MEMO FROM THE MAYOR



During the Council meeting held on June 10, 2015, we introduced for first reading a series of new comprehensive land use ordinances. This new set of ordinances consists of over 300 pages and is a combination of new ordinances and revision of the current ordinances. These new ordinances will be enacted most importantly with an eye towards identifying the current issues in our town, and putting our town in a position where it will be up to date with the ever changing community developments, with the goal of maintaining the family

oriented character of our Borough.

The adoption of these ordinances are a necessary step following the adoption of the Master Plan by the Planning Board which took place a few years ago. For the most part, these ordinances are consistent with the Master Plan's recommendations. The only difference came as a result of the Mayor and Council's belief that there should be less multifamily dwellings and more single family dwellings in the new zoning map as we, as a Governing Body, believe that this is the direction our community should take going into the future. The proposed ordinances are on the Borough website and our residents are encouraged to review the ordinances and to provide any suggestion they have to the Mayor and Council by emailing the Borough Clerk's office at boroughclerk@kenilworthnj.org.

Also as some of you may have noticed, the grass pick-up in town is no longer being performed by an outside contractor, but rather by our Department of Public Works employees. The Borough on two separate occasions put this service out to bid but on both occasions not a single bid response was received at any price. As a result our Department of Public Works was left with this service for the time being. Also as a result some of you may have noticed that the grass pick-up may not have been occurring on the scheduled Tuesday, but rather not until a day or two later. This is as a result of the DPW unexpectedly having to undertake this task which becomes exacerbated during the summer vacation months. At this point in time the Borough is now considering the hiring of private companies outside of the bid process and it is hoped that we can find a responsible and qualified company to perform this task in the near future. In the meantime, I apologize for any inconvenience that may come as a result of the delays in grass pick-up.

Furthermore, at the Council meeting that took place on June 10, 2015 it was our pleasure to recognize and commend Kenilworth's Girl Scout Troop 40897 and Kenilworth's Boy Scout Troop 83 for their continued dedication to our community and local charities. Just to name a few contributions, these Scouts have assisted in the beautification of the Kenilworth Library, the planting of flowers in front of Borough Hall and alongside the Boulevard, organized efforts to donate prom dresses and Halloween costumes for the less fortunate, and worked at soup kitchens, nursing homes, and our local senior center. As you can see they are one of the most significant assets of our town.

Finally, I hope you have a happy and safe Fourth of July celebration..
