The group armed with garbage bags, work gloves, wading boots and rakes took to the shores of the winding Rahway River from the Droscher's Mill to South Avenue. In all, over 300 lbs. of assorted trash and debris was

collected by the energetic group. Such things as a wheelbarrow, a bicycle, a scooter and a propane tank were collected. The river clean-up team was treated to a hot dog barbeque along the river bank as reward for a job well done.

Saturday river clean-up wasn't enough, the troop made their Monday night meeting theme "River Clean-Up". The entire troop was summoned to meet at the 9/11 Memorial to continue the good work that started on Saturday. The troop was broken up into five teams. Each team's trash tallies were weighed and the winning team was awarded prizes. Monday night's river bank clean-up covered from the 9/11 Memorial to Hanson Park. An amazing 400 lbs. of debris was removed. The winning team collected over 200 lbs. themselves. Todd Sweeney, senior patrol leader, stated "The scouts did an amazing job in a short period of time, it was great working together to keep Cranford clean." Roy Walton, scoutmaster said "This was such a great idea; we are going to make it an annual event."

ability to take on a job bigger than he has ever done before. He must plan it in advance, coordinate and bring together the human resources necessary, the supplies needed, and fund the effort. It will use all the training that a young man has received during his 12 years of scouting.

Troop 80 of The Cranford First Presbyterian Church is proud to announce the graduation of their 137th Eagle Scout since 1928, Brendan Aszklar. Brendan completed 28 merit badges and completed an extensive renovation of the entry gardens at Livingston Avenue School as well as a teacher's garden that allows educators to retreat to a peaceful place for much needed tranquil time during the school day.

Brendan worked with principle Philip Luiz in designing the needs for the gardens. With a volunteer team of 11 fellow scouts, Brendan managed the project over a course of several days. In all a total of 137 man hours were logged as they tilled and cleaned the overgrown gardens and planted 38 new plants and bushes.

As project manager Brendan contacted several local nurseries and landscaping companies that provided all the components necessary. A generous monetary donation from a local salon provided funds for all the extras.

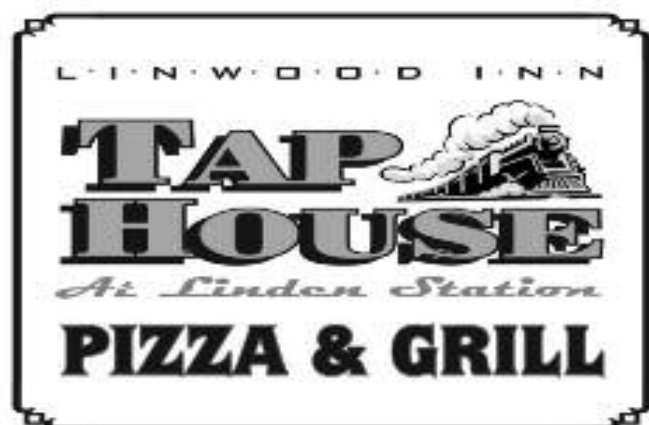



DISPLAYING THE FLAG:

ON SAME STAFF

U.S. flag at peak, above any other flag.

MARCHING

U.S. flag to marchers right (observer's left).

ON SPEAKER'S PLATFORM

When displayed with a speaker's platform, it must be above and behind the speaker. If mounted on a staff it is on the speaker's right.

DECORATION

Never use the flag for decoration. Use bunting with the blue on top, then white, then red.

SALUTE

All persons present in uniform should render the military salute. Members of the armed forces and veterans who are present but not in uniform may render the military salute. All other persons present should face the flag and stand at attention with their right hand over the heart, or if applicable, remove their headdress with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the heart.

HALF STAFF

On special days, the flag may be flown at half-staff. On Memorial Day it is flown at half-staff until noon and then raised.

Do not let the flag touch the ground.

Do not fly flag upside down unless there is an emergency.

FLAG DISPOSAL:

1. The flag should be folded in its customary manner.
2. It is important that the fire be fairly large and of sufficient intensity to ensure complete burning of the flag.
3. Place the flag on the fire.
4. The individual(s) can come to attention, salute the flag, recite the Pledge of Allegiance and have a brief period of silent reflection.
5. After the flag is completely consumed, the fire should then be safely extinguished and the ashes buried.
6. Please make sure you are conforming to local/state fire codes or ordinances.

NOTE:

The federal flag code says the universal custom is to display the U.S. flag from sunrise to sunset on buildings and stationary flagstaffs in the open, but when a patriotic effect is desired the flag may be displayed 24 hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness. Also, the U.S. flag should not be displayed when the weather is inclement, except when an all-weather flag is displayed.

