UNION HIGH LEADS THE WAY WITH 16 NOMINATIONS FOR 2015 PAPER MILL RISING STAR AWARDS

For over twenty years, the Paper Mill Playhouse has been honoring excellence in high school theater throughout the state of New Jersey. The Union High School Performing Arts Company has remained at the top of the list as one of the best musical theater training programs for high school students in the state; this year being no exception, with sixteen nominations for their production of Duke Ellington's Sophisticated Ladies.

Five years ago, they were bestowed the honor of winning Outstanding Overall Production for 2010's Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat. Director James Mosser shared "It is exciting for the students to be recognized by Paper Mill.

The company of this show has embodied this material, and I couldn't be prouder of them. 





"REV. JAMES CALDWELL" MARKS ANNIVERSARY OF HANNAH'S DEATH

Hannah Caldwell Day 2015
will be commemorated by
the Union Township Historical Society
with an open house at
the Caldwell Parsonage Museum
909 Caldwell Avenue, Union
from 2 to 5 pm on Sunday, June 7.

Visitors will be greeted by Hannah's husband, the Reverend James Caldwell, portrayed by reenactor Doc Burkhardt, who will tell the story of his wife's untimely passing and his involvement in the American Revolution as "the Fighting Parson."

On that date in 1780, following the Battle of Connecticut Farms (most of which was fought in front of the Connecticut Farms Presbyterian Church, 888 Stuyvesant Avenue, Union), Mrs. Caldwell—the mother of their nine children—was killed inside their home by a retreating British soldier.

Rev. Caldwell used her death as a rallying cry for the Patriot cause and, in doing so, helped recruit additional members for the New Jersey militia and George Washington's Continental Army. Just over two weeks later—on June 23, 1780— the British and Hessian forces were turned back yet again, this time at the Battle of Springfield, and thereby prevented from reaching George Washington and his troops in Morristown. That was the last major battle of the war in the North.


