

WATCHUNG STUDENTS "SOARED" AT FUTURE CITY COMPETITION

Valley View students from the 6th and 8th grade S.O.A.R. (Seeing Our Achievements Rise) program participated in the NJ Future City Competition held at Rutgers University on January 17.

With guidance from the S.O.A.R. educator, Mrs. Elaine Chesebro, and their engineermentor, Mr. Todd Hay, students created their own cities that could actually exist in the near future. The topic for this year's competition was to find two food sources to support the city for at least one growing season. One had to be a protein, and the other, a vegetable. One of Watchung's very own teams, Ville de Saine, won third place overall, while others won special awards. Each group wrote an essay, a narrative, created a presentation, built a model, and designed a virtual city using SimCity software.

Ville de Saine (Annika Schmidt, Isabel Vala, and Jacqueline Lee) is based in present-day Detroit, Michigan. The city's problem was obesity from overeating unhealthy foods. To solve this, the students replaced junky foods with a protein of chicken, and a vegetable of broccoli. It wasn't easy, though, and they faced many challenges along the way, but in the end, they amazed the judges with their knowledge of engineering, agriculture, and most importantly, teamwork.

When asked what the competition taught her and her peers, Azade Modaressi, 13 (from team Amida), said, "Future City is a competition that provides political perspectives and allows students to explore some of the problems our world is faced with today." Teammate Jeremy Cui, 13, added "I learned that teamwork is only possible when all the members are allowed to do what they do best. Some are better at hands-on projects, while others are better at writing essays. Utilizing those skills of each person is incredibly essential."

LOCAL POLICE K9 INFLUENCES **PENNSYLVANIA'S CRIMES AGAINST** LAW ENFORCEMENT ANIMALS

On January 13, 2015 South Bound Brook Police Department K9 handler Rick Fittin and Somerset County Sheriff Captain Tim Pino were invited out to meet Pennsylvania Governor Thomas Corbett. In 2013, Pino's longtime K9 partner Dano had a law named after him, known as "Dano's Law" by New Jersey Governor Chris Christie. Pennsylvania recently mirrored that legislation by creating stricter penalties involving crimes against police K9's. "Dano's Law" originated in 2008 out of Hillsborough when death threats were made by a local drug dealer against K9 Dano, putting Pino's entire family at risk. Sadly, K9 Dano passed away this past December.