SURPLUS VEHICLES TO ENHANCE CRANFORD POLICE FLOOD RESPONSE

The Cranford Police Department recently took possession of a number of military surplus vehicles and other equipment geared towards enhancing the agency's flood and disaster response capabilities. The items were obtained through a federal program that repurposes decommissioned military equipment for use by municipal and state agencies. All vehicles and equipment were obtained at no cost to the township, and with the approval of the Cranford Township Committee.

Most visibly, the Cranford Police Department has deployed three Humvees, a five ton mobile command post, and two five ton trucks. All are capable of operating in flooded areas and are anticipated to help with rescue, recovery and evacuation efforts in future emergencies such as the massive floods or power outages that accompanied Hurricane Irene, Hurricane Sandy, Tropical Storm Floyd, and other recent storms. In addition to coordinating field activities and personnel, the mobile command post is able to assume the role of the police communications center in the event the municipal building is damaged or inaccessible, as was the case during Irene. It is fully equipped with radios, telephones, and computer equipment.

Each of the vehicles was painted and outfitted at Eastern Surplus and Equipment Company in Philadelphia. In addition to installing safety features and keyed ignition systems, the company installed engine snorkel kits allowing the Humvees to operate in over four feet of water. Police lights and markings were also installed.

Additional surplus equipment includes three heavy duty generators, a bulldozer and a five-ton dump truck. While the generators can keep vital services operating in a disaster, the bulldozer and dump truck will help avoid unnecessary expenses related to debris removal; in past disasters, the Department of Public Works needed to rent similar equipment at significant cost.

Chief James Wozniak believes that his personnel are now better prepared for the next

disaster. "The Cranford Police Department has, unfortunately, deployed to more than our fair share of weather related emergencies, rescues and evacuations in the past decade," he stated. "Now, we have a more complete toolbox, and we can rely less on outside agencies that have their own needs and priorities." He noted that on multiple occasions, the Cranford Police Department called on the Union County Office of Emergency Management, the National Guard,

and surrounding towns to assist in weather related events.

Cranford Mayor Andis Kalnins was also an avid supporter of the surplus acquisition program. He said, "I commend Chief Wozniak and the Cranford Police Department.

By taking advantage of this innovative program, they have significantly increased our public safety abilities at almost no cost to the taxpayers."

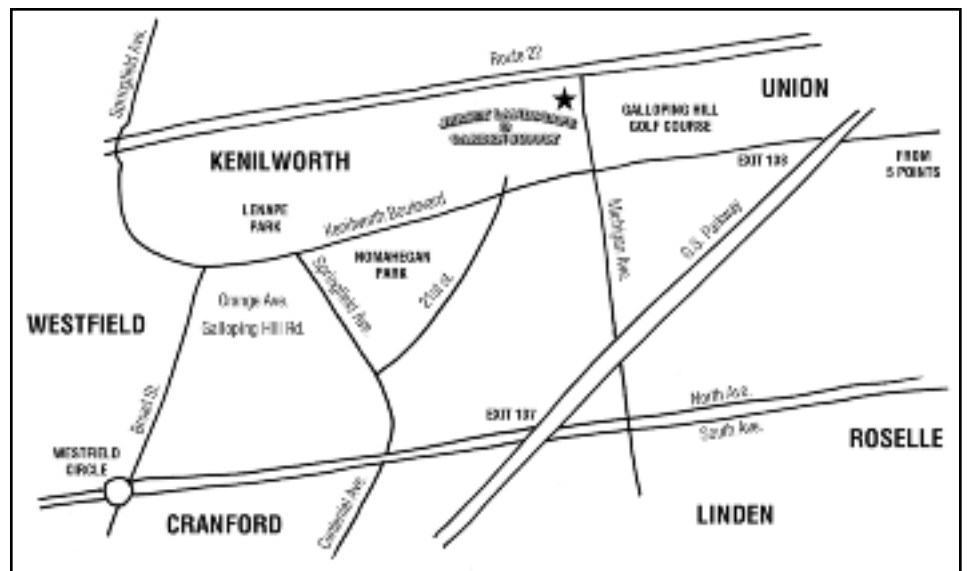

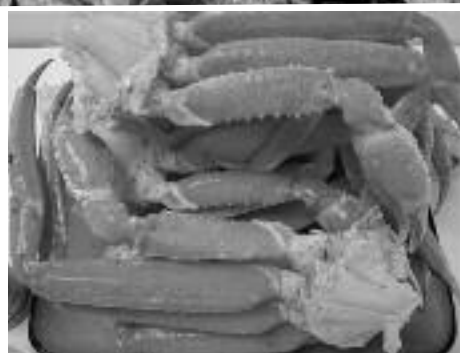
