



SUMMIT CONFIRMS PURCHASE OF FORMER MERCK SITE BY CELGENE CORPORATION

The City of Summit, NJ is confirming that Celgene Corporation completed its purchase of the former Merck campus located at 556 Morris Ave. in Summit, NJ earlier today.

"We are extremely pleased that Celgene will continue to develop and grow its highly successful business in its new world-class Summit location," explains Summit Mayor Ellen Dickson. "Celgene is a long-standing community partner and we anticipate them making the most of another exceptional property."

Summit City officials had been actively involved in the search for a purchaser for the campus location since Merck & Co., Inc. announced plans in October 2013 to move its global headquarters to Kenilworth, NJ.

Dickson further explains, "The announcement by Celgene in early July of its intention to acquire the property was a clear indication that the company values Summit as a great place to do business. Partnering with Celgene to bring about

this important investment in the Summit community has been a priority for the City, and we look forward to working together with this outstanding organization for many years to come."

The 556 Morris Ave. site includes research and development facilities, laboratory and support buildings, manufacturing capabilities, storage, warehouse buildings and administrative office space. The site has approximately 850,000 square feet of administrative office space and 450,000 square feet of R&D space.

The acquisition of the Morris Avenue facility along with the completion of construction on a new 550,000 square foot office building at its 86 Morris Avenue global headquarters location will allow Celgene to concentrate its New Jersey operations at two campuses in close proximity in Summit.

COMPOSTING, BULK PICKUP AND TRANSFER STATION SCHEDULES FOR REMAINDER OF 2015

The City of Summit Department of Community Services is offering curbside pickup of leaves and large items such as appliances now through early/mid-December 2015.

Through December 4 or the first major snowstorm, the Division of Public Works will collect bagged leaves on regularly scheduled garbage pickup days. Leaves must be placed in biodegradable brown bags and placed at the curb. Residents may also bring leaves to the Transfer Station location at 40 New Providence Rd. The collected leaves are then composted and the compost is made available to the public in the spring for use on lawns and in gardens. For the next few weeks, pumpkins are also being composted at the Transfer Station with a "catapult your pumpkin" launch on Sunday, November 1 from 10AM to 2PM.


Residents are asked to refrain from piling leaves in streets, as this is prohibited by a city ordinance. Though the Division of Public Works operates street sweepers and leaf vacuums to clear streets of leaves and other natural debris, piling leaves in the street is a driving hazard. Doing so narrows driving lanes and creates traffic problems, especially during wet weather when leaves become slippery.

The City is also providing scheduled pick up of



bulky items such as furniture and appliances on December 4 and 18. Please contact the Department of Community Services at 908-273-6404 to arrange a pickup for those scheduled dates.

Please note: The Transfer Station will be closed on Thanksgiving Day 11/26 and reopen with regular operating hours on Friday 11/27 and Saturday 11/28. The Transfer Station will also be closed on Christmas Day Friday 12/25 and will reopen Saturday 12/26 with regular operating hours.


