RAHWAY RE-LAUNCHES GRANT-FUNDED COALITION

Mayor Samson D. Steinman was the featured speaker at the re-launch of the Rahway Prevention Coalition at the Rahway Public Library on Monday, March 16. Joining the Mayor was a diverse audience of City residents, community leaders, professionals and elected officials who came together to learn about the Coalition and its work to reduce substance use among Rahway youth. Late last year, the City of Rahway was awarded the highly competitive 2014 Drug Free Communities Support Grant providing funding for community-based coalitions to organize in an effort prevent youth substance use.

An extension of the Rahway Municipal Alliance which has been in existence for over 20 years, the Coalition will receive \$125,000 annually for the next five years through the Drug Free Communities grant which falls under the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy. Recent evaluation data indicate that where Drug Free Communities funds are invested, youth substance use is lower. The long-range objectives of the program call for a measurable decrease in substance use by changing the youth culture to one that does not promote or accept alcohol and marijuana use. The coalition will have the option to apply for an additional five years of funding.

The Coalition launch included the debut of its logo

designed by Rahway High School art students, recognition of community leaders positively impacting the Rahway community and an informational portion that allowed the speakers to go in further detail about the Strategic Prevention Framework that will guide the effort.

"The focus of this grant is bringing people from different walks of life, different organizations, different racial, ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds, working together as one," said Mayor Steinman.

Membership is open to all who would like to participate. The next Rahway Prevention Coalition meeting is slated to take place on April 28, 2015.

Once again Senior captain Deshawne Bunion led Rahway to a strong second place finish. Deshawne took home the gold medal in the 800 meter dash. After finishing second in the 400M running the second fastest time in the state this season. Deshawne also teamed up with Terance Anderson, Lenworth Wilson, and Donavon Logie to finish fourth in the 4x400 relay. Lots of young talent emerged to help the Indians in their title quest. Sophomore Corey McGhie finished third in the 3200 meter run, while fellow Sophomore Jordan West finished second in the

shot put. Both Jordan and Corey's mark rank second in school history. Jordan's performance also ranks him the #3 Sophomore in the nation. Nadir Williams-McLaurin, Jayquan Johnson, Joshua Pretlow-King, and Tari Wilson also scored for Rahway.

The Lady Indians finished seventh in team standings led by Chasity Docteur, who finished fifth in both the high jump and the 800m. The 4x400 relay team composed of Abisola Atilola, Alana Peterson, Gabrielle Charles, and Assata Edwards finished third.

RAHWAY ONCE DUBBED “THE CARRIAGE CITY OF THE WORLD”

Throughout most of the 1800s, the City of Rahway was closely identified with the business of building carriages. By the 1850s, the period when the industry’s prosperity had reached its height, as many as forty carriage and carriage related factories were in operation, building and exporting their products to the lucrative markets of the South and across both the Atlantic and Pacific.

The carriage trade had started in the city several years before 1800, and by 1804, records show the existence of a dozen factories. The growth of the industry can be attributed to the Rahway River which flowed out to the Arthur Kill and later to the railroad (laid in 1834), as both made transportation of the products convenient. However, the main reason the business concentrated in Rahway was due to the number of skilled trades that were established early on, resulting in large numbers of carpenters and smiths being drawn to the place where they could find work. These artisans would create every type of vehicle from gentlemen’s carriages, complete with trimmings and silver-plated ware and Spanish-styled coaches that appealed to the wealthy plantation owners in the South, to farm wagons and covered wagons.

Most of the shops employed from twenty-five to seventy-five highly skilled mechanics plus any number of apprentices who generally served four year apprenticeships. Besides the woodworkers, the shops would employ wood carvers, blacksmiths, painters, trimmers, silver platers, lamp makers, axle makers, and spring makers, in many cases all working under the same roof.

