## 5TH GRADERS GO TO THE MOON

On January 21st, the 5th grade Gifted and Talented students in Rahway went on a field trip to Buehler Challenger and Science Center, located on the campus of Bergen Community College in Paramus. The educational facility exists to promote science and math learning and offers a simulation of a space flight to the moon. It is part of a network of Challenger Centers worldwide.

After weeks of preparing for this mission, the students were ready. As "astronauts" the kids needed to have a working understanding of areas such as geology and chemistry. Perhaps even

more significant is that the trip helped to instill and emphasize the benefits of teamwork. Students each had their own assignment but the goals of launching a probe to the lunar surface and landing their spacecraft on the moon, depended on teamwork.

## CARING FOR FRESH CUT ROSES

*"A rose by any other name  
would smell as sweet" William Shakespeare  
(Romeo and Juliet)*

In literature and poetry for centuries, roses are perhaps the most beloved flower in the world. Roses have been a symbol of love and passion since Roman times.

On Valentine's Day roses are in incredible demand. Of course this increases the cost at this time of year. To get the most out of your investment you can follow a few basic steps.

The more water that reaches the flower, the longer it will last. To ensure this process proper cutting is essential. Roses need a clean cut on an angle to open the stem and absorb water. A blade or sharp knife is a good tool for this. Scissors or pruning shears unfortunately close the stem and are therefore not a good choice.

Keep your fresh roses out of the sun. Direct sunlight will dehydrate the flower and lessen its life span.

After a few days or when your flowers begin to droop it is time to freshen them up. Remove the flowers and clean the vase, then refill with fresh water. Give your roses a fresh 'clean' cut as described above and put them in the vase. This will give your roses a few more days of beauty.

Flower crystals\* do work so I add them to all flower arrangements. Flower shops and even

super markets supply crystals free of charge, so remember to ask for it.

You can easily dry roses and enjoy them all winter long. Do this while the roses are still fresh, before the flowers droop or the petals drop off. Using a hanger and twist ties, simply hang the roses up-side-down, leaving space between them for good air circulation. Hang them in a dry room out of direct sunlight, which will help preserve color. Leave them undisturbed until they are fully dried, approximately two or three weeks. When dried they are ready for display.

\*If you don't have flower crystals a regular lemon lime soda (not diet) will also do the trick. (P. Allen Smith)

## EBENEZER AME CHURCH DATES BACK TO 1826

Ebenezer African Methodist Episcopal Church of Rahway was established in September, 1826 and has the distinction of being among the first of the AME churches to be organized and chartered in the state of New Jersey. Early on, it was one of only five AME churches in the state and the only AME church between New York and Trenton.

The history of this denomination began in 1787, eleven years after the signing of the Declaration of Independence, when a religious group, labeled “the Outcasts,” left St. George’s Methodist Episcopal Church in Philadelphia because of discrimination. In that church, African-American congregants were required to sit in separate sections of the sanctuaries and African-American ministers, although accepted, were only allowed to preach before African-American congregations. Under the leadership of Richard Allen, an African-American minister, the Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church was organized in 1793 as a reaction to the segregation. Allen’s new church adopted and maintained the doctrines and form of government of the Methodist Episcopal Church as he had no plans to leave the denomination. However, by 1816, as African-American Methodists in other middle Atlantic communities were continuing to experience racism, Allen called for a meeting in Philadelphia to form a new Wesleyan denomination, the African Methodist Episcopal Church. The name was not intended to give the impression that this was to be a segregated church family but rather that this Methodist Episcopal Church was established and controlled by Americans of African descent.

The AME Church was the first African-American denomination organized and incorporated in the United States. It has a unique history as it is the first major religious denomination in the western world that developed because of sociological rather than theological differences, being born in protest against racial discrimination and slavery.

For the first three years in the life of the Rahway congregation, meetings and services were held in various places until 1829 when approximately thirty families of “free persons of colour” procured a site on Central Avenue and erected a building for worship. Reverend Christopher Voorhis, the individual instrumental in organizing the church, was the first pastor.

