Franklin Elementary School's 3rd and fourth grade gifted and talented students recently won first place in the district's annual "Battle of the Books".



ROBOTICS TEAM EARNS SEMI-FINAL BERTH

Following its championship at the Mt. Olive Robotics Event, Rahway High School's RoboTribe Team 1228 earned a berth in the semi-final on Sunday March 29th before falling to the eventual champion alliance.

Once again, programming issues on day one of the tournament forced RoboTribe to miss two matches, while on day two an electrical problem partially disabled RoboTribe for a match and was repaired afterward. These issues had a deleterious effect on the average score of RoboTribe, a score which is used to seed teams for playoff competition. RoboTribe finished the qualification round ranked sixteen of thirty-eight teams and was selected in the first round of the playoff alliance selection, eventually paired with team 3314 from Clifton, New Jersey, as well as team 3142 from Newton, New Jersey.

Team 1228, also known as RoboTribe, participates in FIRST, For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology, an international organization with many sub regions, including the Mid-Atlantic Region, in which RoboTribe competes. Annually, FIRST designs a new game, and teams must build a new robot to complete the tasks outlined in the game. This year's event is titled Recycle Rush, a game in which teams form an alliance with other participating teams and are tasked with stacking recycling totes and bins in stacks on scoring platforms. Each alliance has just under three minutes to reach the highest possible score.

In the playoff rounds RoboTribe and its alliance continued to improve increasing its

average score. In the semi-final RoboTribe's alliance had an average score just above one hundred seventeen, far surpassing the qualification average of seventy-two. Although the average score was impressive, RoboTribe and its alliance members would not qualify to compete in the finals for a chance to win back to back titles, finishing in third place. Prior to this season RoboTribe had never advanced past a semi-final, therefore a championship and a third place finish are two outstanding accomplishments. Rahway Robotics is currently ranked twenty-one in a district consisting of one hundred twenty-one teams.

"FORGOTTEN" MEMORIAL TREES TO BE MARKED WITH FLAGS

Of the hundreds who drive on the roadway circling the Union County Park in Rahway each day, or jog along its rolling paths, only a very, very few, if any at all, realize they are in the midst of a living memorial. This will be made more evident in mid-May when American flags will be placed next to 58 trees that were planted in the park sixtyeight years ago in memory of the 58 men from Rahway who made the Supreme Sacrifice during World War II. The flags will be planted by members of the Merchants and Drovers Tavern Museum Association, and the American Legion Post # 5 of Rahway, with the cooperation of the Union County Division of Parks and Recreation.

At the conclusion of WWII, the Rahway American War Dads, Chapter 6, initiated a project to create some method of honoring the local servicemen who

were killed in the war. Their project evolved into the creation of a Memorial Tree Grove that would surround a monument to be placed in the Rahway County Park.

The dedication service, which took place on Memorial Day, May 30, 1947, was impressive. The observance began with a long parade that started in the business district and ended in the park where several thousand people, young and old, had gathered. A bronze plaque listing the names of the 58 and set in a large boulder was unveiled. The dedication continued with the reading of the names of the fallen soldiers. Standing next to each new tree was a Boy Scout who saluted as the name for whom that tree was dedicated was called. Following the roll call. speeches were presented by local, county, and state officials after which there was a gun salute given by an honor guard from Camp Kilmer. The ceremony closed with an Army bugler playing "Taps." The Memorial Tree Grove was

reported to be the first and most suitable method to honor the war heroes.

In my research over the years, I have literally stumbled across many articles while scanning reels of microfilm. It was at least six or seven years ago that I saw the article reporting the ceremony in the park. I grew up aware of the monument, but I had no previous knowledge of the memorial trees. With this new found information, my curiosity was aroused and I went to the park to see if I could locate the trees, figuring they would all be the same height, have the same girth, and be of the same species. It didn't take long before I realized it would be impossible to pick out the exact 58 trees from the many that cover the park's expansive acreage.

The story behind the rediscovery of the memorial trees is a combination of luck and chance. Last summer I received a request from the nephew of 1st Lt. Walter E. Williams, a serviceman who died from wounds he sustained while in action with General Patton's Third Army in Germany. The nephew, Walter Williams (he was named after his uncle), asked if he could bring two boxes of family memorabilia to the History Room in the Rahway Public Library for safe-keeping. Together, we did a cursory inspection of the contents and then put the cartons away until I had an opportunity to make a more thorough inventory.

This past January I went back to the boxes and came upon a scrap book at the bottom of one. It had been kept by the soldier's mother and contained photos, newspaper articles of her son's death, Western Union telegrams, letters of condolence from military and civilian officials, all carefully arranged in chronological order. Near the end of the book, was the 1947 Rahway News-

Record article on the dedication ceremony. I turned to the next page and found a large piece of paper folded in thirds. When I opened it, I immediately knew I had discovered a treasure. Within the folds was a detailed map of the Memorial Tree Grove which noted the position of each tree as well as a number key matching each tree with each soldier.

This newly discovered map has enabled our local historical association and our veteran groups to once again call attention to the brave men who fought and died for our country when they place an American flag at the base of all 58 trees. The Rahway News-Record editorial from June 5, 1947 commented, the grove will be "a memorial which will grow as the years pass to keep generations aware of the sacrifice which these men made to permit the continuation of our way of life." Just by luck and chance, a tribute that was made almost seven decades ago will be reestablished for a new generation.





EARTHWORMS (LUMBRICUS TERRESTRI)

The reddish-gray-colored common earthworm, often called a night crawler in the United States, is familiar to anyone with a fishing rod or a garden. They are indigenous to Europe, but are now abundant in North America and western Asia.

Earthworms are vital to soil health because they transport nutrients and minerals from below the surface via their waste. Their tunnels aerate the ground. An earthworm can eat up to one third its body weight in a day. A 'healthy' garden soil should have approximately ten earthworms per square foot.

Earthworms burrow during the day, typically keeping close to the surface, but are capable of digging down as deep as 6.5 feet.

Contrary to playground legend, if a worm is cut in half, two will not grow. Therefore you are better off leaving your earthworm undisturbed to get the best results. Amazingly earthworms can live up to six years in the wild.

Worm castings, also called 'vermicast', worm humus or worm manure, is the end-product of the breakdown of organic matter by an earthworm. These castings have been shown to contain reduced levels of contaminants and a higher saturation of nutrients than do organic materials before vermicomposting.

To encourage as many earthworms in your garden as possible add organic materials such as compost to your soil. Scatter it on top or rake it in and the worms will do the rest. This practice adds nutrients to your garden which is as good for your plants as it is for your worms.

Most importantly limit the use of pesticides and insecticides as they can harm or kill your earthworms as well as your intended targets.

The next time you dig up an earthworm while gardening remember how essential they are and rather than just tossing it to the side - cover it back up. Earthworms wither and die quickly when left in the sun.


