A Broadway triumph turned Academy Award nominated film, *Born Yesterday* is a deliciously witty screwball comedy about a corrupt businessman, Harry Brock, trying to get ahead in Washington. He hires a newspaperman, Paul Verall (played by Cranford resident Joe Leo) to tutor his brassy girlfriend, Billie Dawn, but gets more than he bargained for when he discovers a little bit of learning can be a dangerous thing.

Directed by Eric Walby, the cast is led by Joe Leo as Paul Verall, Julie Ann Nolan as Billie Dawn and Matt Lafargue as Harry Brock. Joel Redmount, seen on stage at CDC in last seasons *Aladdin* is Ed Devrey. The cast also features Barry Leonard and Maureen Muldoon as Senator and Mrs. Hedges, Susan Roberts as Helen, James Beckman as the Bellhop and Brittany Patterson as the Assistant Manager.

The director recently asked "Can a classic still be considered timely? This piece is about ruthless business' purchasing politicians to further their own interests at the cost of the general public. It's about the abused and powerless finding their voice through information and bravery. It's about genius' selling their souls through weakness and fear; because the themes of government corruption and the marginalization of women are just as relevant to a story line today as they were 70 years ago."

Born Yesterday opens October 16 and runs through October 24.



CHIEF CZECH THANKS COMMUNITY FOR CONTINUED SUPPORT; PROMOTES FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

In April of this year, Captain Daniel Czech was promoted to Fire Chief to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Chief Dolan. Since then, Chief Czech has undertaken some proactive projects within the agency through close cooperation with the Cranford Township Committee.

Some of these projects include the purchase of a new aerial ladder truck to replace the existing twenty-year-old truck. Grant funding has also been obtained to purchase personal emergency escape systems for fire personnel. In addition, several new IT-based systems were vetted and chosen to improve productivity and streamline processes. A proactive public relations and public education plan was developed to increase participation in community events. And several promotions and appointments were made by the Township Committee to fill vacancies within the Department. Chief Czech notes that none of these projects would be possible without the close support and cooperation of the Township Committee and Township Administration. "I

can't thank the Cranford Community enough for their support during my first three months as Fire Chief. The Cranford Township Committee continues to show strong support for public safety within the community." In addition, the Chief notes that support from residents and business owners have also been extensive. "We are committed to working closely with our community stakeholders so we can continue to deliver comprehensive, cost-effective emergency services in a manner which is tailored to Cranford's needs."

This week also marks Fire Prevention Week throughout the country. Fire Prevention Week was proclaimed in 1920 by President Woodrow Wilson to commemorate the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 which claimed hundreds of lives and destroyed over 17,000 structures. Chief Czech notes that this year's theme is "Hear the Beep Where you Sleep" and stresses the importance of having a working smoke detector in every bedroom. The Chief also stressed the importance of testing your home smoke alarms and replacing

those which are older than ten years. After that age, the sensitivity of the detector can be impaired, potentially delaying the alarm feature in the event of a fire. Residents should visit www.firepreventionweek.org for more information and fire safety tips.

In the coming days, the Fire Prevention Bureau will be visiting the Township Schools to conduct fire safety education programs for various age groups. Lieutenant Matthew Lubin, who directs fire prevention, risk reduction, and code enforcement, stresses the importance of proactive public education programs. "In Cranford, Fire Prevention is a year-round initiative across all age groups and risk populations." The Cranford Fire Prevention Bureau conducts programs from Kindergarten through High School and also has programs to help train employees and occupants of business, industrial, and special-hazard occupancies.

In addition to the school programs, the Fire Department will have a fire prevention display at the Downtown Street Fair on October 18th.




