GIRL SCOUTS RECEIVE PRESTIGIOUS BRONZE AWARD

Ten of 10 applicants of the North Plainfield Girl Scout Troop 65255 received the highest award a Junior Girl Scout can get, the Bronze Award, for its "We Care" project. This prestigious award fulfills an unmet need in the local community, took months to accomplish and 20 hours of community service – as well as completion of a three-phase Junior Girl Scout "Journey." Awardees where honored and received their Bronze Pins at their "Challenge Ceremony," where they bridged to Cadets on October 19, 2015.

During their award journey, girls gained critical 21st century skills like problem solving, time management and teamwork. They discovered pressing community issues, connected resources while they took action and provided solutions. "The girls' 'We Care' project is a phenomenal example of how Girl Scouts are changing the fabric of our communities in New Jersey, one project at a time and we could not be more proud of their leadership," said Julie Wagenblast, Girl Award Program Specialist of the Girl Scouts Heart of New Jersey.

The troop's "We Care" Kits, or bags of necessary items for those who need help affording them, contained things such as dental floss, tooth paste, soap, mouthwash and other personal items. Product donations were collected from schools, family members, churches, the CVS in North Plainfield and other businesses. "The troop is grateful to everyone who made a donation," said troop member and Bronze Awardee, Nicole Lindemeyer.

The Scouts delivered the kits and provided (Leader supervised) babysitting for children while parents got their "We Care" Kits and food at the Lighthouse Food Ministry on Somerset Street in North Plainfield on May 30, 2015. Pastor Tom Dickerson and Manuel Moricormia, leaders at Lighthouse Ministry, told the Troop, "Thank you for your help, you have been a blessing to have here." Lighthouse is a food bank that serves more than 120 families in the greater North Plainfield community. Over the years, the girls have also handed out chickens and turkeys there for Thanksgiving.

The girls followed and completed the "Agent of Change" Junior Girl Scout Journey Book. In order to fulfill the Bronze, a project that they did on their own with guidance from troop leaders, they also did the following: phase one/Discover: researched and shared about a woman leader, their "heroine:" phase two/Connect: compiled a poster and magazine about these heroines and shared knowledge with each other; and, phase three/Take Action: organized and collected supplies to





GREEN LEARNING SPACE HELPS STUDENTS LEARN

Last fall, former West End student, Bobby Bereheiko, volunteered to revitalize the West End School garden. Over a course of a few months Bobby, along with fellow boy scout members, installed a new fence and stepping stones and added weed blocking underlay, mulch, plant beds, and fresh soil. With money raised through fundraisers, as well as generous donations, Bobby was able to purchase supplies. His hard work and dedication to the project earned him his Eagle Scout badge. Thanks to Bobby's commitment to giving back, a new green learning space for students and teachers had been created. In Spring 2015, Mrs. Lubreski's kindergarten class and Art teacher Lisa Cerulo participated in a collaborative planting project which extended the classroom experience into the newly designed garden. To obtain a first-hand understanding of seeds, the students, assisted by class mom Mrs. Sorkin, planted pumpkin, squash, sunflower, watermelon and mixed garden seeds. During the summer Mrs. Sorkin and children maintained the garden by weeding and watering the plants. Upon arrival in September students were able to see how the seeds sprouted into hearty plants, with

the vines wrapping around the garden. The Room 15 graduates were able to pick the large pumpkins, watermelons and sunflowers to put on display at West End School for the harvest season.

G.E.M.S INSPIRES GIRL

The G.E.M.S (Girls Excelling in Math and Science) program is opening up its doors at Somerset School in North Plainfield to all grade 5 and 6 female students. The program is being presented and advised by Mrs. Kaitlyn Jaffe, science instructor and Ms. Marcelle Farhat, math instructor at Somerset School.

Mrs. Jaffe and Ms. Farhat know firsthand the importance of providing opportunities for young women to have fun with math and science. G.E.M.S will be a place where girls can try things that either will not or cannot be done in regular classroom sessions. Members will be able to explore engineering, a subject that is not yet incorporated into the 6th grade science curriculum.


G.E.M.S will provide an opportunity for the girls to delve into a world of higher level math and science that will challenge the girls without putting any undue pressure on them, because they do not have to pass a test on it. Using critical thinking skills, they will explore and fail and start again without pressure to get the one right answer. They can discover and get messy in hands-on activities! They can get dirty, use tools, mix stuff up, and generally DO the science that is not possible to do during school!

The G.E.M.S program will, indeed, serve to inform and inspire girls toward their potential careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. Throughout the academic year, members will be exposed to guest speakers who currently work in the science and math fields, which will

include government agencies, local industries and corporations. These young women will also be traveling off campus throughout the year, making visits to institutions of higher education to witness their STEM program.

Our overall goal in G.E.M.S will be to encourage girls to pursue STEM fields for courses and careers. G.E.M.S will focus on five overarching goals that will drive girls towards success: INVITE, ENTICE, ENCOURAGE, EXPLORE AND EXPERIENCE.
