WORLD LANGUAGE HONOR SOCIETY INDUCTS 241 STUDENTS

Some 241 students at Watchung Hills Regional High School were inducted into the academic honor societies for the languages of Chinese, French, German, Italian, Latin and Spanish at a ceremony held on Thursday, April 16, at the school.

Seventy-three of the 241 students were inducted for the second year. Two students, Rebecca Pasch and Angeli Reyes, were inducted into two language honor societies, Pasch for Chinese and Spanish, and Reyes for French and Spanish. The number of students inducted into each of the honor societies were: Chinese, 23; French, 30; German, 9; Italian, 47; Latin, 11; and Spanish, 121.

Guest speaker for the ceremony, which was open to family members and guests, was Amanda Seewald, board member of the Northeast Conference of the Teaching of Foreign Languages (NCTFL) and the Foreign Language Educators of New Jersey (FLENJ. In congratulating the students for their academic achievement in World Languages, Seewald encouraged them to continue their language learning. "I can tell you that living multi-lingually completely changes the trajectory of your life and you are all on your way," she said.




