clothing and sent it abroad in response to a plea that he directed to Leo Eska, Post Commander.

Specialist Wojick will return on Saturday, following a 10-Day leave, assured that the clothing needs of the children that he had befriended will continue to be met for some time to come. On a visit to the post home 648 Fulton St., Specialist Wojick saw 40 more boxes of clothing ready to be shipped to Saigon and forwarded from there to his station. "The need will continue because the children now in the orphanages are growing bigger and more and more refugees are being brought in as hostilities increase," Specialist Wojick stated.

A member of Advisory team 28 stationed in Tuy On, Vietnam, Specialist Wojick job is to visit villages, hamlets, hospitals and orphanages in the district with members of his team and administer medical to the people. Specialist

Wojick said his teammates regularly contribute money to supplement the clothing donated. They buy the materials and pay tailors in the villages to make garments, which then are distributed to orphanages operated by Buddhist and Catholic nuns and priests.

There appears to be no further religious animosity, as Buddhists and Catholics are working together peaceably to care for their homeless brethren, Specialist Wojick noted. The religious communities are caring for the elderly and ill, as well as children, he said. Clothing including shoes of all sizes, may be sent to Post #91 headquarters, where it will be processed for shipment to Vietnam. For those who may wish to send clothing or donations direct, Specialist Wojick address is: RA51149214, Advisory Team 28, and APO San Francisco, Calif., 96295. ".



The LERS unit is an easy to use wireless transmitter which becomes a 24 hour companion and a direct link to safeguarding one's health and safety. One press of the button is all it takes to notify the central station that an emergency condition exists and within minutes, an ambulance and emergency personnel are at the scene. Besides having the transmitter and emergency help immediately, your medical profile is kept on file and is at the disposal of emergency personnel.

The City of Linden has purchased the emergency units for the subscriber. The subscriber in turn pays \$12.00 a month monitoring fee and charges for the installation of the unit.

The Linden Emergency Response System, administered through the Department of Recreation and Community Services, is an invaluable service available to the residents. 




