WATCHUNG MOUNTAIN DISTRICT BOY SCOUTS HOLD FIRST ANNUAL CHESS TOURNAMENT SPONSORED BY WHITE CASTLE

The Watchung Mountain District of the Boy Scouts of America hosted their first Chess Tournament open to all registered Boy Scouts, Venturers and Explorers. The tournament was generously sponsored by White Castle and was held on November 1, 2014, in the Stonecrest Community Church in Warren, NJ. This was the first tournament since the Boy Scouts of America introduced the Chess merit badge. Thirteen players participated, playing four games each.

Parth Patel won first place with a perfect score of 4.0. James Scacifero and Alec Thomson both ended with a 3.0 score and James took second on the tie break system. Steven Rhein and Michael Duncan both finished with 2.5 scores.

White Castle will continue to support the Boy Scouts and the Chess program.



2014/2015 DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

The Borough of Watchung wishes to inform all Borough residents and non-resident Borough property owners that a Borough-controlled deer management program will begin on December 1, 2014 and may continue until February 14, 2015. The program will be conducted under the same format as that previously utilized under the Community Based Deer Management Program.

The deer management program will be conducted as follows:

1. Controlled hunting via firearm by Warren Blue Ridge Sportsmen, Inc. on three tracts of municipal land from December 1, 2014 through February 14, 2015, as permitted by State regulations. The three tracts include 19.81 acres on the west end of Mountain Boulevard, 9.56 acres on Sequoia Drive and 6.4 acres between Route 22 and Johnston Drive.

2. Controlled hunting via firearm by Warren Blue Ridge Sportsmen, Inc. on three tracts of privately owned land from December 1, 2013 through February 14, 2014 as permitted by State regulations. The three tracts are identified below.


There are a total of six tracts of municipal or private land within the Borough of Watchung approved for this season's deer management program. Shooting is limited to the six sites designated in the program and will only be done from elevated tree stands.

A 24 hour telephone hot line will be in operation at the Watchung Borough Municipal Building and will be maintained by the Borough to provide timely and regularly updated advance information to residents as to which dates the tracts are scheduled to be used. 