Most of the larger factories were located on Irving Street, Hamilton Street, Seminary Avenue, Campbell Street, and Grand Avenue (called Mechanic Street until the 1870s). Smaller factories and shops doing specialty work could be found on Coach Street, Union Street, Harrison Street, Fernote Street, Winfield

Street (called Factory Street until the 1870s), and Elizabeth Avenue. William F. Flatt established a business on Irving Street in 1846 that was recognized as the largest carriage company in the state. He employed over 100 workers and maintained a complex of three large buildings. The factory of Jonathan and Amos Woodruff, also on Irving Street, was the main supplier of carriages to Memphis, Tennessee. Brother Amos would eventually settle in Memphis and in 1871 build an elegant mansion home on fashionable Adams Avenue, once known as “Millionaire’s Row,” which today is preserved as an historic site. Ira and Joel LaForge operated a large wheel and spoke factory located on Hamilton Street (The building would later house the Hamilton Laundry and today the site is the parking area for the Hamilton Stage). Their markets included New York, Baltimore, Savannah, and New Orleans. The Rahway Hub Manufactory, owned by John Urmston, made hubs for carriages, coaches, wagons, and carts and were sold throughout the United States, in Europe, South Africa, and Australia. His home and office building still stand on the corner of Union and Winfield Streets. David Dunham, who had been a partner of Jonathan Woodruff, went off on his own in 1875 and purchased the repository buildings previously owned by William Flatt.

The employer of over sixty workmen, Dunham manufactured carriages, coupes, landaus, buggies, and wheeled vehicles of every description.

Other names associated with the industry included Denman and Freeman, Miller Brothers, Osborn Brothers, William Jewell, and Jonathan Hill.

Rahway’s booming industry suffered its first major setback on April 12, 1861 with the outbreak of the Civil War. Shortly after the shots were fired on Fort Sumter, 300 apprentices were dismissed from the trade and most of the manufactories would soon be standing idle. As Southern firms severed relations with the industries in the North, Rahway’s economy was hit so hard it nearly drove the city into bankruptcy. The hardships were so severe that a number of owners and citizens, who were ruined by the catastrophic financial situation, actually advocated New Jersey’s secession from the Union. The opinion of the majority, however, was strongly Unionist, and although several establishments were driven out of business, many did survive and even prosper as they were able to make changes in their production methods to produce vehicles and equipment for the Union army.

Although the war crippled Rahway’s main industry, a business directory from 1875 lists twenty-nine factories still in operation. In fact, the city might well have rebounded and regained the reputation as a carriage producing center had it not been for the introduction of a newfangled invention - the automobile. It was that chugging, coughing, motor-powered vehicle that dealt a final death blow to the carriage business.

By 1904 only nine factories remained. A few attempted to change over to the production of fenders and wheels for the new autos, but met with little success. The last carriage factory in Rahway was the Charles Grube Company which held on to the fine tradition of carriage making until 1918.

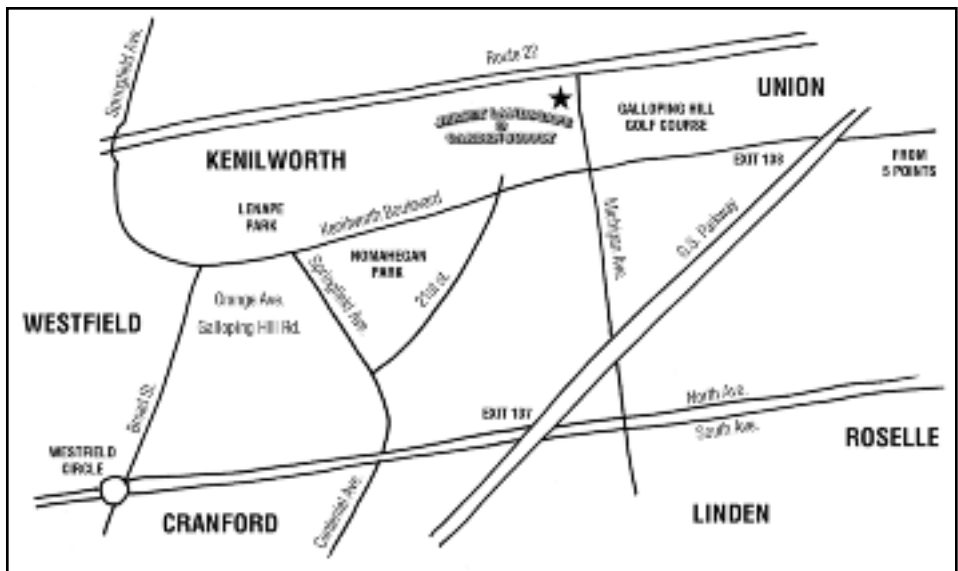

Now that spring is upon us our local garden centers are busy stocking up supplies for the season. I always enjoy driving by and watching the deliverers of shrubs, flowers or mulch being unloaded.