In the following decades the congregation grew and by the 1890s was able to purchase a home located not far from the church to serve as a parsonage. In 1920 a vestibule was added to the front of the sanctuary.

In 1921 Reverend John W.P. Collier Sr. became pastor and preached his first sermon on Sunday, May 22. Rev. Collier would spend the next twenty-six years in the pulpit at Ebenezer during which time he became an active

participant in church and community affairs being always vigilant in regards to issues of equality in the city. Under Rev. Collier’s tenure, an extension was added on the rear of the church and a pipe organ was installed. Rev. Collier retired in 1947 and gave his final sermon as pastor on Sunday, May 11.


On Tuesday, March 9, 1948, only nine months after Ebenezer’s new minister, Henry A. Hildebrand was installed, the church was damaged by a fire caused by an over-heated furnace. For over a year the congregation worshiped in St. Paul’s on Irving Street until the church was repaired. A service dedicating the cornerstone of the rehabilitated structure took place on Sunday, September 25, 1949.

Reverend Rudolph P. Gibbs became Ebenezer’s pastor on September 14, 1975. It was under his leadership that several physical improvements were made to the church, but more importantly, he set in motion the plans for the construction of a new, modern church

building. The old church was eventually razed in 1994 and during the next two plus years, while the new church was being constructed, the congregation met in the Senior Citizen building on Esterbrook Avenue and later at the John F. Kennedy Center on Hazelwood Avenue. On Sunday, June 8, 1997, the first service was held in the beautiful new edifice. Rev. Gibbs retired in 2007 completing thirty-two years as pastor at Ebenezer, the longest tenure of any minister in the long history of the church.

On June 17, 2011, Reverend Dr. Erica D. Crawford, the current pastor, joined the church thus becoming the first woman minister to serve in the pastoral position at Ebenezer.

To this day, as Ebenezer AME is approaching its 190th anniversary in 2016, the church has remained Christian-centered and committed to being a holistic ministry, ministering to the Spiritual, Intellectual, Emotional, and Physical needs of its believers and the Greater Rahway Community.

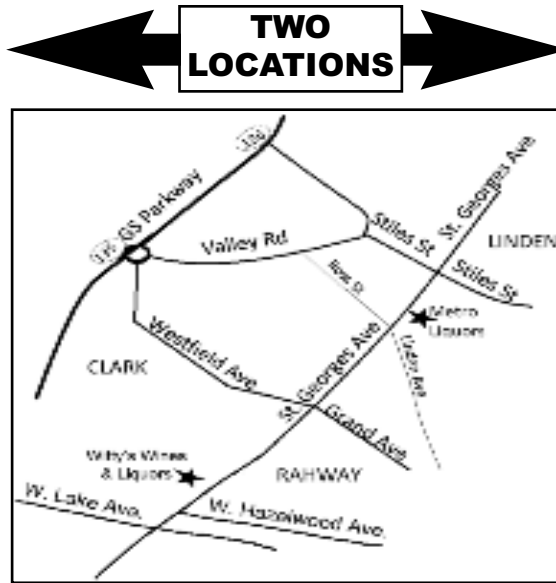

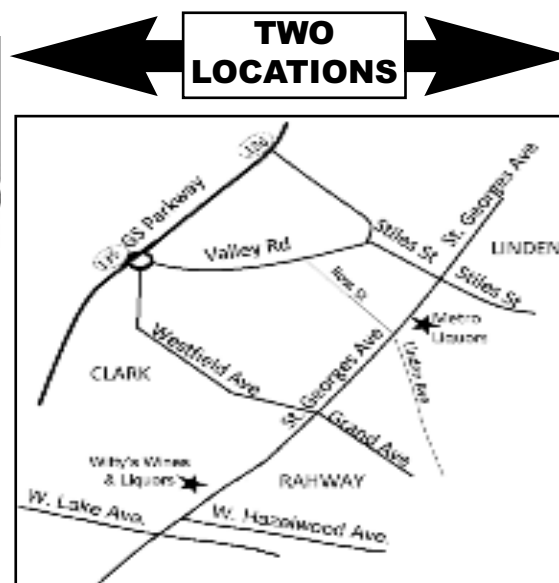
