"FOUR CENTURIES IN A WEEKEND" PROGRAM AT THE OSWALD J. NITSCHKE HOUSE TO CELEBRATE "THE EARLY DAYS OF NEW ORANGE/KENILWORTH: A COLLEGE TOWN"

"Kenilworth Memories," a new Kenilworth history book about to be released, reveals that during World War II future president John F. Kennedy dated a young Kenilworth woman. Author Walter E. Boright, Ed. D., who has written four previous Kenilworth history books, stated, "At first I said to myself, 'Can this really be true?' Years of research paid off by finding members of the young woman's family and a few surviving classmates who verified the story. After the war Kennedy actually came to Kenilworth in search of her. But who knew who Kennedy was to become back then?"


According to the author the JFK connection and other untold stories, and events in Kenilworth history are among the topics presented in "Kenilworth Memories." The book's 300 pages contain hundreds of Kenilworth, photographs, stories, legends, interviews, and trips down memory lane.

Among topics are the making of silent movies in Kenilworth; fires and disasters; bandits and shootings, assassination at borough hall; the Great Train Robbery controversy; famous people with Kenilworth connections; airplanes taking off and landing in Kenilworth; the real story of Tin Kettle Hill; and a tribute to members of the of the armed forces who gave their lives in WWI, WWII, and the Korean War. There is a detailed presentation about Upsala College when it was located in Kenilworth and considerable information about the Ku Klux Klan taking over the campus and making a headquarters there when the college moved out of town.

"This new book contains a section about Kenilworth families. It's amazing to see what people have found going through their attics and basements," commented Dr. Boright.

In conclusion, Dr. Boright reported, "The name of the young Kenilworth woman who dated JFK, where she lived in Kenilworth, and Kennedy's visit to town are among the stories in the all-new history book.