Although it is easy to buy plants and flowers almost everywhere, supermarkets, hardware stores and even road side stands, our local garden centers depend on our seasonal business to support themselves, their families and pay their employees. In return they supply us with the largest selection of plants, varieties and flower colors. Additionally because it is their livelihood garden centers tend to give the best care, including regular watering of their stock.

When you purchase garden plants you want them to be 'happy', well-tended and healthy. Many plants will rebound from lack of care, but they will be more productive with flowers and fruit if they have total care and never need

to recuperate in the first place.

The season from pansies to pumpkins and holiday decor is short. Yet taxes and electric bills continue all year long. Try to imagine not having a local garden center in the area. What a sad loss that would be for our community.

To find a good local garden center ask your gardening friends and neighbors for their recommendations. Then make a list and visit all of them. A visit to a garden center can be a nice relaxing time out.

If you have a local 'Farm & Garden Supply' in your area you are lucky. Once widely available now most towns have to drive miles to the nearest one. Although they do not sell garden plants they are indispensable to a gardener. One advantage of a "farm & garden store" is the wide range of fertilizers and chemicals to choose from. *Remember to always use the correct product for the job and follow the directions on the label.

Luckily for us we have one very close to Rahway in Clark. "Google" Farm & Garden supply in Clark NJ for directions and information.

I often find that a rainy spring day is an excellent time to visit these garden venues. Garden centers tend to be quiet which allows you to visit without the bustling crowds of a sunny spring day.

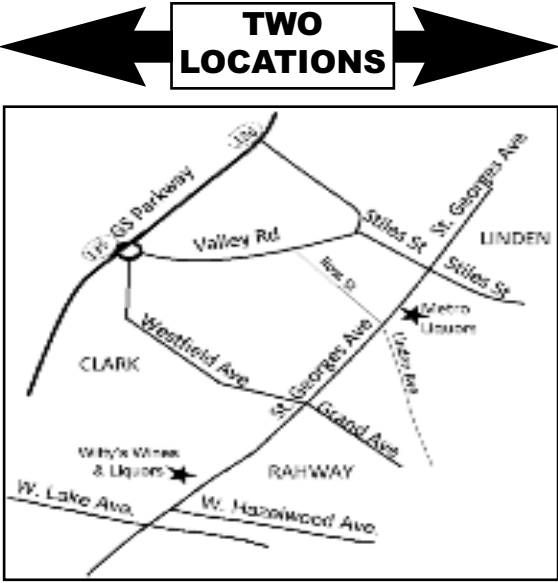

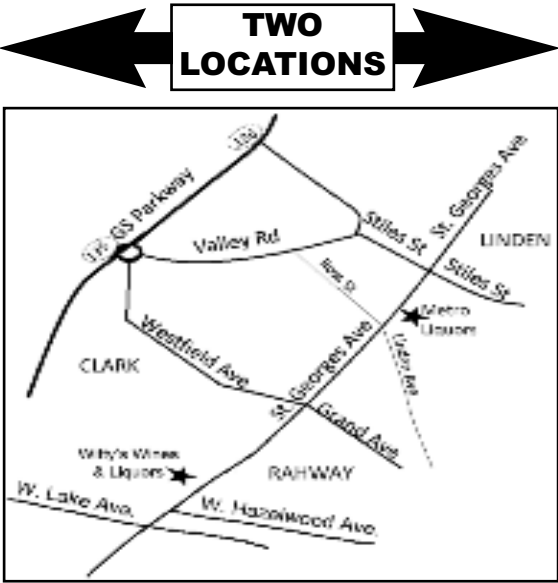
