





WARREN RESIDENT TO COMPETE IN AKC NATIONAL AGILITY CHAMPIONSHIP

Coming off her most recent 3rd place finish at the Westminster Kennel Club Agility Championship, Warren resident Mary Lou Hanlon, owner of PetMinders, Inc. and her Border Collies Shazam and Wizard will be among the contenders at the American Kennel Club® National Agility Championship this March 27-29 in Reno, Nevada. The quickest, most agile dogs in the country will all be aiming for the title of National Champion.

Top agility team Mary Lou Hanlon along with her dogs Shazam and Wizard, met tough standards to qualify for this competition. During the event, they will run timed agility courses, off-leash, striving for a perfect score of 100. Any missed obstacles or other mistakes result in penalty faults which are deducted.

Agility, AKC's fastest-growing canine sport which hit over 1.23 million entries in 2014, is an activity that provides fun and exercise and strengthens the bond between dog and handler. Dogs demonstrate their agile natures and versatility by following cues from the handler



through a timed obstacle course of jumps, tunnels, weave poles and other objects.

This year marks the 19th AKC National Agility Championship and 6th Preferred National Agility Championship for dogs jumping lower than their measured jump height.




